## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

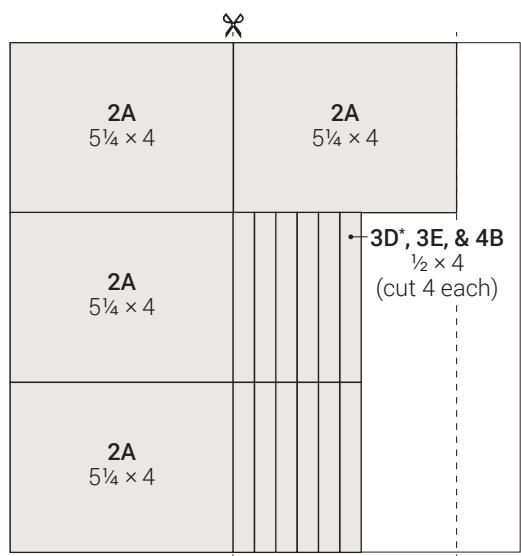
## Cutting Diagrams:

zip strips



3I:  $4\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$  (cut 4)

Tip: Cut the zip strip in half, into two  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, first. Then, cut four  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.



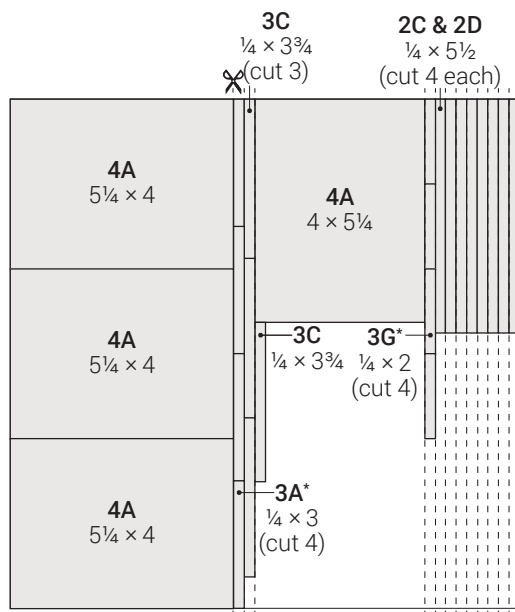

## Project 1: Make 4



## Prepare (4 each):



### Card Base:

Paper: card base  
Ink: Fern



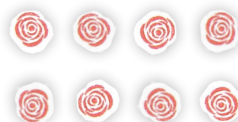
### 1B:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Fern  
Tip: Sponge ink along bottom, then stamp.



### P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
Die: gate  
Inks: Fern, Smoothie  
Tip: Sponge with Smoothie ink, then stamp vines of choice with Fern.



### P1 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy  
Die: rose  
Ink: Smoothie  
Tip: Make 8 per card.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1B to 1A
3. Attach gate accent to 1B, as shown
4. Stamp large leaf cluster without stem along archway with Fern ink, as shown  
*Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for lighter images.*  
*Technique: Ink the stamp in Fern and stamp it along the archway. Then, without re-inking, stamp along the archway again.*
5. Add leaf veins with journaling pen, as shown
6. Attach rose accents to archway with glue dots, as shown
7. Stamp sentiment with Intense Black ink, as shown
8. Attach 1A to card base with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Sponge wood heart with Smoothie ink
10. Attach wood heart with glue dot



## Project 2: Make 4

## Prepare (4 each):



### 2B:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Fern, Smoothie

Tip: Stamp the daisies and bird using the second-generation stamping technique.

Technique: Ink stamp in Smoothie and stamp on scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 2C.



### P2 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: banner

Ink: Intense Black, Smoothie

Tip: Sponge center with Smoothie ink.



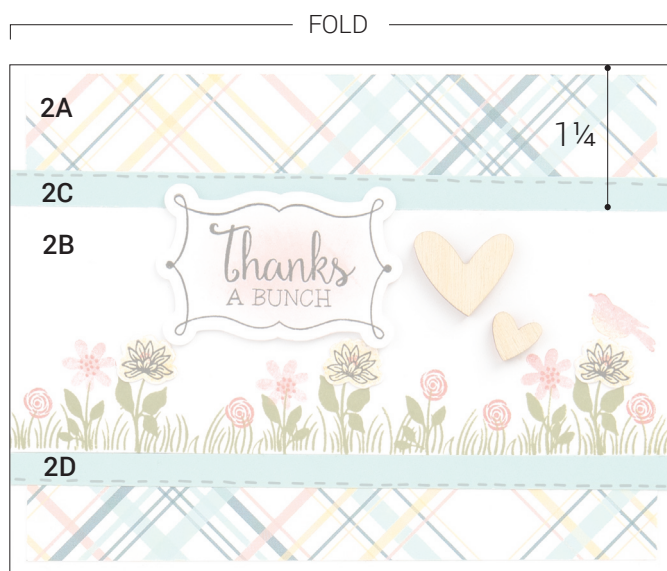
### P2 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: dahlia

Inks: Intense Black, Sundance

Tip: Sponge with Sundance ink, then stamp image with Intense Black.

