**Getting Started:**

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

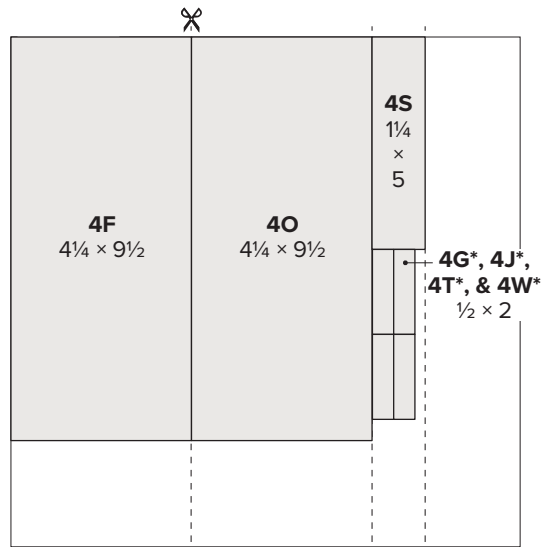
Shortbread cardstock

## Project 1:



## Prepare:

- Attach 1B to 1A
- Stamp slash line border above 1B with Charcoal ink, as shown
- Stamp grid background on 1A with Mulberry ink, as shown  
*Tip: Stamp in a circle, approx. 9½" in diameter.*
- Stamp heart border along one short edge of 1R with Charcoal ink
- Stamp dotted line border on 1R with Charcoal ink to form journaling lines
- Attach prepared 1R to 1Q, as shown
- Punch a hole in 1Q, then thread 1S through, as shown
- Dovetail the flat ends of 1E, 1G, 1H, 1J, 1L, 1M, and 1O, as shown



## Assemble:

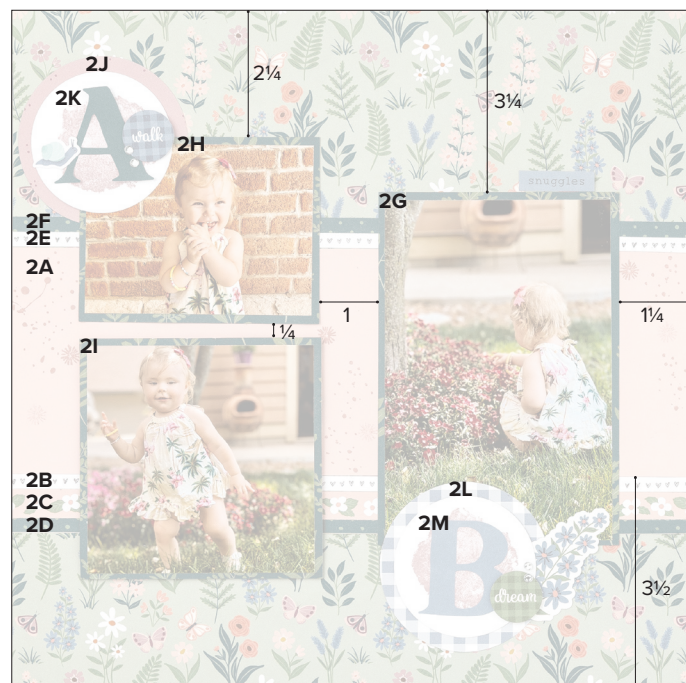
1. Use Charcoal woodgrain paper for base page
2. Attach P1 light Shortbread circle accents to base page
3. Attach prepared 1A
4. Attach 1C
5. Attach 1D–1O, as shown  
*Tip: Lay all the pieces out, first, and arrange them as desired before attaching.*
6. Attach 1P with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Only use foam tape along the top, bottom, and right edge to form a pocket for another piece.*
7. Attach photo  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
8. Attach sticker title, as shown
9. Attach 1T, as shown
10. Embellish with stickers, wood stickers, and clear sparkles  
*Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the "little darling" sticker slightly behind the photo, as shown.*
11. Add journaling to prepared 1Q tag, then tuck into pocket behind 1P, as shown

## Project 2: Left Page



## Prepare (for both pages):

- Stamp large splatter, small splatter, and burst on 2A and 2N with Mulberry ink, as shown  
*Tip: Use first and second-generation stamping.*  
*Technique: Ink the stamp in Mulberry and stamp it on the cardstock. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock again for a lighter, second-generation, image.*
- Stamp heart border on 2B, 2E, 2O, and 2R with Charcoal ink
- Stamp large puddle on 2K, 2M, 2X, and 2Z with Mulberry ink

