Getting started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

- ✂ = first cut
 * = use back of paper
 P = Project
 ----- = cut line
 = fold line
 _____ = suggested thin cuts arrangement
 stack = paper pieces that can be stacked to die-cut two shapes at once, are labelled, "stack"

Adding stickers from the Daisy, Daisy sticker sheet:

Each sticker that is used in this workshop has been labelled with the number of the project and in some instances **L** or **R** to indicate whether it is used on the left or right page (for layouts). Stickers used on the single page or cards have the project number only.



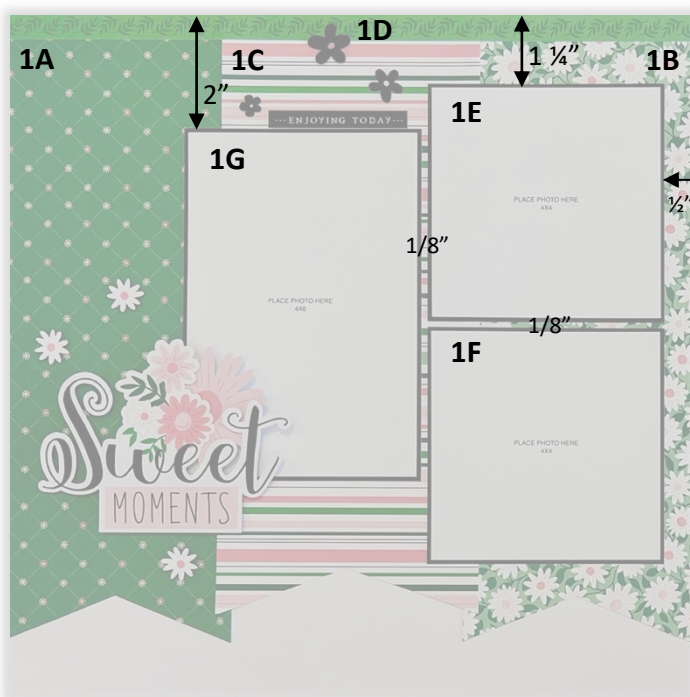
Project I: Sweet Moments- Left page



Prepare (for both pages):

- Dovetail the bottom of the 6 strips of patterned paper.

Tip: For consistent dovetails, turn the patterned paper over and on the back of all 6 strips of pattern paper, measure up $\frac{3}{4}$ " from bottom of the paper and mark the centre point of each strip. Draw a line from the centre point to the left and right bottom corners. Cut along the lines with your scissors.



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page.
2. Attach 1A flush with the top and the left side of the base page.
3. Attach 1B flush with the top and the right side of the base page.
4. Attach 1C, overlapping both 1A and 1B by approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
5. Attach 1D flush with the top of the base page.
6. Attach 1E and 1F, leaving $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap between them.
7. Attach 1G leaving $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap.
8. Create the "Sweet MOMENTS" sticker cluster and attach with 3-D foam tape.
9. Decorate with extra stickers and black die-cut flowers, as shown.



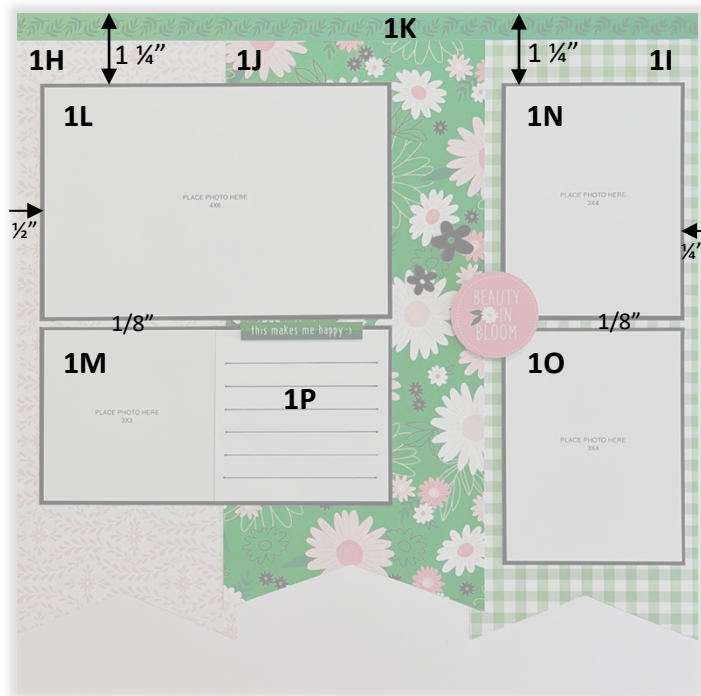
Project I: Sweet Moments- Right page



Prepare:

- Draw journaling lines on 1P.