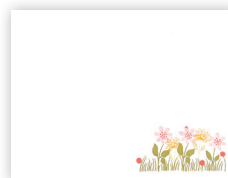


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B, 2C, and 2D  
*Tip: Draw stitch marks on 2B and 2D with a journaling pen, as shown.*
4. Attach dahlia accents, as shown
5. Attach banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with wood hearts  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

## Project 3: Make 4

## Prepare (4 each):



### Card Base:

Paper: card base

Inks: Fern, Smoothie, Sundance

Tip: Stamp daisy petals and two small flower stems using the second-generation stamping technique.

Technique: Ink stamp and stamp it on scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on card base.

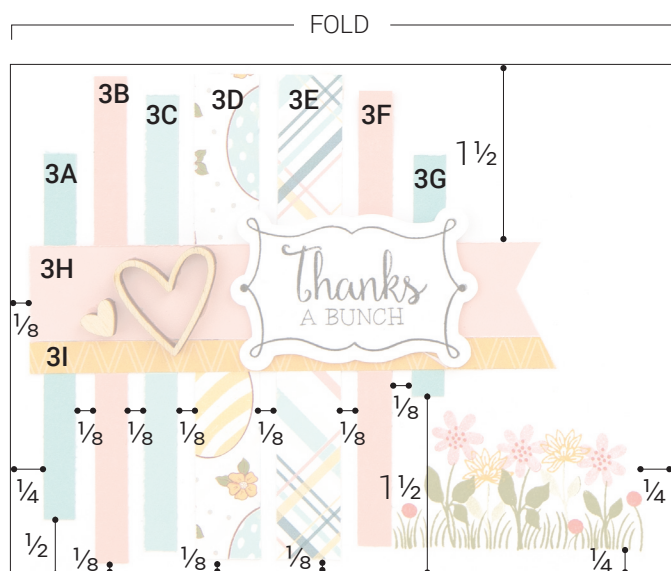


### P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: banner

Ink: Intense Black

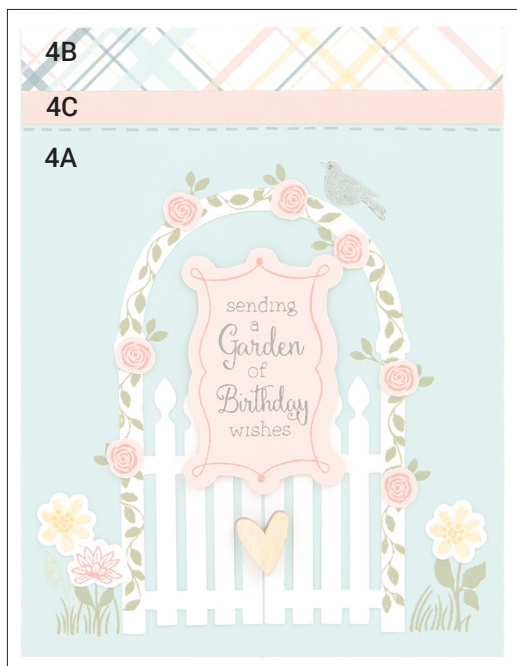


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F, and 3G
3. Dovetail 3H
4. Trim right edge of 3I to match dovetail of 3H, as shown
5. Attach 3H and 3I
6. Attach banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Embellish with wood hearts

*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

## Project 4: Make 4



## Prepare (4 each):



### P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: gate

Ink: Fern

Tip: Stamp with vines of choice.



### P4 Accent:

Paper: light Peach

Die: banner

Inks: Intense Black, Smoothie



### P4 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: daisy

Ink: Sundance

Tip: Stamp the daisy bases in Sundance ink using the second-generation stamping technique. Technique: Ink the stamp in Sundance ink and stamp it on scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the accent.



### P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: dahlia

Ink: Smoothie



### P4 Accents:

Paper: light Peach

Die: rose

Ink: Smoothie

Tip: Make 7 per card.

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A, as shown
3. Attach 4B and 4C, as shown
4. Attach gate accent, as shown
5. Stamp small leaves along archway with Fern ink, as shown
6. Stamp bird with Intense Black ink using second-generation stamping technique, as shown  
*Tip: Ink the stamp in Intense Black ink and stamp it on scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 4A.*
7. Attach rose accents, as shown
8. Stamp grass and flower stems on 4A with Fern ink, as shown  
*Tip: Stamp one large flower stem using the second-generation stamping technique.*  
*Technique: Ink the stamp in Fern ink and stamp it on scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 4A.*
9. Attach daisy accents, as shown
10. Attach dahlia accent, as shown
11. Attach banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
12. Draw stitch lines below 4C with journaling pen, as shown
13. Embellish with wood heart  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