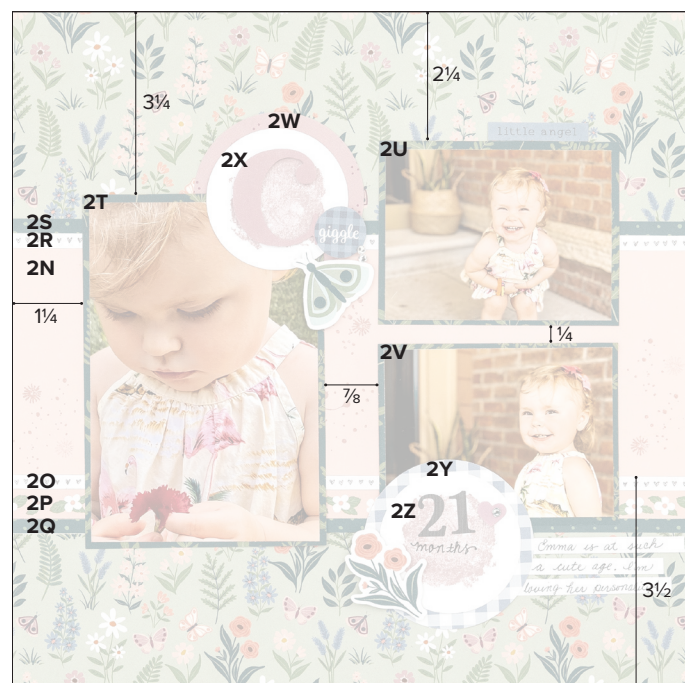


## Assemble:

1. Use Sage floral paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 2A, prepared 2B, 2C, 2D, prepared 2E, and 2F
3. Attach 2G and 2H  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner of 2H so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach 2I with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 2J, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 2H.*
6. Attach photos
7. Attach a prepared 2K, as shown
8. Attach 2L and prepared 2M, as shown
9. Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
10. Embellish with sparkles



## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Sage floral paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 2N, prepared 2O, 2P, 2Q, prepared 2R, and 2S
3. Attach 2T, 2U, and 2V  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right corner of 2T so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach 2W, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 2T.*
5. Attach photos
6. Attach prepared 2X, as shown
7. Attach 2Y and prepared 2Z, as shown
8. Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. Embellish with sparkles
10. Add journaling

## Project 3: Left Page



## Prepare (for both pages):

- Stamp dotted background on 3G, 3H, and 3Q with Charcoal ink  
*Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique.*  
*Technique: Ink the stamp in Charcoal and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock.*
- Stamp curved swash on 3P, approx. 1" from top, with Sage ink
- Stamp dashed journaling lines on 3P with Charcoal ink, as shown
- Stamp grid on 3I with Linen ink
- Trim Shortbread border sticker to 2¾" and attach to 3P, as shown



## Assemble:

- Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, and 3D
- Attach 3E and 3F  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right of 3F so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- Attach photos
- Stamp large puddle on base page with Mulberry ink, as shown  
*Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique.*  
*Technique: Ink the stamp in Mulberry and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the base page.*
- Stamp medium puddle and small splatter on base page with Linen ink, as shown
- Attach prepared 3G, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 3F.*
- Attach prepared 3H and 3I, as shown  
*Tip: Attach 3I with 3-D foam tape.*
- Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- Embellish with wood sticks and sparkles



## Project 3: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Shortbread gingham paper for base page
2. Attach 3J, 3K, and 3L
3. Attach 3M, 3N, and 3O
4. Attach prepared 3P  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach prepared 3Q and 3R, as shown  
*Tip: Attach 3R with 3-D foam tape.*
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
8. Embellish with wood stickers and sparkles
9. Add journaling

## Project 4: Left Page



**Prepare (for both pages):**

- Stamp dotted border on 4A and 4M with Charcoal ink, as shown
- Attach 4B to 4A, along back side of top right corner
- Fold prepared corner of 4A down, approx. 1¼"
- Attach prepared folded corner of 4A with a brad  
*Tip: Pierce through all the paper layers, approx. ¼" from the point, first.*
- Attach 4N to 4M, along back side of bottom right corner
- Fold prepared corner of 4N up, approx. 1¼"
- Attach prepared folded corner of 4N with a brad  
*Tip: Pierce through all the paper layers, approx. ¼" from the point, first.*
- Stamp splatter and puddle stamps on center right side and lower left corner of 4A with Sage ink, as shown
- Stamp splatters and puddle stamps on right side of 4M with Sage ink, as shown
- Stamp dashed background on 4E and 4Q with Charcoal ink, and dovetail, as shown
- Cut three pieces from Sage border sticker: 4¼", 3¾", and ¾"  
*Tip: Leave these on the carrier sheet until ready to use.*



### Assemble:

1. Use New England Ivy plaid paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 4A
3. Attach 4C
4. Dovetail and attach 4D
5. Attach prepared 4E
6. Attach 4F with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Attach photos
8. Attach prepared ¾" and 3¾" Sage border stickers, as shown
9. Attach two 1" light shortbread and one 1" light Sage cardstock circle accents, as shown
10. Attach 4G, 4H, 4I, 4J, 4K, and 4L
11. Embellish with additional stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck "our new arrival" sticker slightly behind 4F, as shown.*
12. Embellish with wood stickers



## Project 4: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use New England Ivy plaid paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 4M
3. Attach 4O with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach 4P, prepared 4Q, and 4R
5. Dovetail and attach 4S
6. Attach photos
7. Attach prepared 4 1/4" Sage border sticker, as shown
8. Attach 4T, 4U, 4V, 4W, 4X, and 4Y
9. Attach one 1" Shortbread and two 1" light Sage cardstock circle accents, as shown
10. Embellish with additional stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
11. Embellish with wood stickers
12. Add journaling
