Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

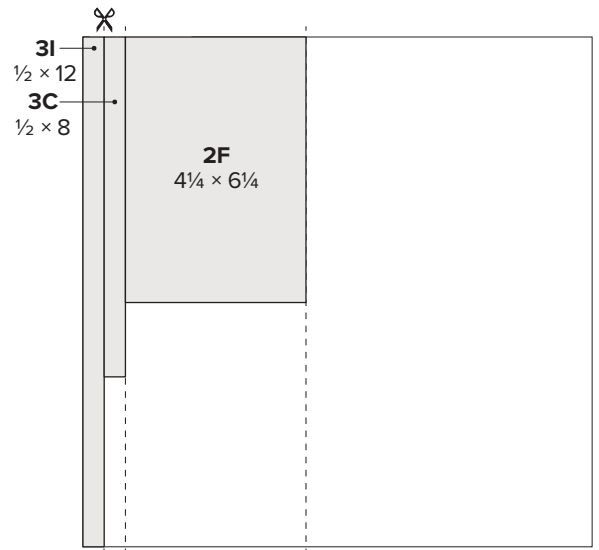


Sangria cardstock

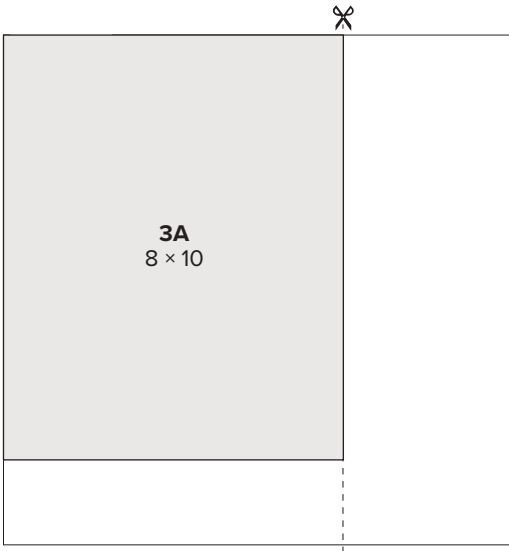

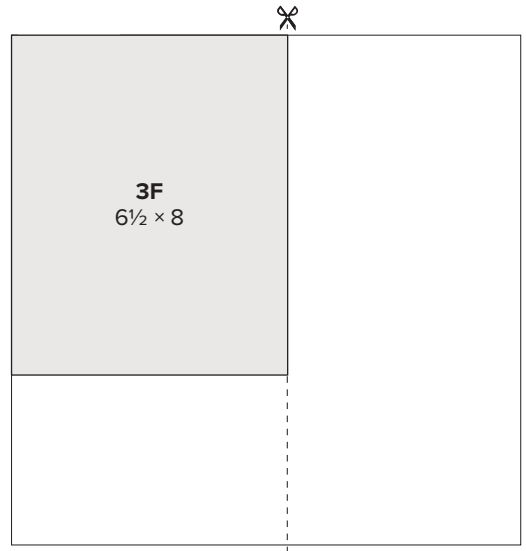


Sage cardstock

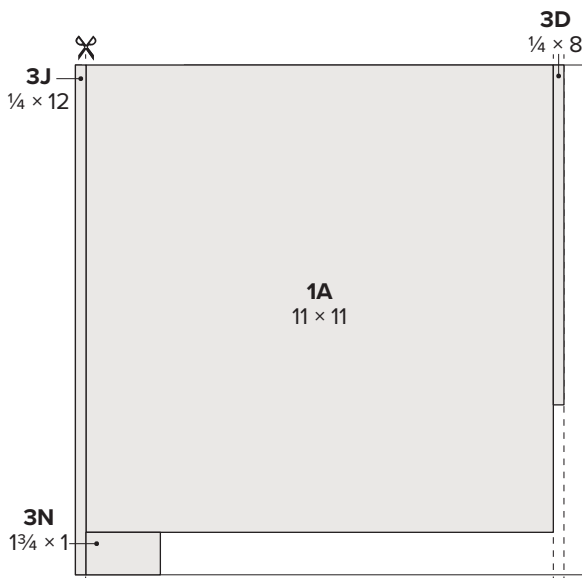

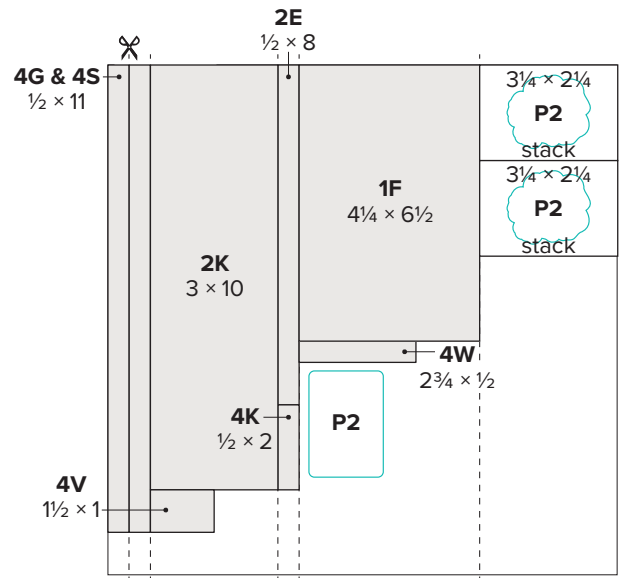


Mulberry cardstock

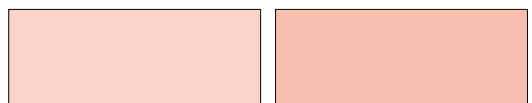

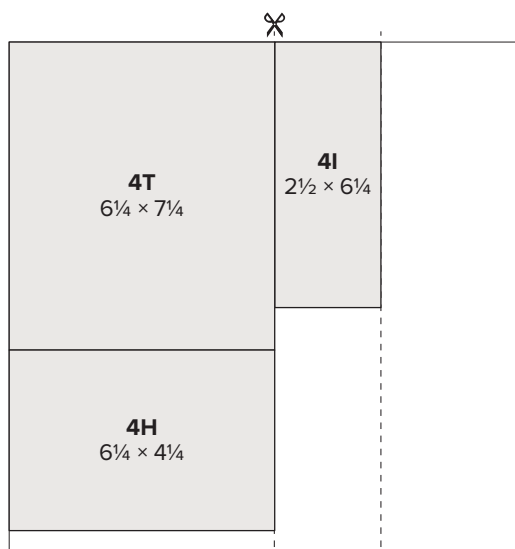

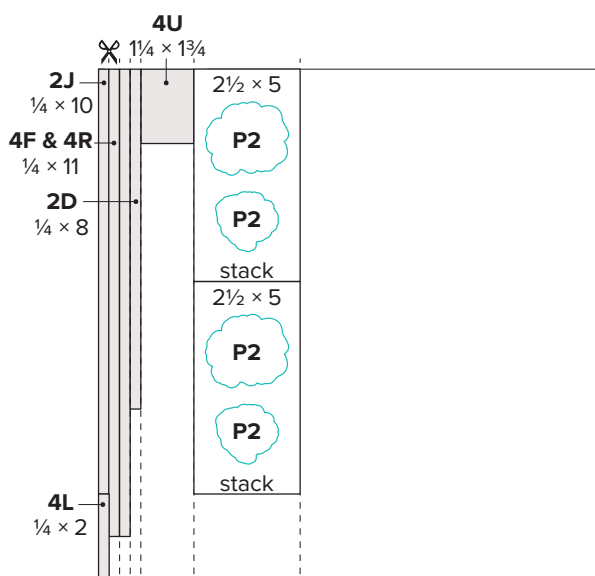


Evergreen cardstock

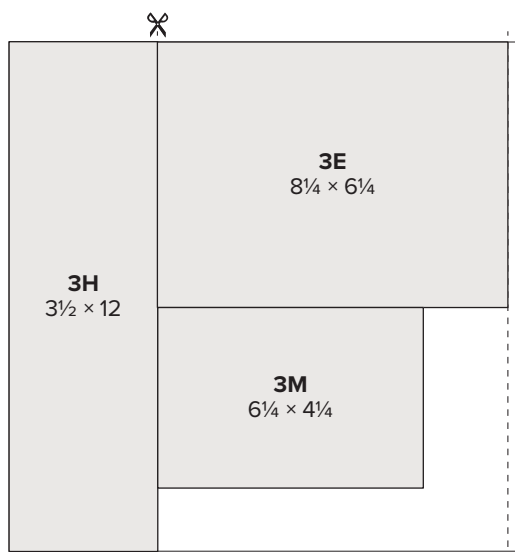
Papaya cardstock



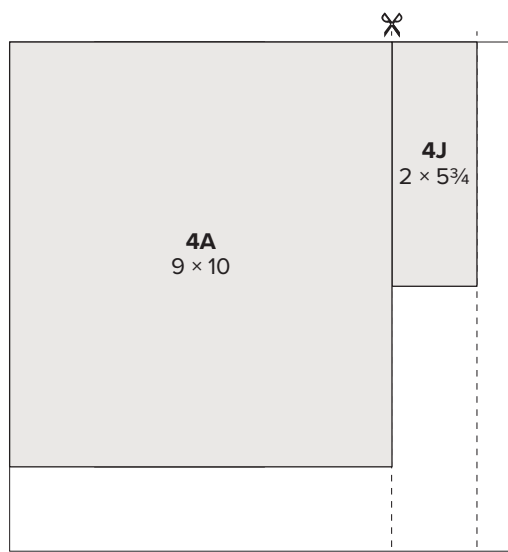

