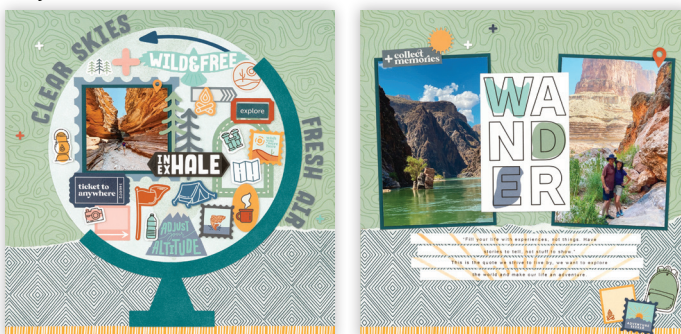

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

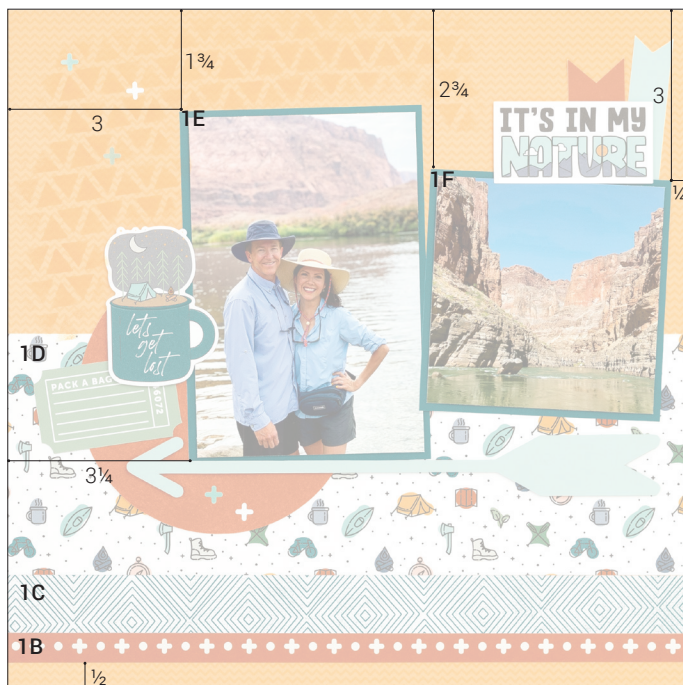
## Project 1: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Sundance chevron paper for base page
2. (Optional) Sponge triangles on White Daisy "LET'S GO" die-cut overlay with stencil and spiced marmalade ink, as shown  
*Tip: Secure the stencil in place with washi tape before sponging with the blending tool.*
3. Attach "L-E-T-'S-G-O" letter die-cuts to back of "LET'S GO" die-cut overlay, as shown  
*Tip: These letters can be left off if you want your photos to show through the letter outlines.*
4. Attach photos behind die-cut overlay, as shown
5. Attach prepared die-cut overlay to base page, as shown
6. Attach 1A
7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. The shorter Glacier arrow die-cut is used on this page.*
8. Add journaling

## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Sundance chevron paper for base page
2. (Optional) Sponge triangles on top left of base page with stencil and Spiced Marmalade ink, as shown  
*Tip: Secure the stencil in place with washi tape before sponging with the blending tool.*
3. Attach 1B, 1C, and 1D
4. Attach Paprika circle die-cut, as shown
5. Attach 1E
6. Attach photo to 1E with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach 1F  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
8. Attach photo to 1F with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck pennant die-cuts slightly behind 1F.*



## Project 2: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Peach watercolor paper for base page
2. (Optional) Sponge diamonds on top left corner and bottom center of base page with stencil and Spiced Marmalade ink, as shown  
*Tip: Secure the stencil in place with washi tape before sponging with the blending tool.*
3. Attach 2A
4. Attach pennant die-cuts to 2A, as shown
5. Attach photo to 2A with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach "TIME TO TRAVEL" die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Attach "TRAVEL" with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Attach Paprika chipboard die-cut frame to 2" x 2" photo, and attach
8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 2: Right Page

