Materials Needed:

- Journey Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Harbour Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Mocha Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Honey Butter Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Seabrook Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Peach Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Papaya Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Paprika Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- My Acrylix® Block (suggested sizes: 2x2, 3X3 and 2X6.5)
- Blending Brush
- Masking Tape
- 12" Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- 3-D Foam Tape

Getting started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- All measurements are listed in the cutting guide, as well as below are the H x W.
- Start by placing a post-it note, or small piece of paper, with the project #'s on them, as this will be where you place all the pieces once they are cut.
- Cut all the papers according to the cutting guide and add them to the correct layout pile.
- The stencils are applied in an order, it might be helpful to add the # (1,2,3,4) in the same spot on the stencil with a Sharpie or label maker to keep track of the order

Cutting Guide Key:

- #= use reverse side of paper
- P= project #
- DT = dovetail
- STC= stamp & thin cut

Project 1- make 4



Prepare (4 each):

- Stencil with the Plaid A2 size stencil, using Mocha ink for each of the steps, 1-4 on the White Daisy pieces
- Envelope treatment- mask off 1" on the left side of the front of the envelope and add the stencil treatment 1-4 with Mocha ink
- Stamp sentiment with Journey ink

Assemble:

- Attach the Mocha as the background
- Attach the Journey cardstock
- Attach the stenciled White Daisy
- Attach the two dovetailed Journey pieces
- Attach the Honey Butter
- Attach the stenciled White Daisy
- Attach sentiment, on 3-D Foam tape
- Embellish as in photo of all 4 cards

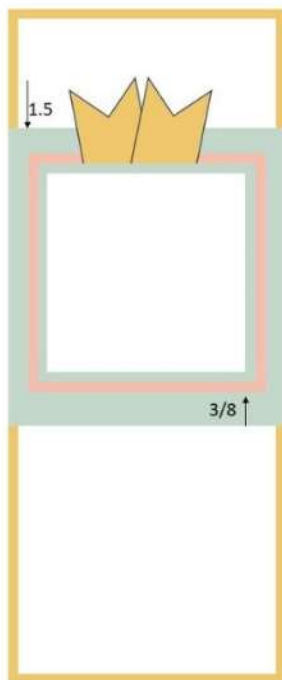


Project 2- make 4



Prepare (4 each):

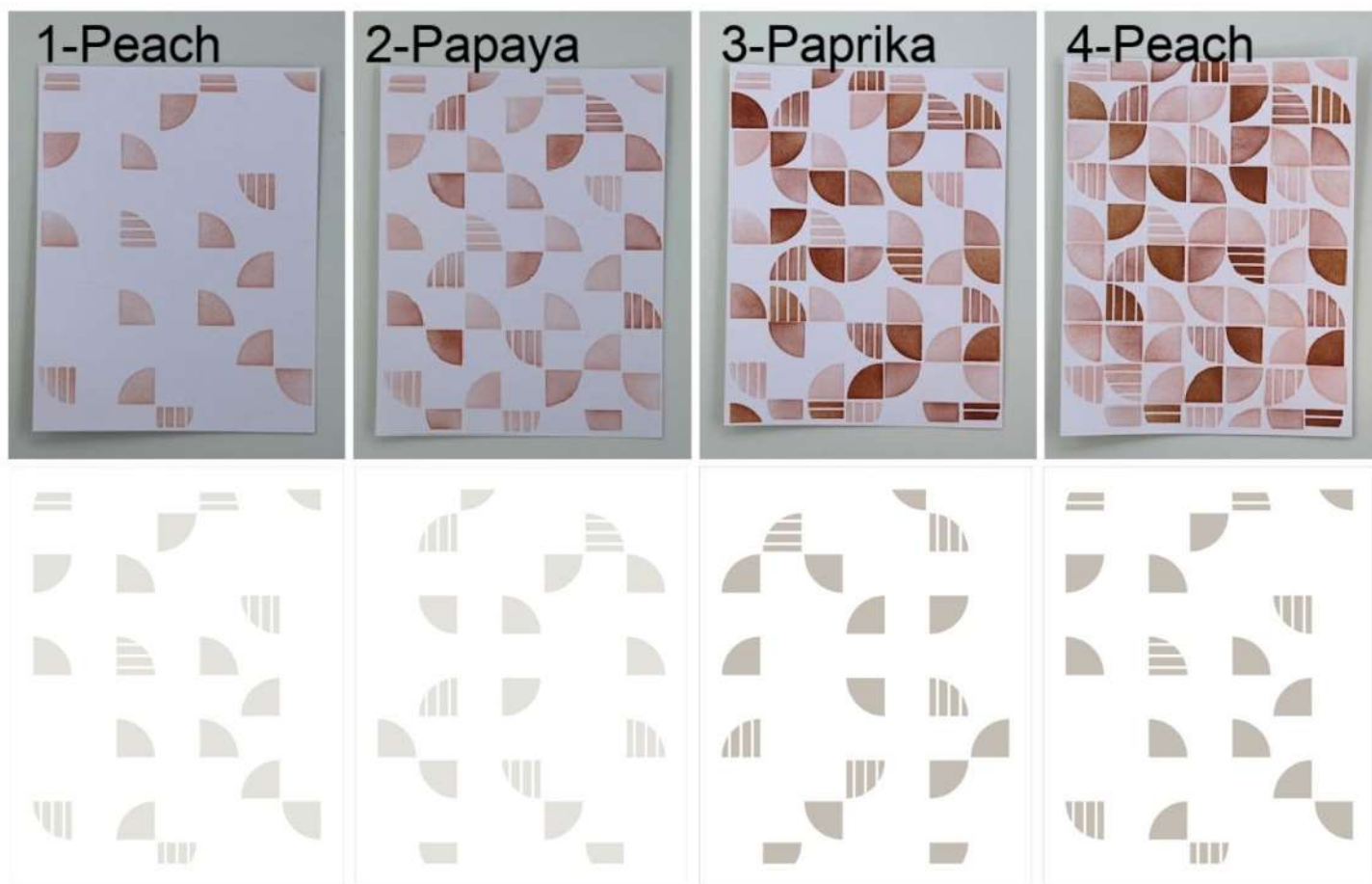
- Stencil with the Plaid Slimline size stencil, using Peach #1, Honey Butter #2, Peach #3, and Seabrook #4
- Envelope treatment- add the stencil treatment 1-4 on the back flap
- Stamp the sentiment in two tone stamping with the Peach on the top half and Seabrook on the bottom half



