1. Gather photos (19 total); where applicable, photo orientation is noted as either portrait (P) or landscape (L)

2. Trim and save all zip strips from B&T Duos™

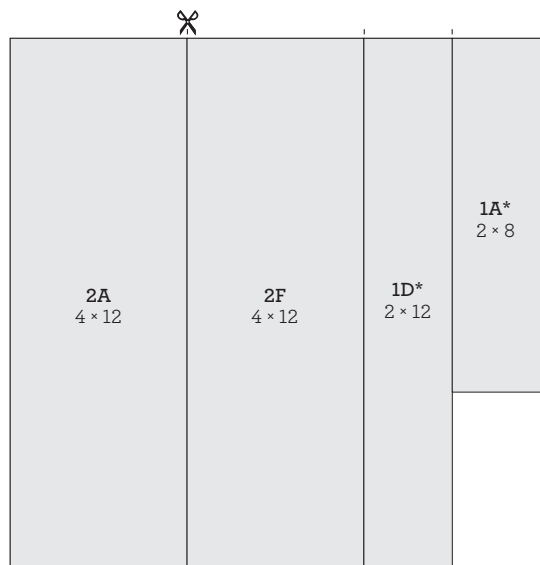
3. Cut apart pocket cards

3P: 3 x 4 pocket card



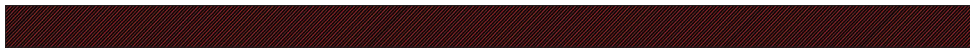
3G: 4 x 6 pocket card

3H: 4 x 1/2 zip strip

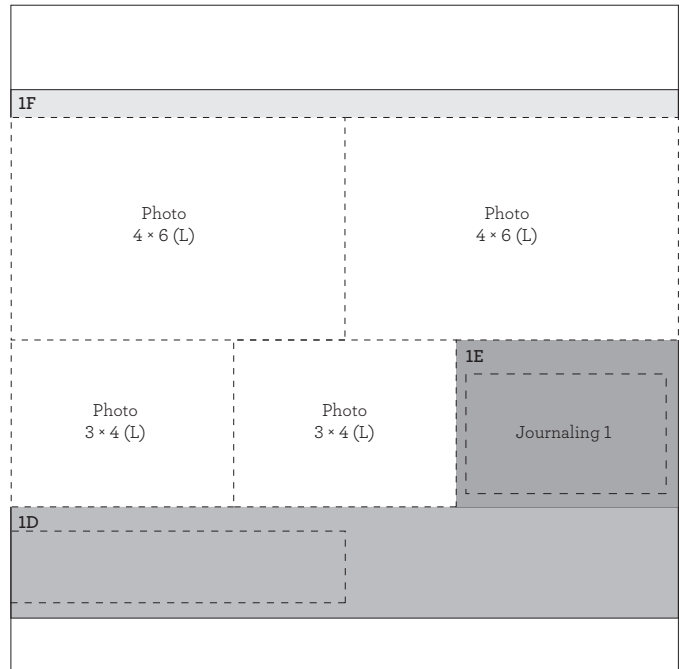
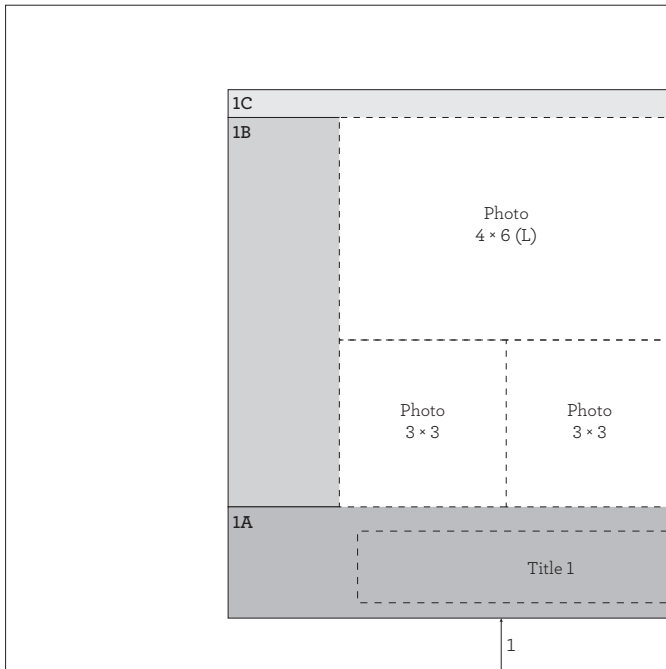

