Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

✂ = first cut | * = use back of paper

■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

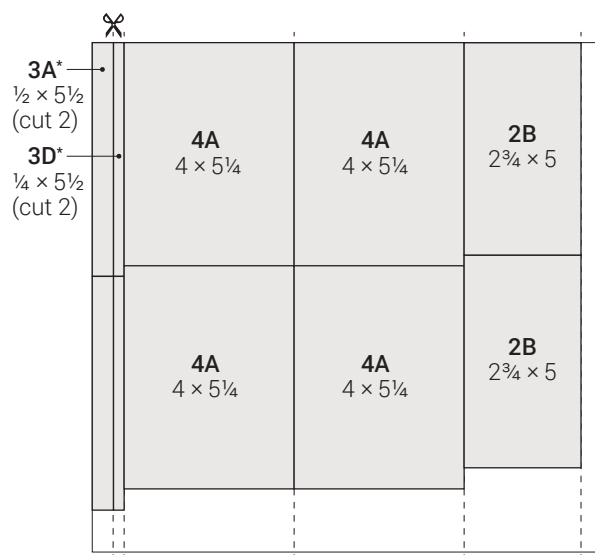
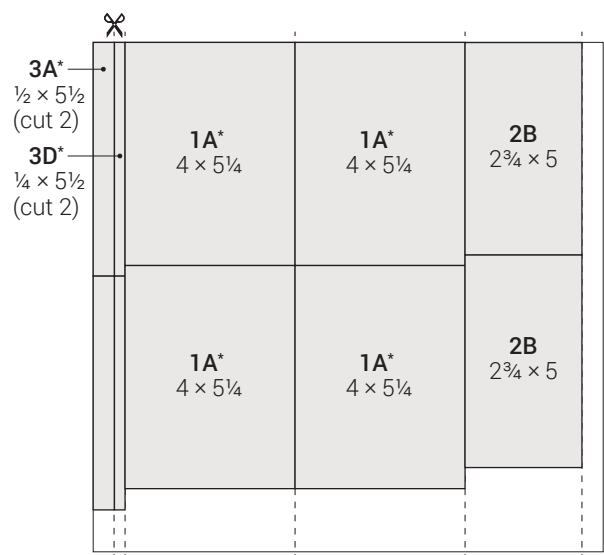

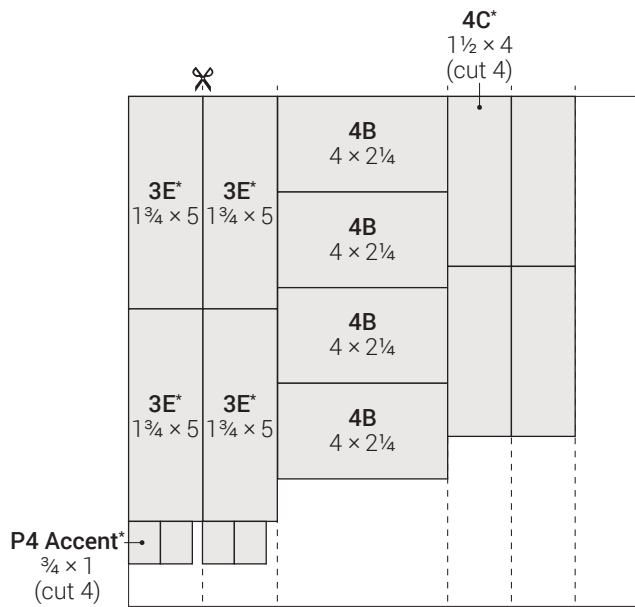


1E: $2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ (cut 4)



P4 Accents: $1 \times \frac{1}{2}$ (cut 8)