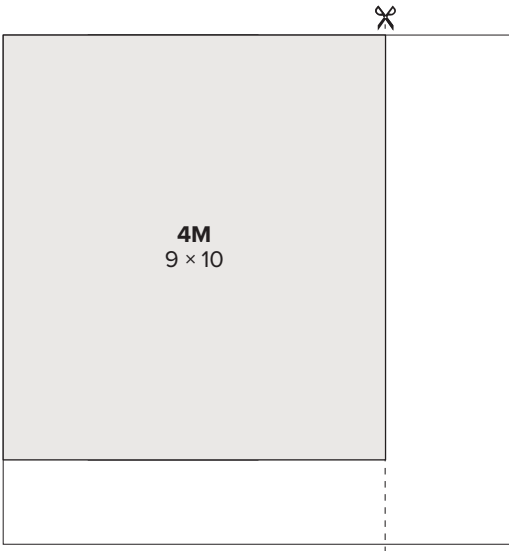


White Daisy cardstock

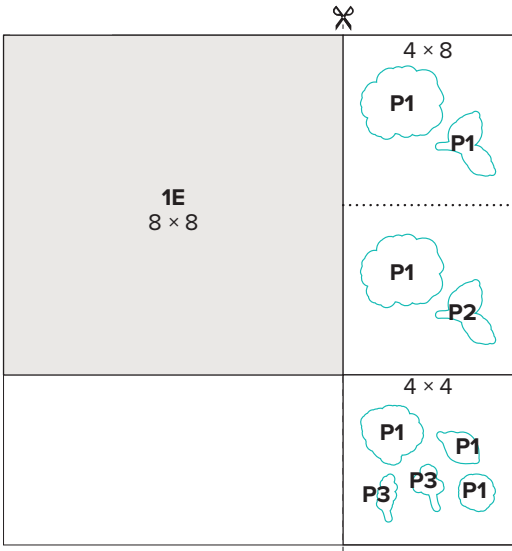

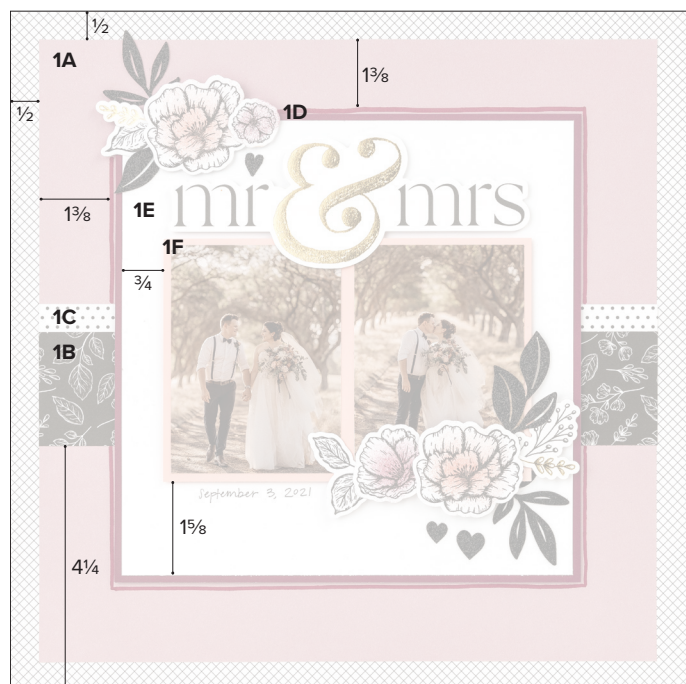

Project 1:



Prepare:

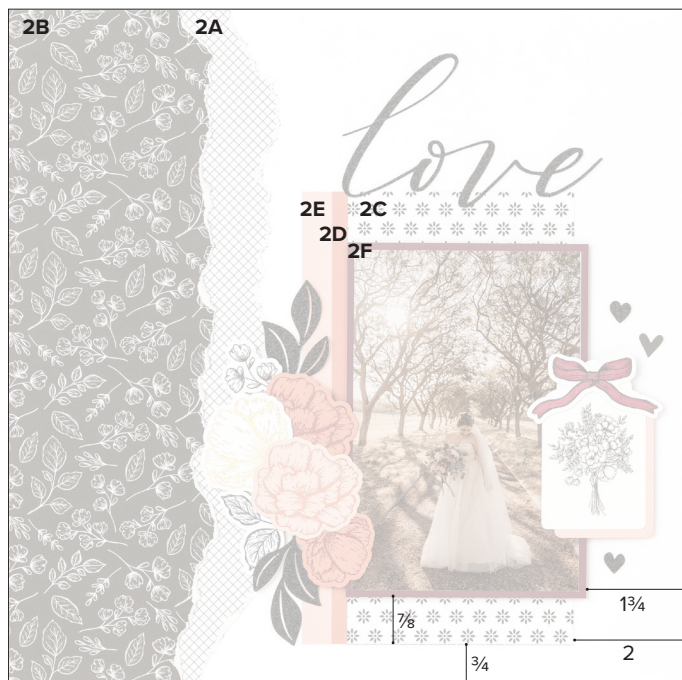
Tips: If you are creating the Mink page, replace the Intense Black ink with Mink ink. If you are creating the Toffee page, replace the Intense Black ink with Toffee ink.

- Stamp large flower on two coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink (or Mink or Toffee ink)
- Lightly sponge large flower accents with Papaya ink
Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.
- Stamp medium flower on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink (or Mink or Toffee ink)
- Stamp small flower on coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink (or Mink or Toffee ink)
- Lightly sponge medium and small flower accents with Sangria ink
- Stamp one double and one single leaf on their coordinating P1 White Daisy cardstock accents with Intense Black ink

Assemble:

1. Use black and white grid paper for base page
Tips: If you are creating the Mink projects, use the small flower paper. If you are creating the Toffee projects, use the diagonal stripe paper.
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach 1B and 1C
4. Attach 1D with 3-D foam tape
5. Draw border around 1D with darkest Dark Red shades marker, as shown
6. Attach 1E, as shown
7. Attach 1F with 3-D foam tape
8. Attach photos
9. Embellish with prepared accents, stickers, and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

Tips: If you are creating the Mink pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Mink ink. If you are creating the Toffee pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Toffee ink.