## Project 1: 12 × 12 Layout

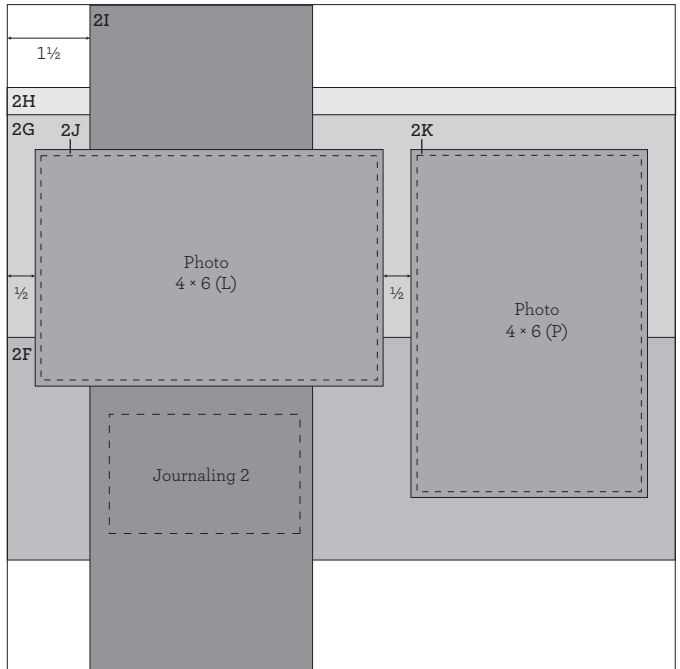
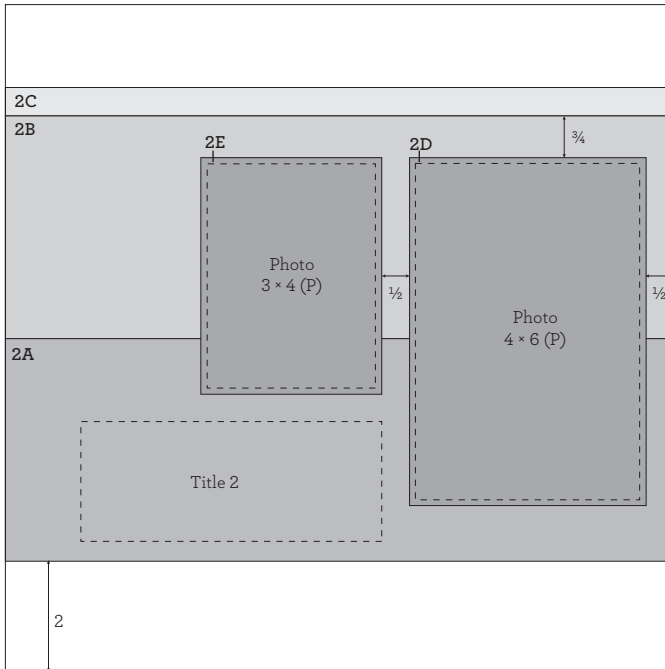


### TIPS

- Wrap twine around 1A before attaching to base page, if desired
- Use trees B&T Duos™ paper for base pages
- Use zip strips for 1C and 1F
- Attach “Wild Child” from Jack Complements to 1A and 1D for Title 1

- Use 3 x 4 pocket card for 1E and add journaling, if desired
- Embellish layout with twine, Jack Complements, and dots as desired