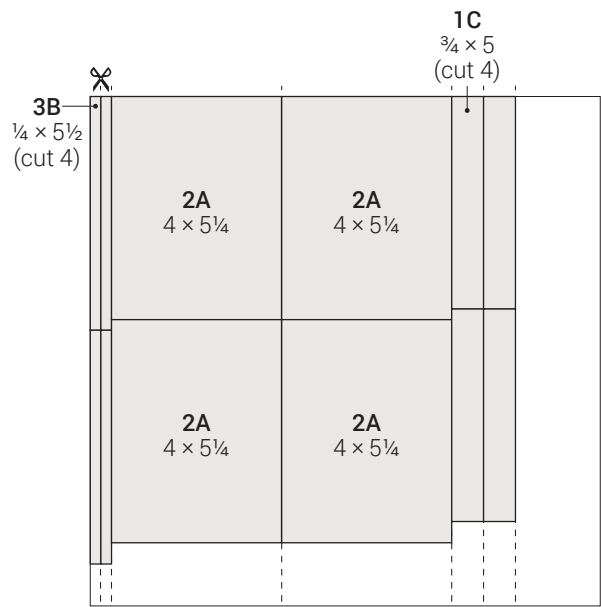

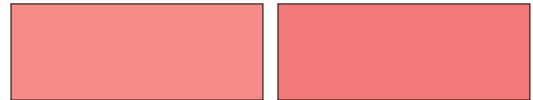

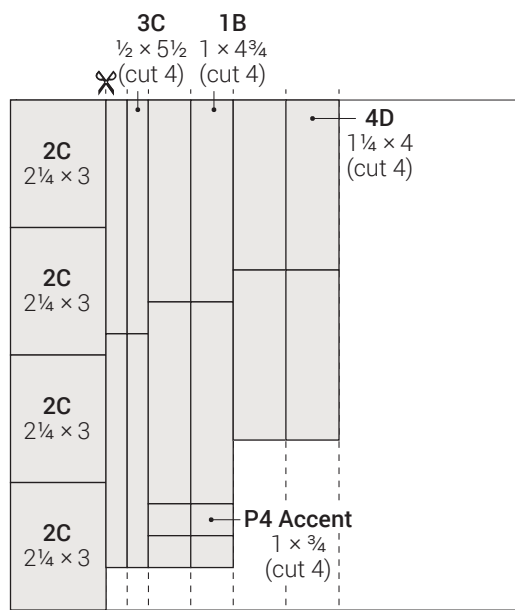


Smoothie cardstock

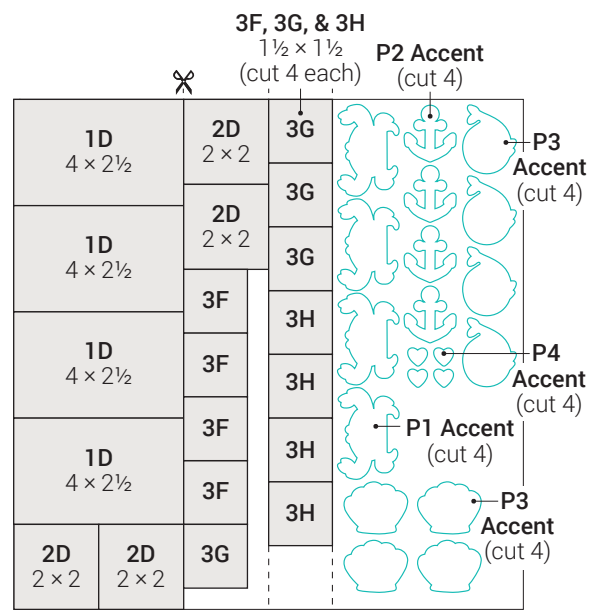


Sapphire cardstock

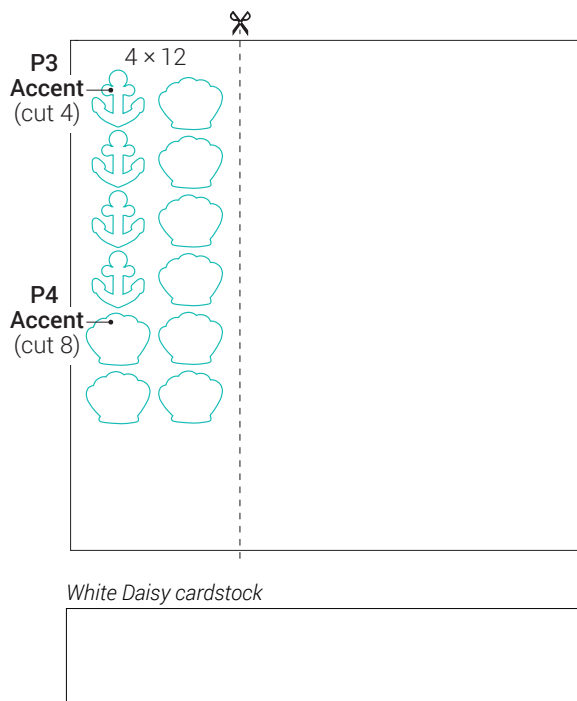

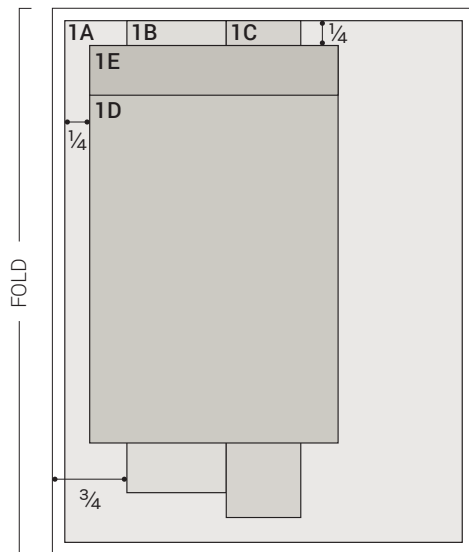

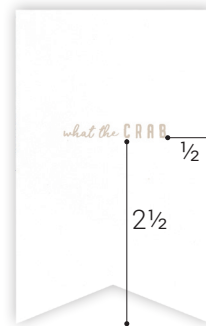

Project 1



Prepare (4 each):



1D:

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Mink
Tip: Dovetail.

P1 Accent:

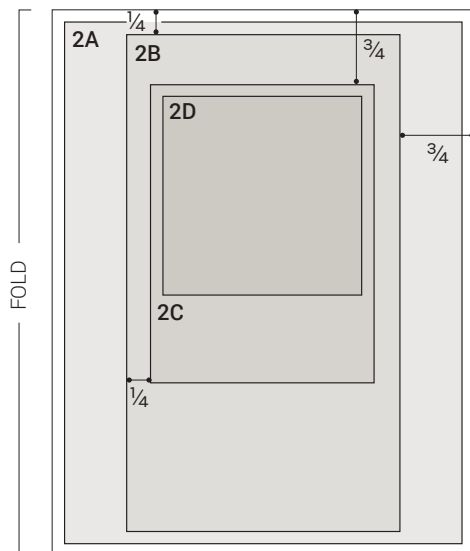
Paper: White Daisy
Die: crab
Ink: Smoothie
Tips: Use second-generation, rock & roll, and kissing stamping techniques.
Techniques: First, ink the stamp in Smoothie, stamp it on a scratch piece of paper, and then gently roll the outer edges (claws) in Smoothie, again. Then, press the un-inked heart stamp (mounted on a block) to the center of the crab stamp. Stamp crab on cardstock.



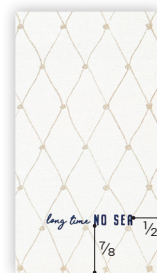
Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A
3. Dovetail and attach 1B and 1C
4. Attach 1D with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 1E to 1D
6. Attach crab accent with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with ribbon
Tip: Attach with glue dot.