Tip: To achieve even spacing between journaling lines, start ruling your lines from the bottom of the journaling box. Use the guidelines on the clear ruler to move the ruler up the same distance each time.



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page.
2. Attach 1H flush with the top and the left side of the base page.
3. Attach 1I flush with the top and the right side of the base page.
4. Attach 1J, overlapping both 1H and 1I by approximately 1/4".
5. Attach 1K flush with the top of the base page.
6. Attach 1L and 1M, leaving 1/8" gap between them.
7. Attach 1N and 1O leaving 1/8" gap.
8. Attach 1P to the right side of 1M.
9. Decorate with extra stickers and black die-cut flowers, as shown.

Project 2: Together Time- Right page

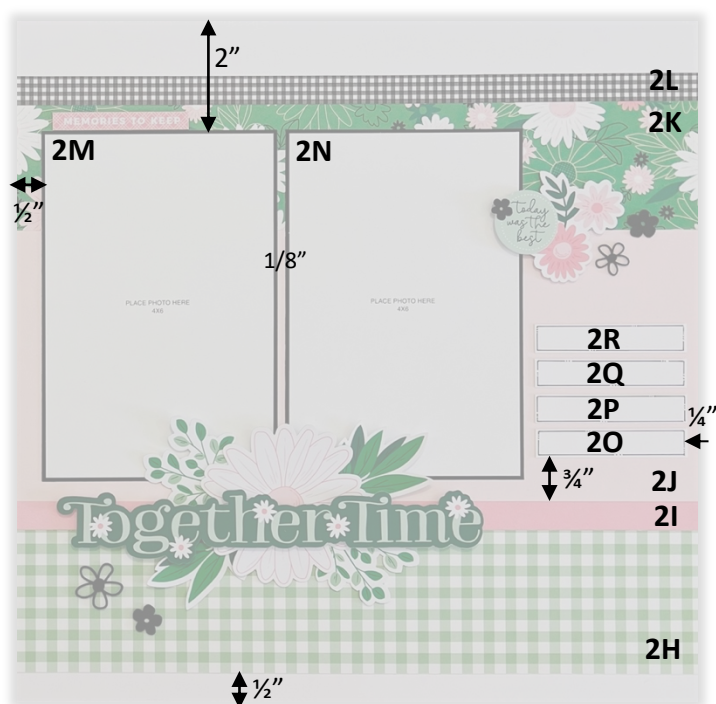
The right page is created before the left page for ease of aligning the strips across the layout.



Prepare:

- Doodle around the inside edges of 2O, 2P, 2Q and 2R to create the journaling strips.

Tip: For a more precise doodle, use a ruler to draw the lines. For a more organic doodle, hand draw the lines.



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for the base page.
2. Attach 2H at $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of the base page.
3. Attach 2I, 2J, 2K and 2L in order ensuring they are flush with the top of the piece below them.
4. Attach 2M and 2N leaving $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap between them.
5. Attach 2O, 2P, 2Q and 2R leaving $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap between them.
6. Build the "Together Time" sticker cluster and attach with 3-D foam tape.
7. Decorate with extra stickers and black die-cut flowers, as shown.



Project 2: Together Time- Left page

Use the measurements below as well as the completed right side of the layout to ensure the various paper and cardstock strips line up across the layout.

