Featured Technique: Embellishing with Die Cut Banners

## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

## P2 Accent

Paper: White Daisy
Die: maple leaf
Ink: Paprika

## Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 2 A and 2 B
3. Stamp dot border above 2B with Papaya ink, as shown
4. Stamp "GIVING THANKS" above dot border with Harbour ink, as shown
5. Stamp large leaf next to "GIVING THANKS" with Papaya ink, as shown
6. Attach maple leaf accent, as shown
7. Embellish with shimmer trim



3C:
Paper: White Daisy
Stamp: dot border
Inks: Papaya, Paprika, Shortbread Tip: Stamp two rows of the border in each colour. Begin on the left with Paprika, then Papaya, then Shortbread.

## P3 Accent:

Paper: Peach
Die: banner Ink: Paprika
Tip: Fold the banner along the score lines, as shown. Note which sections of the banner will be on top, then unfold the paper and stamp these sections.


## P3 Accents:

Paper: stripe
Dies: large branch, maple leaf Ink: Paprika


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, 3B, and 3C
3. Attach banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom right corner of the banner so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach large branch and maple leaf accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
5. Embellish with shimmer trim

Tip: Dovetail and tuck slightly behind the banner.

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Papaya

P4 Accents:
Paper: White Daisy
Dies: large branch, acorn branch Ink: Papaya

## P4 Accent

Paper: White Daisy
Die: large leaf Ink: Harbour

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Attach 4 C
4. Stamp dot border above 4C with Shortbread ink, as shown
5. Embellish with shimmer trim Tip: Trim a piece of shimmer trim to 3", then attach.
6. Attach 4D and 4E with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown Tip: 4E will overlap shimmer trim.
7. Attach leaf and branch accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