Assemble:

- Attach the Honey Butter as the background
- Attach the stenciled White Daisy
- Attach the Seabrook piece
- Attach the Peach piece
- Attach the two dovetailed Honey Butter pieces
- Attach the Seabrook piece with 3-D foam
- Attach sentiment
- Embellish as in photo of all 4 cards

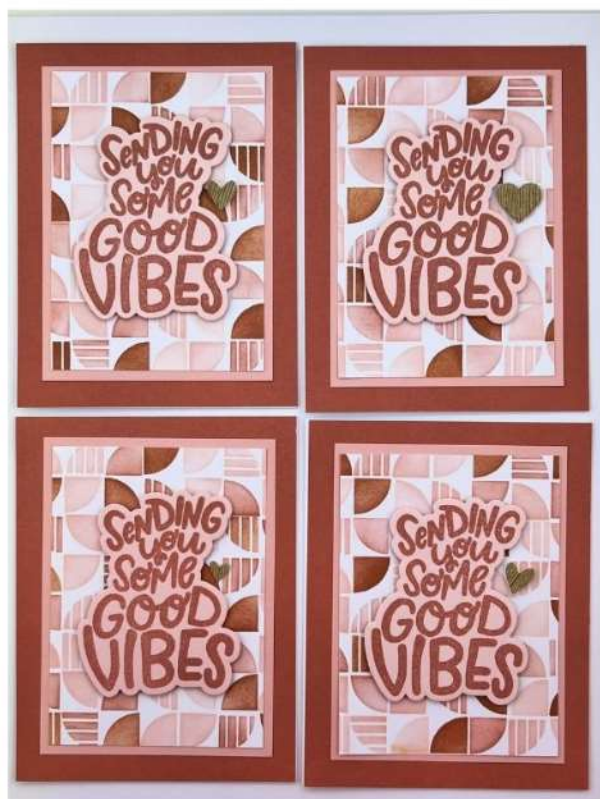
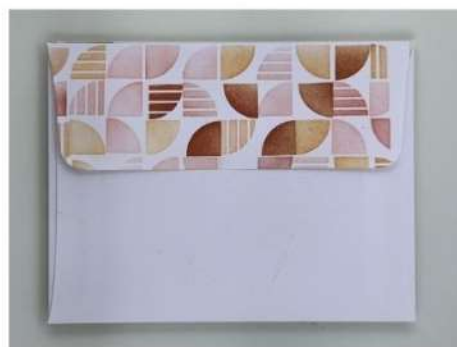
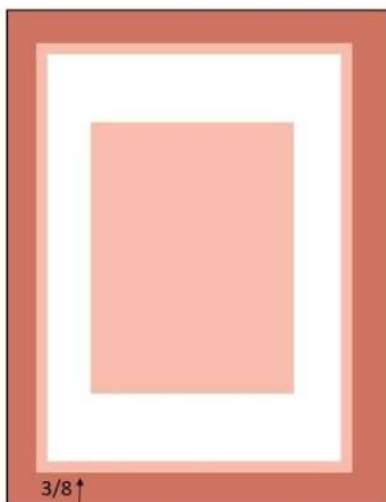
Project 3- make 4



Prepare (4 each):