## Project 2: 12 × 12 Layout

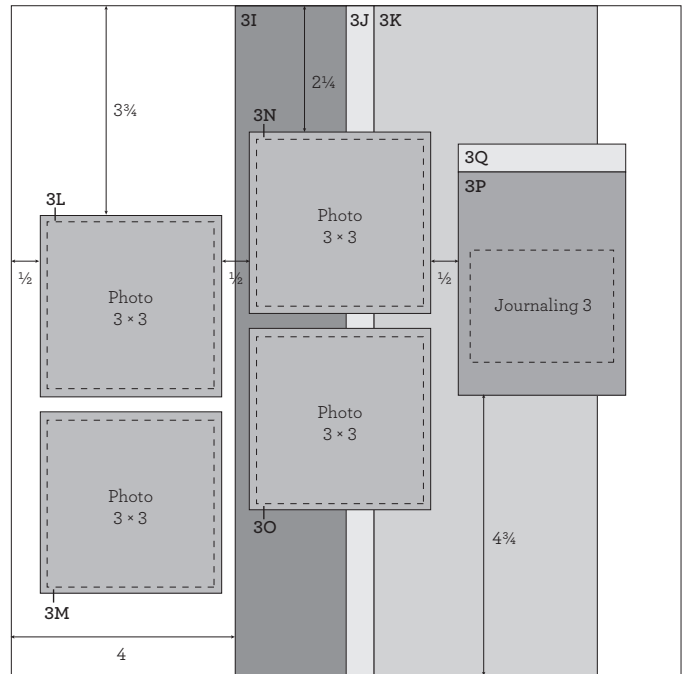
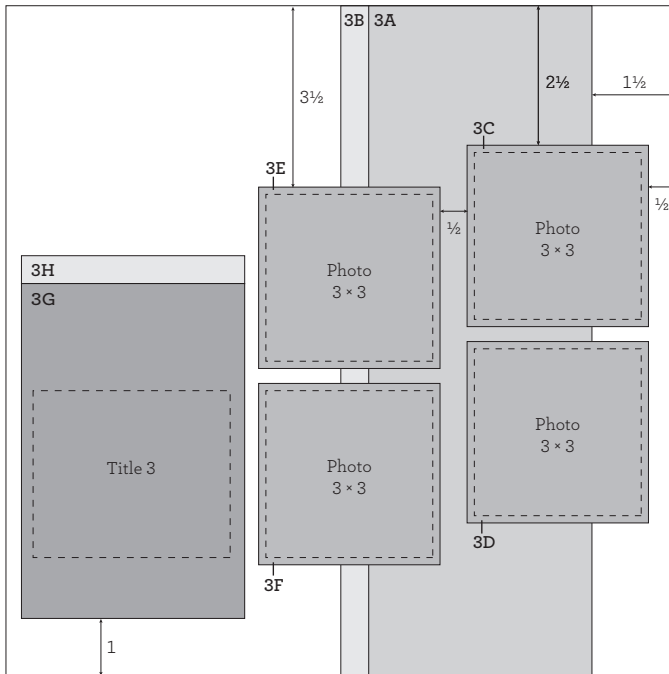


### TIPS

- Use axes B&T Duos™ paper for base pages
- Use zip strips for 2C and 2H
- Attach “Happy Camper” from Jack Complements to 2A for Title 2

- Add journaling to 2I, if desired
- Embellish layout with twine, Jack Complements, and dots as desired

## Project 3: 12 × 12 Layout



### TIPS

- Use Juniper woodgrain B&T Duos™ paper for base pages
- Wrap twine around 3B & 3J before attaching photo mats
- Attach 3E, 3F, 3N & 3O using thin 3-D foam tape, if desired
- Use 4 x 6 pocket card for 3G
- Use 3 x 4 pocket card for 3P and add journaling, if desired

- Use zip strips for 3H and 3Q
- Embellish layout with twine, Jack Complements, and dots as desired
- Add extra photos and pocket cards to this layout pattern designed especially for 4-inch wide Pocket Plus™ Memory Protectors™; turn the page to see inspiration

