## Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

✂ = first cut | \* = use back of paper | P= Project

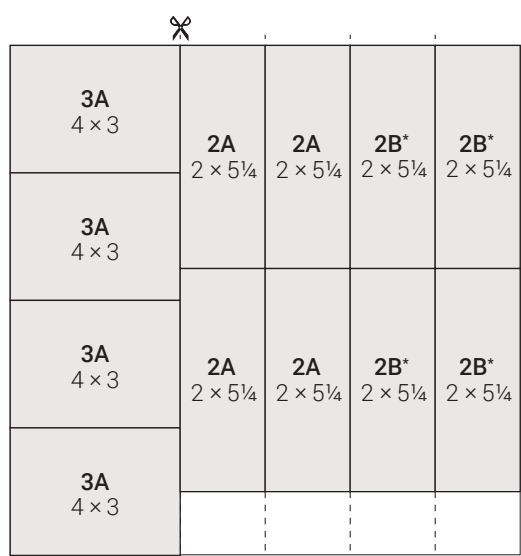
■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

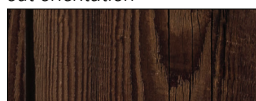

3B:  $4 \times \frac{1}{2}$  (cut 4)



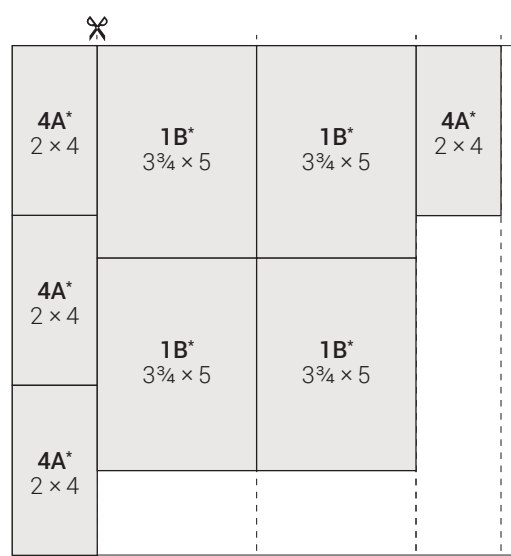
cut orientation

## Project 1

## Prepare (4 each):

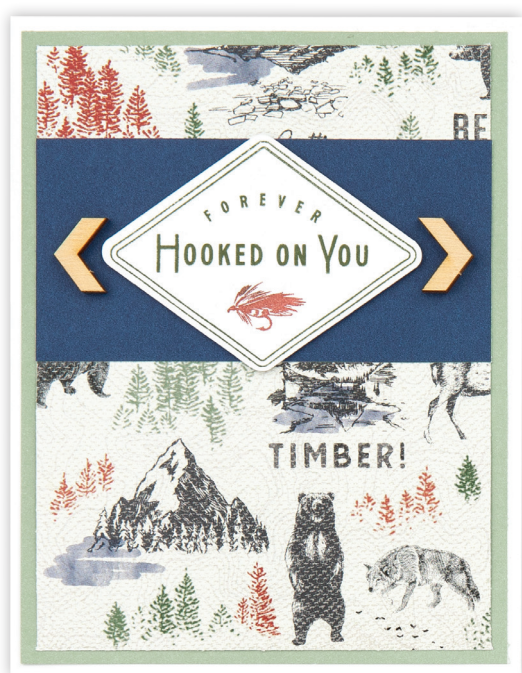


### P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: diamond

Inks: New England Ivy, Ruby  
Technique: Ink the stamp in New England Ivy, then sponge Ruby ink on the fly hook with a sponge dauber. Stamp on cardstock.

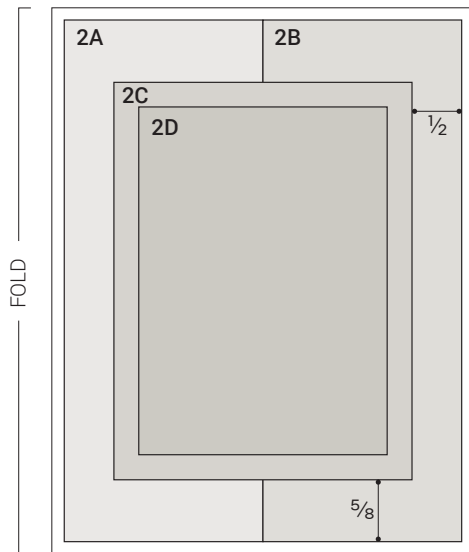


## Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C
4. Attach diamond accent with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with assorted wood arrows of your choice  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

