 Attach 1A and 1B
- 3. Tear about 3/4" off bottom of 1C and attach
- 4. Attach heart border sticker above 1A
- 5. Attach 1D

- 6. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape7. Attach "LOVE" title sticker with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown8. Embellish with additional stickers Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 9. Stamp hearts on base page with Flamingo ink, as shown
- 10. Add journaling



 Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for the page of the stickers with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

Project 2: Right Page





Assemble:

- Use Black cardstock for base page
 Attach 2F, 2G, and 2H
- 3. Attach 21
- 4. Attach 2J, 2K, and 2L with thin 3-D foam tape 5. Attach photos
- 6. Embellish with stickers Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 7. Add journaling

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Shaker Window Assembly Tips for Projects 3, 4, and 5:

- 1. Carefully remove outer foam heart from foam tape backing sheet and attach to heart base *Tip: Leave the foam pieces on the backing sheet for later use.*
- 2. Place desired amount of mini hearts inside frame
- 3. Remove protective film from acetate and lay on top of foam tape heart Tip: If you haven't already done so, peel off the protective layer from the foam heart to expose the adhesive before laying the acetate on it.

Project 3: Make 2



Prepare (2 each):

- Stamp hearts on 3C with Candy Apple ink and dovetail, as shown
- Stamp heart border on 3D with Archival Black ink, as shown
- Stamp large heart on 3E with Flamingo ink, as shown
 Tip: Use second-generation stamping technique.
 Technique: Ink stamp in Flamingo and stamp it on a scratch piece
 of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 3E.
- Stamp "HELLO" on 3E with Archival Black ink, as shown

 Tip: Before stamping, consider the angle at which you will attach the
 shaker window. Turn 3E slightly counterclockwise so that "HELLO"

 will be straight when it is attached to your card.
- Assemble heart shaker window
 Tip: Refer to Shaker Window Assembly Tips above.



Assemble:

- 1. Attach 3A
- 2. Attach 3B and 3C
- 3. Attach 3D
- 4. Attach heart shaker window, as shown
- 5. Attach 3F

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Project 4: Make 2



Prepare (2 each):

- Stamp "we're the Perfect Match" on 4A with Archival Black ink, as shown
- Stamp matches on 4D with Archival Black ink, as shown
- Assemble heart shaker window Tip: Refer to Shaker Window Assembly Tips on page 9.





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

- 1. Fold 6A along score lines
- 2. Attach 6B to 6A, as shown
- 3. Hole punch 6A, as shown
 Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 6A, at 1"
 from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the
 front and back flaps together and punch through both layers on
 your pencil marks to make four holes.
- 4. Attach a flat lollipop inside 6A with clear tape
- 5. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown

Project 7: Make 5



Prepare (5 each):

- Score 7A at 3¼" and 3¾"
- Stamp large hearts on 7A with Flamingo ink, as shown Tip: Use second-generation stamping technique to stamp second heart.

Technique: Ink stamp in Flamingo and stamp it on 7A. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 7A again.



Assemble:

- 1. Attach 7B to 7A
- 2. Fold 7A along score lines
- 3. Hole punch 7A, as shown
 Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 7A, at 1"
 from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the
 front and back flaps together and punch through both layers on
 your pencil marks to make four holes.
- 4. Attach a flat lollipop inside 7A with clear tape
- 5. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown

Prepare (5 each):

- Score 8A at 3¼" and 3¾"
- Stamp "HELLO" on 8A with Archival Black ink, as shown
- Stamp heart border on 8A with Candy Apple ink, as shown



Assemble:

- 1. Fold 8A along score lines
- 2. Attach 8B to 8A, as shown
- 3. Hole punch 8A, as shown
 Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 8A, at 1"
 from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the
 front and back flaps together and punch through both layers on
 your pencil marks to make four holes.
- 4. Attach a flat lollipop inside 8A with clear tape
- 5. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown

Prepare (5 each):

- Score 9A at 3¼" and 3¾"
- Stamp "xoxoxo" on 9B with Archival Black ink, as shown



Assemble:

- 1. Attach 9B, 9C, and 9D to 9A
- 2. Fold 9A along score lines
- 3. Hole punch 9A, as shown Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 9A, at 1" from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the front and back flaps together and punch through both layers on your pencil marks to make four holes.

 4. Attach a flat lollipop inside 9A with clear tape

 5. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown

Prepare (5 each):

- Score 10A at 3¼" and 3¾"
- Stamp "HELLO" on 10C with Archival Black ink, as shown
- Stamp arrow on 10C with Candy Apple ink, as shown



Assemble:

- 1. Attach 10B to 10A
- 2. Attach 10C with thin 3-D foam tape
- 3. Fold 10A along score lines
- 4. Hole punch 10A, as shown
 Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 10A, at 1"
 from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the
 front and back flaps together and punch through both layers on
- your pencil marks to make four holes.

 5. Attach a flat lollipop inside 10A with clear tape
- 6. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown

Prepare (5 each):

- Score 11A at 3¼" and 3¾"
- Stamp "I love you" on 11A with Archival Black ink, as shown



Assemble:

- 1. Fold 11A along score lines
- 2. Attach 11B to 11A, as shown
- 3. Hole punch 11A, as shown Tips: Use a pencil to make two small guide marks on 11A, at 1" from both sides and about ¼" from the bottom. Firmly hold the front and back flaps and punch through both layers on your pencil marks to make four holes.

 4. Attach a flat lollipop inside 11A with clear tape

 5. Close top flap and seal with twine, as shown