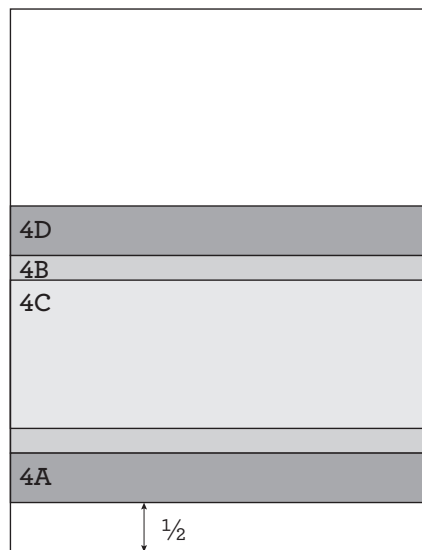
# Optional Cardmaking Project

- Z3271 Archival Black Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z2865 Juniper Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z2870 Ruby Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- X254 White Cards & Envelopes Value Pack
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape

### Project 4: Vertical 4¼ × 5½ Card (Make 2)

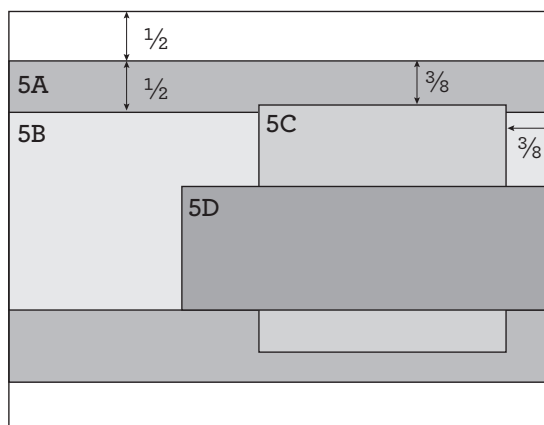


## TIPS

- Attach 4C to 4B, and then wrap twine around 4C before attaching to card base, if desired
- Using Jack Cardmaking Thin Cuts, cut bear and banner from scrap White Daisy cardstock; stamp corresponding images using Archival Black ink, and attach using thin 3-D foam tape, if desired
- Using Jack Cardmaking Thin Cuts, cut winter hat from scrap White Daisy cardstock; stamp corresponding image using Juniper ink, and attach using thin 3-D foam tape, if desired
- Embellish card with dots as desired



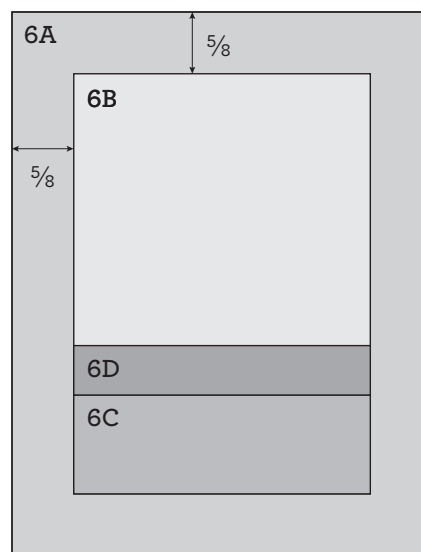
## Project 5: Horizontal 4¼ × 5½ Card (Make 2)



### TIPS

- Dovetail left end of 5D, if desired
- Using Archival Black ink, stamp “It’s Your Day” onto right side of 5D, and attach using thin 3-D foam tape, if desired
- Using Jack Cardmaking Thin Cuts, cut heart from scrap White Daisy cardstock; stamp corresponding image using Ruby ink then attach using thin 3-D foam tape if desired
- Embellish card with twine and dots as desired

## Project 6: Vertical 4¼ × 5½ Card (Make 2)



### TIPS

- Using Archival Black ink, stamp “I Love You More Than I Can Bear” onto 6C
- Attach 6C and 6D to 6B, then wrap twine around 6D before attaching to 6A, if desired
- Using Jack Cardmaking Thin Cuts, cut heart from White Daisy cardstock; stamp corresponding image using Ruby ink
- Using Jack Cardmaking Thin Cuts, cut bear and hands from scrap Whisper cardstock; stamp corresponding image using Archival Black ink
- Embellish card with dots as desired