Project 2



Prepare (4 each):



2B:
Paper: fishnet
Ink: Sapphire



P2 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Die: anchor
Ink: Sapphire



White Ribbon (6½"):

Ink: Smoothie

Tips: Alternate between first- and second-generation stamping to fill the length of the ribbon. Let dry for 30 minutes before using.

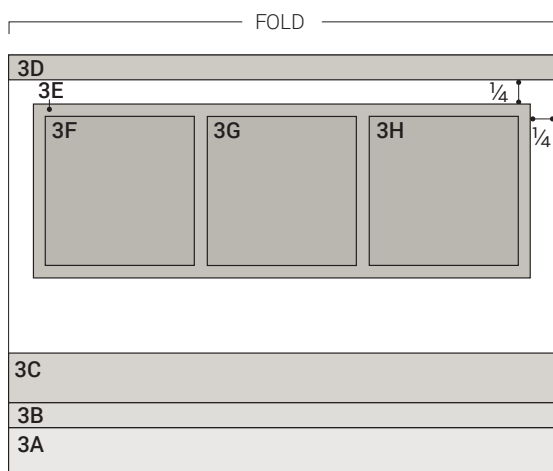
Technique: Ink stamp in Smoothie and stamp on ribbon. Then, without re-inking, stamp again on ribbon.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. Attach 2D to 2C
4. Embellish 2C with prepared ribbon
Tips: Cut ribbon in half. Attach one of the halves across 2C, as shown, and secure on back with glue dots. Tie the other half into a knot, trim as desired, and attach with a glue dot, as shown.
5. Attach 2C with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach anchor accent with thin 3-D foam tape

P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: anchor
Ink: Mink



P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: whale
Ink: Sapphire
Tip: Use kissing stamping technique to create the whale's belly.
Technique: Ink whale stamp with Sapphire ink, then press the top of the un-inked shell stamp (mounted on a block) to the underbelly of the whale stamp. Stamp on cardstock.



P3 Accent:

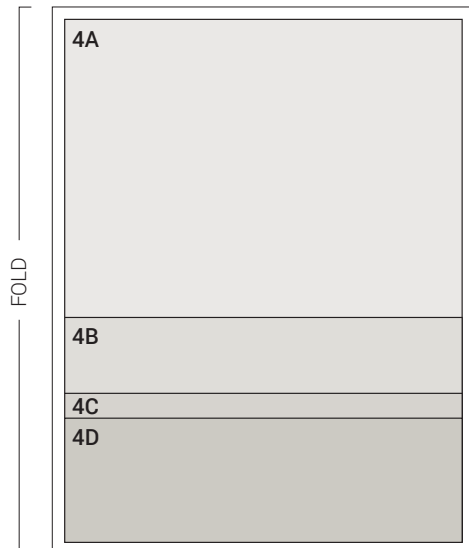
Paper: White Daisy
Die: shell
Ink: Smoothie
Tip: Use second-generation and rock & roll stamping techniques.
Techniques: Ink the stamp in Smoothie, stamp on a scratch piece of paper, and then gently roll the outer edge in smoothie, again. Stamp on cardstock.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, and 3D
3. Attach 3E
4. Attach 3F, 3G, and 3H
5. Stamp sentiment with Mink ink, as shown
6. Attach anchor, whale, and shell accents with thin 3-D foam tape
Tip: Attach with a glue dot.
7. Embellish with ribbon

Prepare (4 each):



4A:
Paper: fishnet
Ink: Sapphire



P4 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Die: shell
Ink: Mink
Tips: Use second-generation and rock & roll stamping techniques. Make 8 (2 per card).
Techniques: Ink the stamp in Mink, stamp on a scratch piece of paper, and then gently roll the outer edge in smoothie, again. Stamp on cardstock.



P4 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Die: heart
Ink: Mink



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Tear $\frac{1}{4}$ "– $\frac{1}{2}$ " from tops of 4B, 4C, and 4D, then attach
4. Dovetail and attach banner accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
5. Attach shell and heart accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with ribbon
Tip: Attach with a glue dot.
