Materials Needed:

- G1225 Daisy Meadows Scrapbooking Workshop Kit
- Z3515 Black Journaling Pen (.01)
- Z3132 Watercolour Paints (optional)
- Z3225 Medium Round Waterbrush
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z1836 Non-stick Micro-tip Scissors
- Adhesive
- Trimmer

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

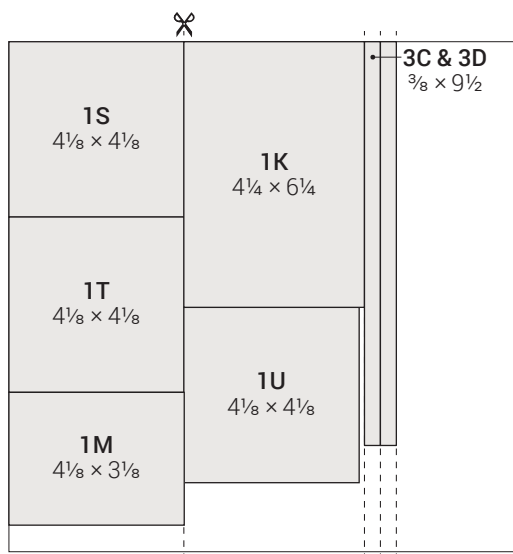

Project 1: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. (Optional) Add watercolour splatters with paint and waterbrush
Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with paint.
Technique: Gently squeeze the barrel of the brush to add water to the bristles. Pick up the paint colour of your choice, and then gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.
3. Attach 1A
4. Attach 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F, 1G, 1H, 1I, and 1J to large egg die-cut, then trim excess
5. Attach prepared egg die-cut to base page, as shown
6. Embellish with floral and leaf stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Attach 1K with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach 1L and 1M
9. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
10. Attach sticker title, as shown
Tip: Attach "Easter" with thin 3-D foam tape.
11. Embellish with additional stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
12. Embellish with dots

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. (Optional) Add watercolour splatters with paint and waterbrush
Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with paint.
Technique: Gently squeeze the barrel of the brush to add water to the bristles. Pick up the paint colour of your choice, and then gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.
3. Attach 1N
4. Attach sticker and die-cut wreaths, as shown
5. Attach 1Q, 1P, 1Q, and 1R
6. Attach 1S, 1T, and 1U
7. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Embellish with egg, stars, heart, and "On a Hunt" stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Add journaling to journaling die-cut and attach with thin 3-D foam tape
10. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. Embellish with dots

Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use Peacock lined paper for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B
 - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach photo
5. Attach yellow flower centers to back of large floral die-cut
6. Attach prepared floral die-cut, as shown
7. Embellish with additional die-cuts and stickers, as shown
 - Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck daisy die-cut slightly behind 2B.*
8. Embellish with dots

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Peacock lined paper for base page
2. Attach 2C
3. Attach yellow flower centers to back of large floral die-cut
4. Attach prepared floral die-cut, as shown
Tip: Trim any excess die-cut that hangs over the edge of the base page.
5. Attach 2D, 2E, and 2F
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right corner of 2F so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
6. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with journaling die-cut, as shown
8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck banner die-cuts slightly behind 2F.
9. Embellish with dots
10. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use multi-colour plaid paper for base page
2. (Optional) Paint edges of large bunny overlay die-cut and add watercolour splatter with paints and waterbrush
Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with paint.
Technique: Gently squeeze the barrel of the brush to add water to the bristles. Pick up the paint colour of your choice, and then gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.
3. Attach 3A to base page, $\frac{3}{4}$ " from right edge and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from top
4. Attach prepared bunny die-cut to base page with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
5. Attach large Peach gingham and Toffee diamond bunny die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach gingham bunny with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Attach 3B
7. Attach photo with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach 3C and 3D
9. Embellish with additional stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Embellish with dots
11. Add journaling

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use multi-colour plaid paper for base page
2. (Optional) Paint edges of large bunny overlay die-cut and add watercolour splatter with paints and waterbrush
Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with paint.
Technique: Gently squeeze the barrel of the brush to add water to the bristles. Pick up the paint colour of your choice, and then gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.
3. Attach 3E to base page vertically, $\frac{3}{4}$ " from left edge and 3" from top
4. Attach 3F to base page vertically, $\frac{3}{4}$ " from right edge and 3" from top
5. Attach prepared bunny die-cut to base page with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Attach 3G and 3H
7. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach Peach gingham and Toffee floral bunny die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
9. Embellish with remaining stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Embellish with dots