- Stencil with the Quadrant A2 size stencil, using Peach #1, Papaya #2, Paprika #3, Peach #4
- Envelope treatment- Stencil the back flap of the envelope in the same order
- Stamp the sentiment with Papaya ink

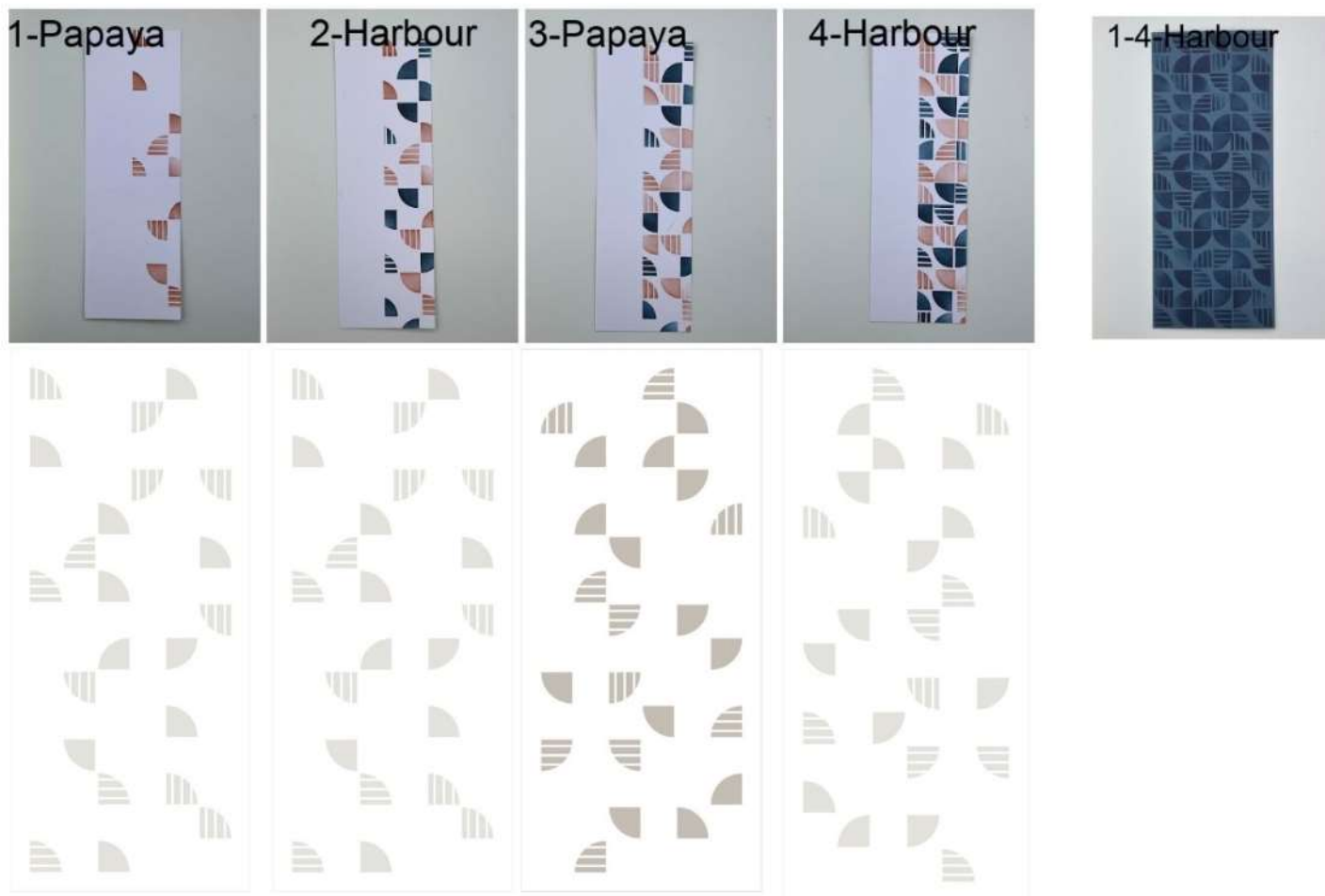
Project 3- make 4



Assemble:

- Attach the Papaya as the background
- Attach the Peach
- Attach the stenciled White Daisy
- Attach sentiment, on 3-D Foam tape
- Embellish as in photo of all 4 cards

Project 4- make 4



Prepare (4 each):

- Stencil with the Quadrant Slimline size stencil, using Papaya #1, Harbour #2, Papaya #3, and Harbour #4
- Envelope treatment- mask off the bottom 1' of the front of the envelope add the stencil treatment 1-4
- Stencil the light side of Harbour with all 4 steps of the Quadart stencil in Harbour
- Stamp the sentiment with Harbour ink

Project 4- make 4



Assemble:

- Attach the Harbour as the background
- Attach the Papaya
- Attach the stencilled White Daisy
- Embellish as in photo of all 4 cards