- Tear approximately 1/2" from one long edge of 2A, 2B, 2G, and 2H, as shown
- Stamp large flower on two coordinating P2 light Peach cardstock accents with Papaya ink
- Stamp large flower on two coordinating P2 light Papaya cardstock accents with Sangria ink
- Stamp medium flower on two coordinating P2 light Papaya cardstock accents with Sangria ink
- Stamp one double leaves on coordinating P2 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink
- Color bow sticker with medium and darkest Dark Red shades markers

Tip: If you are creating the Toffee pages, the bow sticker included in your kit has a glossy UV-coating, and you may want to leave it as is. If you choose to color it, use long, even strokes with the marker.

Assemble:

1. White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach prepared 2A
3. Attach prepared 2B
4. Attach 2C, 2D, and 2E
5. Attach 2F with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photo
7. Embellish with prepared accents, stickers, including prepared sticker, and glitter die-cuts, as shown

Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach sticker tag to P2 light Peach cardstock accent before attaching it to the page.

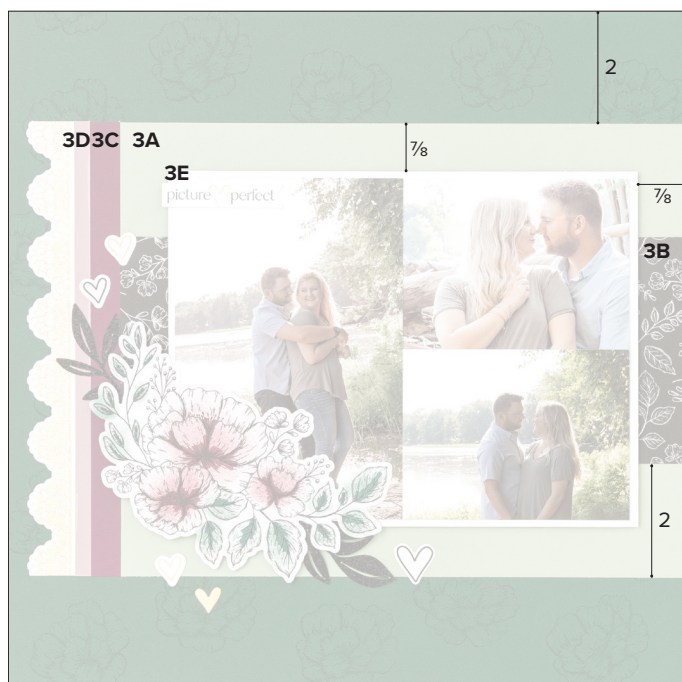
Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach prepared 2G
3. Attach prepared 2H
4. Attach 2I, 2J, and 2K
5. Attach 2L, 2M, and 2N with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with prepared accents, stickers, and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

Tips: If you are creating the Mink pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Mink ink. If you are creating the Toffee pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Toffee ink.