## Prepare (4 each):



### 2D:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Sapphire, New England Ivy



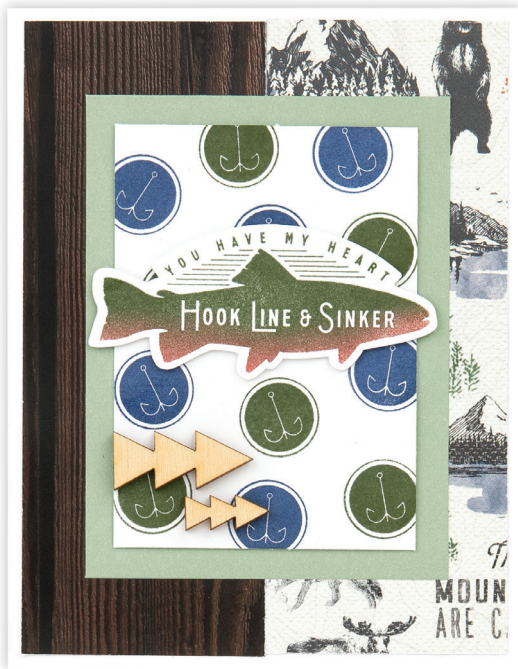
### P2 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: fish

Inks: New England Ivy, Ruby

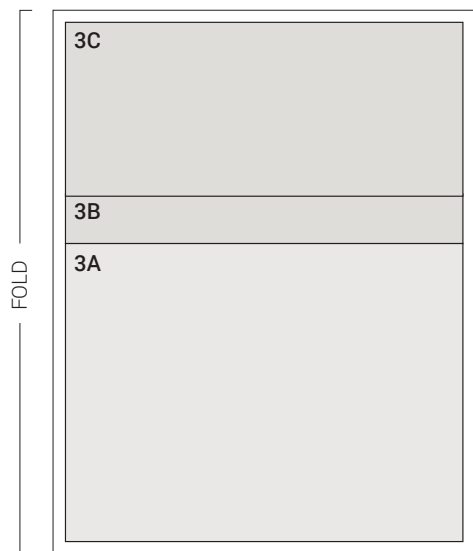
Technique: Ink the stamp in New England Ivy, then sponge Ruby ink along the bottom of the fish with a sponge dauber. Stamp on cardstock.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
  2. Attach 2A and 2B
  3. Attach 2C
  4. Attach 2D with thin 3-D foam tape
  5. Attach fish accent with thin 3-D foam tape
  6. Embellish with assorted wood arrows of your choice
- Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

## Project 3



## Prepare (4 each):



**3C:**  
Paper: light Sapphire  
Ink: Sapphire



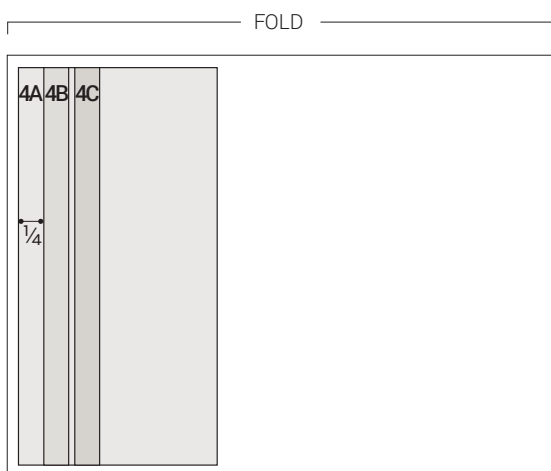
**P3 Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Die: rectangle  
Inks: Sapphire, Ruby  
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sapphire, then sponge Ruby ink on Sapphire, then sponge Ruby ink on "BAIT" with a sponge dauber. Stamp on cardstock.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, 3B, and 3C
3. Attach rectangle accent with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Embellish with assorted wood arrows of your choice  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

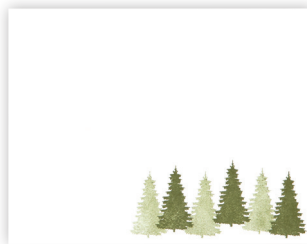
## Project 4



## Prepare (4 each):

### Card Base:

Paper: card base  
 Ink: New England Ivy  
 Tip: Use first- and second-generation stamping technique.  
 Technique: Ink stamp in New England Ivy and stamp on card base. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the card base again for a second-generation image. Repeat three times.



### P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
 Die: diamond  
 Inks: Sapphire, New England Ivy  
 Technique: Ink the stamp in Sapphire, then sponge New England Ivy ink on the fly hook with a sponge dauber. Stamp on cardstock.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A, 4B, and 4C
3. Attach diamond accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
4. Embellish with assorted wood arrows of your choice  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
