Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are scrapbooking project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

Tip: If you are creating the Christmas themed pages, use the Christmas themed side of the patterned paper for 3A and 3G.



White Daisy cardstock



Prepare (Tropical):

- Stamp two large leaves on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Clover ink
- Stamp two small flowers on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Pale Pink blend markers
- Stamp two medium leaves on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Green Turquoise blend markers

Prepare (Christmas):

 Stamp a large ornament on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Green Turquoise, and darkest Citrus blend markers

Tip: Once the marker ink is dry, stamp the large heart in the center of the ornament with Lagoon ink.

• Stamp two small ornaments on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color one ornament with lightest and darkest Pale Pink and darkest Citrus blend markers and color second ornament with lightest and darkest Green Turquoise, and darkest Citrus blend markers *Tip: Once the marker ink is dry, stamp the small heart in the center of Green Turquoise ornament with Lagoon ink.*



- 1. Use Mint grid paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1A with thin 3-D foam tape
- 3. Attach 1B
- 4. Dovetail and attach 1C
- 5. Attach 1D with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photo
- 7. Embellish with prepared accents and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 8. (Christmas) Draw lines from ornaments to the top of 1B with Teal pen and ruler
- 9. Draw border around 1B with Teal pen
- 10. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
- 11. Add journaling



Prepare (for chosen layout):

Tropical:

• Stamp "GETAWAY" on 2F with Lagoon, Lemonade, and Clover inks, as shown

Tip: Stamp the "G" and "W" using the second-generation stamping technique.

Technique: Ink the stamp in Lagoon and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 2F.

- Stamp tag on coordinating P2 White Daisy cardstock accent with Lagoon ink
- Stamp pineapple on coordinating P2 White Daisy cardstock accent with Lemonade and Clover inks *Tip: Use the selective inking technique.*

Technique: Carefully apply Lemonade ink to the fruit part of the mounted pineapple stamp. Then, carefully apply Clover ink to crown of the pineapple stamp. Once inked, stamp the image on the cardstock accent.

Christmas:

- Stamp "Christmas" on coordinating P2 White Daisy cardstock accent with Clover ink
- Stamp two large stars on coordinating P2 White Daisy cardstock accents with Lagoon ink
- Stamp "MERRY" and small star on 2F with Lagoon ink, as shown *Tip: Lay the prepared "Christmas" accent on 2F, without attaching it, to help with the stamp placement.*



- 1. Use Mint and Clover grid paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A
- 3. Attach 2B and 2C
- 4. Attach 2D on top of 2A
- 5. Attach 2E with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach prepared 2F
- 7. Attach 2G
- 8. Attach photos
- 9. Embellish with prepared accents and stickers, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 10. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*







- 1. Use Mint and Clover grid paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2H
- 3. Attach 2I and 2J
- 4. Attach 2K on top of 2H
- 5. Attach 2L and 2M
- 6. Attach 2N with thin 3-D foam tape
- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Embellish with prepared accents and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 9. (Christmas) Stamp small stars on 2L with Lagoon ink, as shown

Tip: Stamp two stars using the second-generation stamping technique. Technique: Ink the stamp in Lagoon and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 2L.

- 10. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
- 11. Add journaling



Prepare (for chosen layout):

Tropical:

- Stamp sand along bottom of 3D with Lemonade ink, as shown
- Stamp a flamingo on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Pale Pink and darkest Citrus blend markers
- Stamp a seashell and sand dollar on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Pale Pink, and lightest and darkest Citrus blend markers

Christmas:

- Stamp a flamingo on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Pale Pink, darkest Citrus, and lightest and darkest Green Turquoise blend markers
- Stamp two wide presents on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink, let dry, then color with lightest and darkest Citrus blend marker
- Stamp a tall present on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Clover ink
- Stamp a small present on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Clover ink, let dry, then color dots in with lightest Green Turquoise blend marker



- 1. Use Ballerina dot paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, and 3D
- 3. Attach 3E and 3F with thin 3-D foam tape
- 4. Attach photos
- 5. Embellish with prepared accents and stickers *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 6. (Christmas) Stamp small star clusters on 3D with Lemonade ink, as shown
- 7. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*







- 1. Use Ballerina dot paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3G, 3H, and 3I
- 3. Attach 3J, 3K, 3L, and 3M with thin 3-D foam tape
- 4. Attach 3N
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Embellish with prepared accents and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 7. (Christmas) Stamp small star clusters on 3N with Lemonade ink, as shown
- 8. Embellish with acrylic shapes
- Tip: Attach with glue dots.
- 9. Add journaling





- 1. Use tropical flowers (tropical) or present paper (Christmas) for base page
- 2. Attach 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 4E, and 4F
- 3. Attach 4G to 4C, as shown
- 4. Attach 4H and 4I with thin 3-D foam tape
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Embellish with stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 7. Stamp small starfish (tropical) or small stars (Christmas) on 4D with Lagoon ink, as shown
- 8. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
- 9. Add journaling







- 1. Use tropical flowers (tropical) or presents paper (Christmas) for base page
- 2. Attach 4J, 4K, 4L, 4M, 4N, and 4O
- 3. Attach 4P to 4L, as shown
- 4. Attach 4Q and 4R with thin 3-D foam tape
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. (Tropical) Dovetail and attach $4\mathsf{S}$
- 7. Embellish with stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- Stamp small starfish (tropical) or small stars (Christmas) on 4M with Lagoon ink, as shown
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