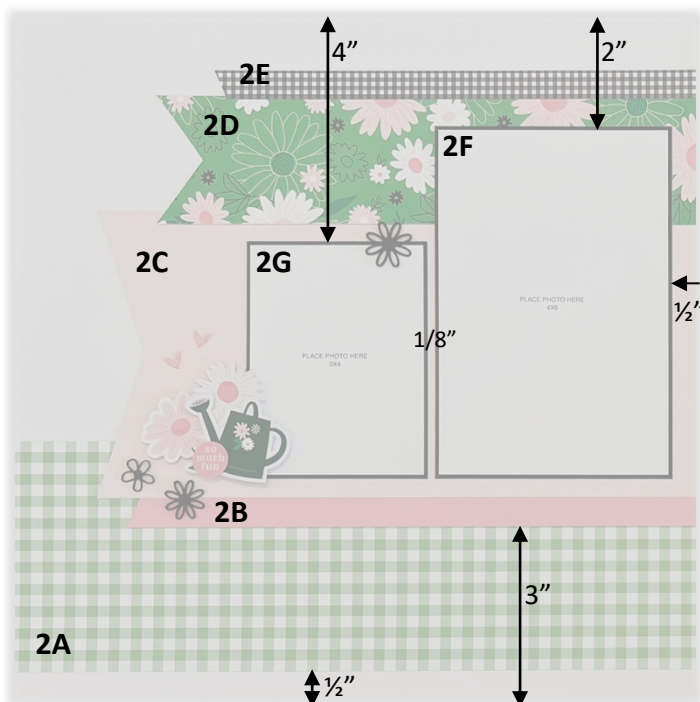


Prepare:

- Dovetail 2C and 2D.

Tip: For consistent dovetails, turn the pieces over and on the back measure in $\frac{3}{4}$ " from left side of the paper/cardstock and mark the centre point of each strip. Draw a line from the centre point to the top and bottom corners. Cut along the lines with your scissors.

- Cut the left side of both 2B and 2E at an angle as shown.



Assembly:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for the base page.
2. Attach 2A at $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of the base page.
3. Attach 2B, 2C, 2D and 2E, ensuring they line up with the pieces on the right page.
4. Attach 2F and 2G leaving $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap between them.
5. Build the "so much fun" sticker cluster and attach with 3-D and thin 3-D foam tape.
6. Decorate with extra stickers and black die-cut flowers, as shown.



Project 3: Happy Life- Left page



Prepare:

- Draw dashed lines along the bottom of 3G, 3H, 3I, 3J and 3K.

Tip: For more precise dashed lines, use a ruler to draw the lines. For a more organic look, hand draw the dashed lines.



Assemble:

1. Use the light side of Ballerina cardstock for the base page.
2. Attach 3A flush with the left side of the base page.
3. Attach 3B and 3C.
4. Attach 3D.
5. Attach 3E and 3F leaving 1/8" gap between them.
6. Attach 3G, 3H, 3I, 3J and 3K leaving 1/8" gaps between them.
7. Attach the bike, applying adhesive only to the bottom part of the wheels.
8. Attach the "HAPPY Life" sticker with 3-D foam tape.

Tip: Leave the backing on the tape at the top of "HAPPY" where it overlaps the photo mat to easily slip a photo behind it. Once the photo is stuck down, remove the backing from the 3-D foam tape and press it onto the photo to attach it.



9. Decorate with extra stickers and black die-cut flowers, as shown.

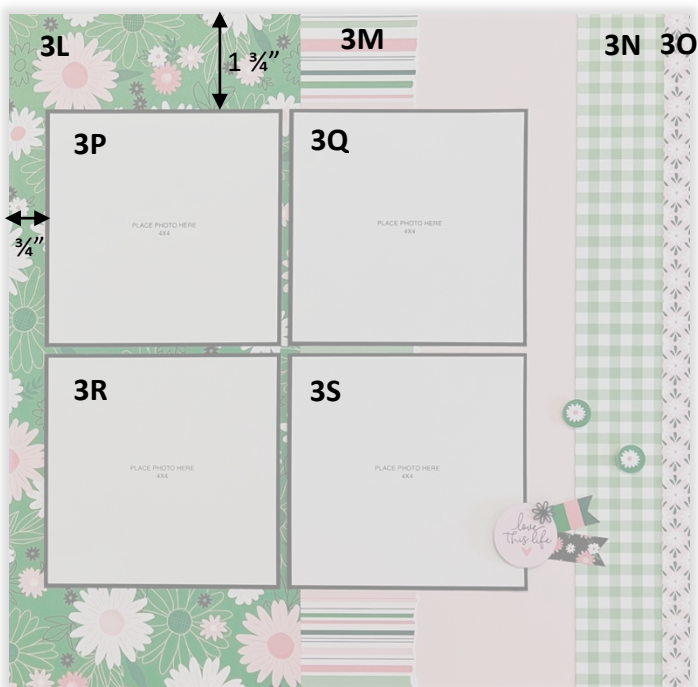
Project 3: Happy Life- Right page



Prepare:

- Tear approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " of the right side of 3M revealing the white core of the patterned paper.

