## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of two stacked paper pieces before running the paper through your diecutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

- Stamp confetti on both base pages (French Vanilla cardstock) with Lagoon ink, $1^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom of the left base page and $1^{1 "}$ from the right edge of the right base page, as shown


## Assemble:

1. Use prepared French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1 A
3. Attach all P1 square and triangle part accents, as shown Tips: With a pencil, lightly draw the six guidelines shown (in red) on the labeled image, and then use these to arrange and form your squares. Once your pieces are all attached, erase any visible leftover pencil lines.
4. Attach photo, as shown
5. Stamp confetti dots on base page with Sundance ink, as shown
6. Embellish with stickers

Tip: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Add journaling


## Assemble:

1. Use prepared French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1 B and 1 C
3. Attach 1D, 1E, and 1F
4. Attach all P1 square and triangle accents, as shown Tips: With a pencil, lightly draw the four guidelines shown (in red) on the labeled image, and then use these to arrange and form your squares. Once your pieces are all attached, erase any visible leftover pencil lines.
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with stickers, silver glitter arrow die-cut, and white acrylic arrow
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic arrow with glue dots.

3. Attach 31 and 3 J
4. Attach 3K, 3L, 3M, and 3N
5. Attach prepared P3 triangle accents, as shown
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers and Sapphire glitter die-cuts Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

1. Use Sapphire confetti paper for base page
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach prepared 4B, 4C, 4D, and 4E
4. Attach 4F
5. Attach photo
6. Build bullseye accents, as shown, on P4 French Vanilla cardstock 2" $\times 2$ " squares
7. Stamp confetti dots on prepared bullseye accents with Lagoon ink, as shown
8. Attach prepared bullseye accents, as shown
9. Embellish with stickers and "MAKE A Wish" silver glitter diecut and white acrylic shape
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shape with glue dots.
10. Add journaling