- Stamp large flower on both Evergreen cardstock base pages with Evergreen ink, as shown
- Sponge large flower and leaf cluster sticker, large flower sticker, and two leaf stickers with Sangria and Evergreen inks, as shown, and set aside to dry
Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the stickers until the desired amount of color is achieved.
- Dovetail 3N, then stamp "OUR LIFE OUR STORY OUR HOME" on 3N with Sangria ink
- Stamp small flower trio on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink (or Mink or Toffee ink)
- Stamp sprig on coordinating P3 White Daisy cardstock accent with Intense Black ink (or Mink or Toffee ink)
- Once sponged stickers are dry, add color with all Dark Red shades and Jade Green shades markers

Assemble:

1. Use prepared Evergreen cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B
4. Attach 3C and 3D
5. Embellish with border sticker
Tip: Trim to 8" before attaching.
6. Attach 3E with 3-D foam tape
7. Attach photos
8. Embellish with stickers, including prepared sticker, and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared Evergreen cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3F
3. Attach 3G
4. Attach 3H, 3I, and 3J
5. Embellish with border sticker
6. Attach 3K and 3L
7. Attach 3M with 3-D foam tape
8. Attach photo
9. Attach prepared 3N, as shown
10. Embellish with prepared accents, stickers, including prepared stickers, and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. Add journaling

Project 4: Left Page

Prepare:

Tips: If you are creating the Mink pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Mink ink. If you are creating the Toffee pages, replace the Intense Black ink with Toffee ink.

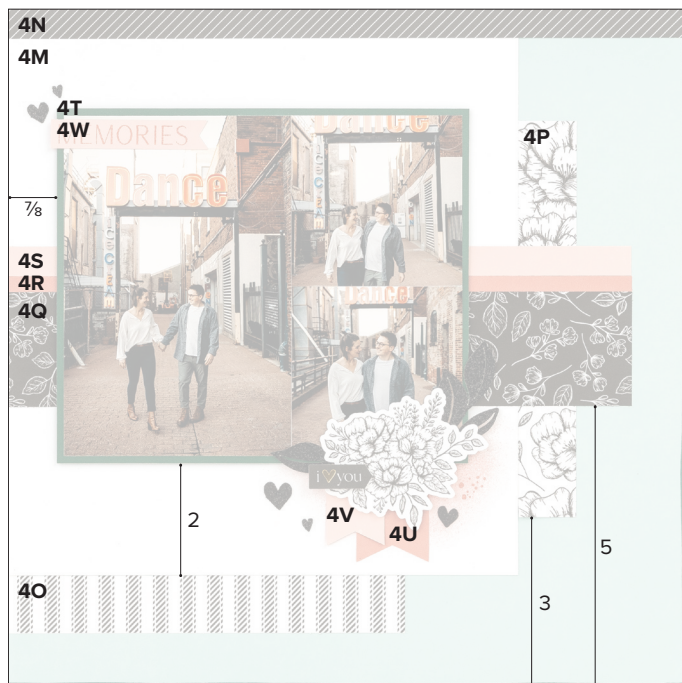
- Lightly sponge 4A and 4M with Papaya ink, as shown
Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.
- Dovetail 4W, then stamp "MEMORIES" on 4W with Papaya ink
- Draw stitch lines on 4L with Black journaling pen, as shown
- Draw border lines on both light Glacier cardstock base pages with darkest Jade Green shades marker, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use prepared light Glacier cardstock for base page
2. Attach prepared 4A
3. Attach 4B
4. Attach 4C and 4D
5. Attach 4E, 4F, and 4G
6. Attach 4H and 4I with 3-D foam tape
7. Attach 4J, as shown
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so a sticker can be tucked behind it in a later step.
8. Attach 4K and prepared 4L to 4J
9. Attach photo
10. Embellish with stickers and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Tuck the flower sticker slightly behind 4J, as shown, and use 3-D foam tape along the parts that hang off 4I for added dimension.
11. Stamp splatters on 4A with Papaya ink, as shown
12. Add journaling

Project 4: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared light Glacier cardstock for base page
2. Attach prepared 4M
3. Attach 4N
4. Attach 4O and 4P
5. Attach 4Q, 4R, and 4S
6. Attach 4T with 3-D foam tape
7. Dovetail and attach 4U and 4V, as shown
8. Attach photos
9. Attach prepared 4W, as shown
10. Embellish with stickers and glitter die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. Stamp splatter on 4M with Papaya ink, as shown