Tip: For a more precise tear, rip the paper along the edge of a ruler. For a more organic tear, use your fingers to tear the paper.















Assemble:

1. Use the light side of Ballerina cardstock for the base page.
2. Attach 3L flush with the left side of the base page.
3. Attach prepared 3M flush with 3L.
4. Attach 3O flush with the right side of the base page.
5. Attach 3N flush with 3O.
6. Attach 3P, 3Q, 3R and 3S.
7. Build the "love this life" sticker cluster and attach with thin 3-D foam tape. Use a micro glue dot to attach the black die-cut flower
8. Decorate with extra stickers, as shown.

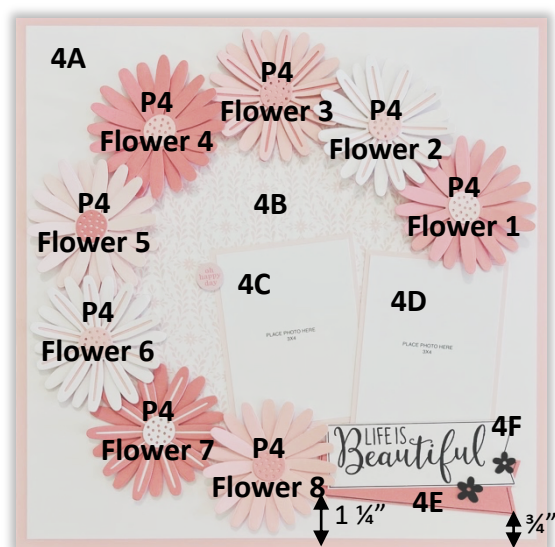
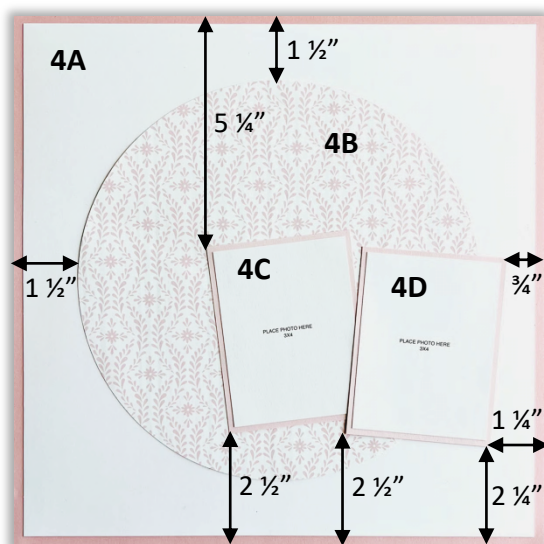


Project 4: Life is Beautiful – Thin-cut daisies: Layers and colours

Follow the table below to assemble the 8 layered daisies that will be used on the single page layout on the next page of this guide (p. 15).

Project 4: Life is Beautiful- single-page layout



Prepare:

1. Assemble the 8 daisies following the table on the previous page (p. 14).

Tip: When layering the daisy with the slit petals on top of the full-petal daisy (e.g. flowers 2, 3, 6 and 7), attach them together by placing a micro glue dot under the tip of each petal of the top daisy and in the centre of the daisy, lining up the 2 layers and pressing together to adhere them. Attach the daisy centres using the dual-tip multi-bond glue pen.

2. Stamp "LIFE IS Beautiful" in intense black ink on 4F.
3. Dovetail the right sides of 4E and 4F.
4. Doodle a line inside the edges of 4E and 4F, as shown.

Tip: For a more precise doodle, use a ruler to draw the lines. For a more organic doodle, hand draw the lines.

Assemble:

1. Use Ballerina cardstock for the base page.
2. Attach 4A in the centre of the base page leaving 1/4" edge around the outside.
3. Attach 4B.
4. Attach 4C and 4D.
5. Attach prepared 4E and 4F.
6. Attach the 8 flowers in order, following the edge of 4B, overlapping flower 1 onto 4D and flower 8 onto 4C as shown. Use thin 3-D foam tape and 3-D foam tape to attach the flowers and to achieve different heights.
7. Decorate with sticker and black die-cut flowers, as shown.

Project 5: You're Amazing



Prepare:

- Stamp "You're Amazing" in intense black ink on 5E.
- Assemble the flower (P5).
- Dovetail the other end of the green check sticker and cut it in half. Stick one piece on top of the other with the dovetails at the same end, splayed out, as shown.



