#### **Getting Started:**


- · Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

#### **Project 1: Left Page**



#### (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

 Spray 1A and 1D with Gilt gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry

Tips: Spray the pieces from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



#### Assemble:

- 1. Use deer hide paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1A
- 3. Attach 1B to 1A
- 4. Attach 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
  Tip: Only use adhesive in the center so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. Attach photo
- 6. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few of these pieces behind 1C, as shown.
- 7. Add journaling

# **Project 1: Right Page**





## Assemble:

- 1. Use deer hide paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1D
- 3. Attach 1E to 1D
- 4. Attach holly border die-cut to 1D, as shown5. Attach 1F, 1G, 1H, and 1I with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photos
- 7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 8. Add journaling

#### **Project 2: Left Page**



#### (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

 Spray the journaling die-cut with Gilt gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry

Tips: Spray the die-cut from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



#### Assemble:

- 1. Use deer paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A and 2B
- 3. Attach 2C
- 4. (Optional) Draw border on 2C with white gel pen, as shown *Tip: Use 08 size pen.*
- 5. Attach 2D with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photo

- 7. Attach title die-cuts and stickers

  Tip: Attach "GOOD TIDINGS OF" sticker and "FOR" die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape.
- 8. Embellish with additional die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

#### **Project 2: Right Page**





#### Assemble:

- Use deer paper for base page
   Attach 2E and 2F
- 3. Attach 2G
- 4. (Optional) Draw border on 2G with white gel pen, as shown Tip: Use 08 size pen.
- 5. Attach 2H with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photos
- 7. Attach prepared journaling die-cut Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right corner of the die-cut so that other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few die-cut pieces slightly behind the journaling die-cut, as shown.
- 9. Add journaling

#### **Project 3: Left Page**



#### (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

 Spray large December die-cut overlay and right base page (White Daisy cardstock) with Gilt gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry

Tips: Spray these pieces from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



#### Assemble:

- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach Harbour plaid die-cut
- 3. Attach prepared large December die-cut overlay
- 4. Attach 3A

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge so that other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 5. Attach 3B
- 6. Dovetail and attach 3C
- 7. Attach circle die-cuts, as shown
  Tips: Tuck behind 3A. You may also cut the circles in half, at 1¼",
  before attaching.
- 8. Attach 3D with thin 3-D foam tape
- 9. Attach photos
- 10. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## **Project 3: Right Page**





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3E
- Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so that other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

  3. Dovetail and attach 3F
- 4. Attach 3G
- 5. Attach tag die-cuts
- 6. Attach 3H with thin 3-D foam tape
- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Attach circle die-cuts, as shown Tips: Tuck behind 3E. You may also cut the circles in half, at 1¼", before attaching.
- 9. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 10. Add journaling
