## Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
-Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

Ink: Mink
Tip: Dovetail.

## P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: crab
Ink: Smoothie
Tips: Use second-generation, rock \& roll, and kissing stamping techniques.
Techniques: First, ink the stamp in Smoothie, stamp it on a scratch piece of paper, and then gently roll the outer edges (claws) in Smoothie, again. Then, press the un-inked heart stamp (mounted on a block) to the center of the crab stamp. Stamp crab on cardstock.

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A
3. Dovetail and attach 1B and 1C
4. Attach 1 D with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 1E to 1D
6. Attach crab accent with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with ribbon

Tip: Attach with glue dot.


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach $2 A$ and $2 B$
3. Attach 2 D to 2 C
4. Embellish 2 C with prepared ribbon

Tips: Cut ribbon in half. Attach one of the halves across 2C, as shown, and secure on back with glue dots. Tie the other half into a knot, trim as desired, and attach with a glue dot, as shown.
5. Attach 2 C with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach anchor accent with thin 3-D foam tape

Ink: Sapphire
Tip: Use kissing stamping technique to create the whale's belly
Technique: Ink whale stamp with Sapphire ink, then press the top of the un-inked shell stamp (mounted on a block) to the underbelly of the whale stamp. Stamp on cardstock.

2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, and 3D
3. Attach 3 E
4. Attach 3F, 3G, and 3H
5. Stamp sentiment with Mink ink, as shown
6. Attach anchor, whale, and shell accents with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with ribbon Tip: Attach with a glue dot.

Techniques: Ink the stamp in Mink, stamp on a scratch piece of paper, and then gently roll the outer edge in smoothie, again. Stamp on cardstock.

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Tear $1 / 4$ " $-1 / 2$ " from tops of $4 B, 4 C$, and $4 D$, then attach
4. Dovetail and attach banner accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
5. Attach shell and heart accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with ribbon Tip: Attach with a glue dot.