Assemble:

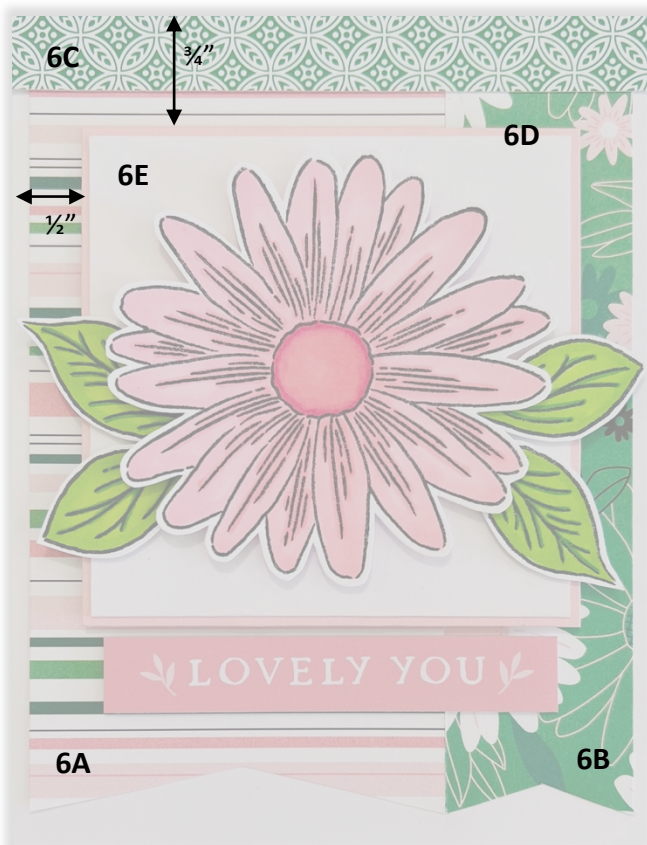
1. Attach 5A.
2. Attach 5B at 1/8" from the left edge, top and bottom of the card.
3. Adhere the prepared green check sticker on the underside of 5E on the right side, as shown.
4. Attach 5D and 5E to 5C, leaving a small, even edge around the outside and between 5D and 5E as shown.
5. Attach the flower (P5) in the centre of 5D using 3-D foam tape.
6. Decorate with black die-cut flowers, as shown.

Project 6: Lovely You



Prepare:

- Stamp the large daisy and 2 of the leaf clusters in black on P6.
- Cut out the daisy and leaves with scissors.
- Colour the daisy centre with the Pale Pink Shades marker (light and mid).
- Colour the daisy petals with the Pale Pink Shades marker (mid to colour the petals and dark to trace over the veins).
- Colour the leaves with the Alpine Green marker (light for the leaves and mid to trace over the veins).
- Dovetail 6A and 6B.



Assemble:

1. Attach 6A flush with the top of the card and approximately 1/8" from the left side of the card base.
2. Attach 6B flush with the top of the card and approximately 1/8" from the right side of the card base.
3. Attach 6C flush with the top of the card.
4. Attach 6D with 3-D foam tape.
5. Attach 6E in the centre of 6D leaving a small edge around the outside, as shown.
6. Attach the leaves with thin 3-D foam tape.
7. Attach the flower with 3-D foam tape.
8. Attach the "LOVELY YOU" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape.

Project 7: Smile All Around



Prepare:

- Stamp the bunch of daisies in intense black ink on 7I.
- Colour the daisy centres with the Pale Pink Shades marker (mid).
- Colour the daisy petals with the Pale Pink marker (use mid closest to the centre and light to blend out to the tips of the petals).
- Colour the leaves with the Alpine Green marker (light and mid).
- Dovetail the right side of 7B, 7C, 7D, 7E, 7F and 7G.
- Dovetail the right side of the "smiles all around" sticker.

Assemble:

1. Attach 7A.
2. Attach dovetailed 7B, 7C, 7D, 7E, 7F and 7G on the right side of 7A, overlapping each piece, as shown.
3. Attach 7H with 3-D foam tape.
4. Attach 7I, centred on 7H.
5. Attach the "smiles all around" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape.
6. Decorate with black die-cut flowers, as shown.

Tip: For a different look, leave the bunch of daisies black & white, or perhaps stamp them in a coordinating colour such as Flamingo.