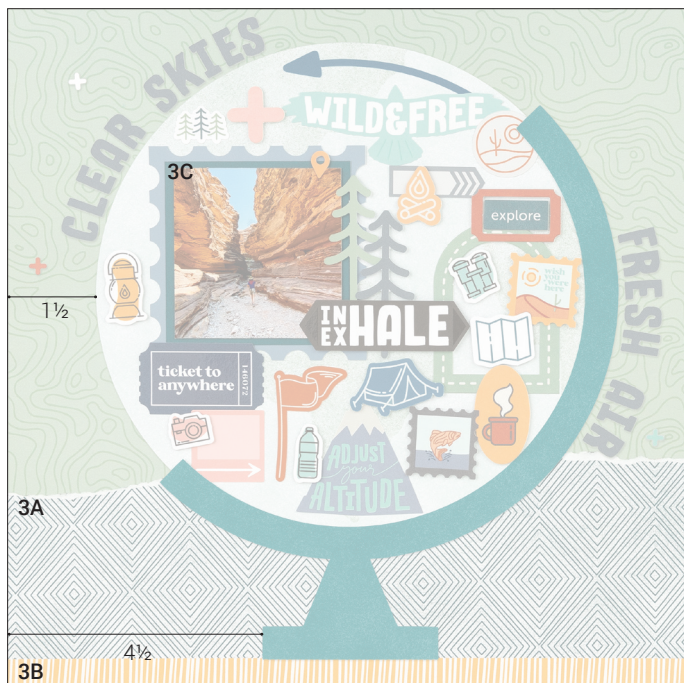


### Assemble:

1. Use Peach watercolor paper for base page
2. (Optional) Sponge diamonds on bottom right corner of base page with stencil and Spiced Marmalade ink, as shown  
*Tip: Secure the stencil in place with washi tape before sponging with the blending tool.*
3. Attach polka dot chipboard die-cut frame to 3" x 4" photo, and hand trim excess
4. Attach Charcoal chipboard die-cut frame to 3" x 3" photo, and hand trim excess
5. Attach mountain chipboard die-cut frame to 3" x 3" photo
6. Attach Paprika chevron arch die-cut
7. Attach prepared chipboard frames with photos, as shown
8. Attach 4" x 4" photo with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
10. Add journaling



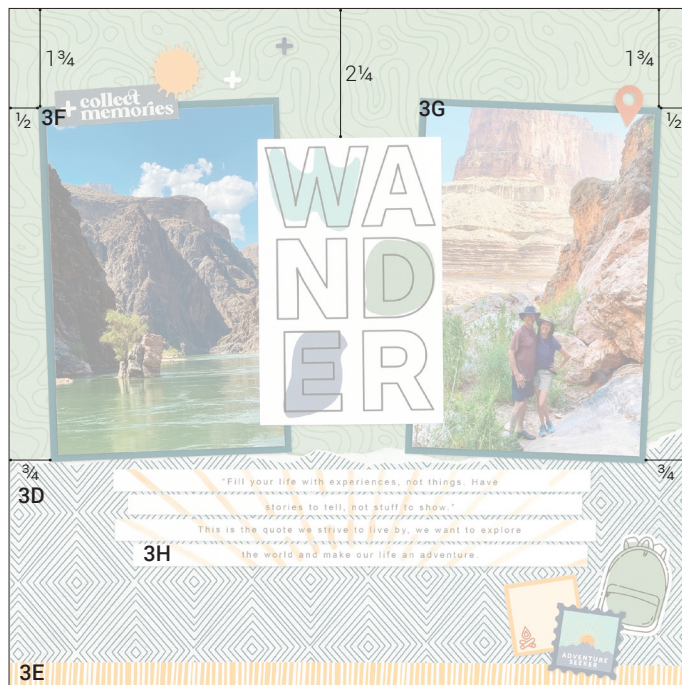
### Project 3: Left Page



#### Assemble:

1. Use Sage topographical map paper for base page
2. Tear approx. ½" to 1" off of 3A, as shown, and attach
3. Attach 3B, on top of 3A
4. Attach globe and stand die-cuts to base page, as shown
5. Attach 3C to postage stamp die-cut and attach to globe, as shown
6. Attach photo to 3C with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach "C-L-E-A-R-S-K-I-E-S" and "F-R-E-S-H-A-I-R" die-cuts around globe, as shown
8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 3: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Sage topographical map paper for base page
2. Tear approx.  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" off of 3D, as shown, and attach
3. Attach 3E, on top of 3D
4. Attach 3F and 3G
5. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
6. (Optional) Sponge sunburst on 3H with stencil and Spiced Marmalade ink, as shown  
*Tip: Secure the stencil in place with washi tape before sponging with the blending tool.*
7. Cut 3H into  $8\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $\frac{3}{8}$ " journaling strips, add journaling, and hand trim to desired lengths
8. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. Attach journaling
