# **Getting Started:**


- · Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.



## **Project 1: Left Page**






#### Assemble:

- 1. Use exclusive flower paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1A and 1B
- 3. Attach large Sapphire circle die-cut
- 4. Attach 1C with 3-D foam tape

  Tip: Apply the foam away from the edges of 1C where other pieces will be tucked behind it in later steps. (See artwork photo.)
- 5. Attach 1E to 1D
- 6. Attach 1D
  - Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1C, as shown.
- 7. Attach photo
- 8. (Optional) Sponge edges of zig zag flower and burst die-cuts with Carolina ink, as shown
- 9. (Optional) Sponge edges of Peach scallop die-cut with Papaya ink, as shown
- 10. Embellish with prepared die-cuts, additional die-cuts, and stickers, as shown
  - Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 1C, as shown.
- 11. Add journaling

# **Project 1: Right Page**





## Assemble:

- 1. Use exclusive flower paper for base page
- 2. (Optional) Sponge three Peach scallop die-cuts with Papaya ink, as shown
  - Tip: Sponge the darker side of the die-cuts.
- 3. Attach all six Peach scallop die-cuts, as shown
- 4. Attach 1F with 3-D foam tape

  Tip: Do not use adhesive along top so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. Attach 1G

- 6. Attach photos
- 7. (Optional) Sponge edges of Carolina flower die-cut with Carolina ink, as shown
- 8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 1F, as shown.

## **Project 2: Left Page**





## Assemble:

- 1. Use ombré paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A and 2B
- 3. Attach 3" × 3" photo
- 4. Attach circle and Sapphire rectangle die-cuts, as shown Tips: Attach the Sapphire rectangle die-cut first, along the bottom left corner, and use it as a guide for placing the circle die-cuts in that corner of the page. Cut the large Sapphire circle in half, attach it along the right edge of the page, and save the second half to use on the right page of the layout. Trim any excess circle pieces that are hanging off the edges of the page.
- 5. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 6. Attach 4" × 6" photo
- 7. Add journaling

# **Project 2: Right Page**





## Assemble:

- 1. Use ombré paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2C

Attach Papaya rectangle and remaining circle die-cuts, as shown


Tips: Attach the Papaya rectangle die-cut first, along the top right corner, and use it as a guide for placing the circle die-cuts in that corner of the page. Attach the saved half of the Sapphire dot circle along the left edge of the page, lined up to complete the circle with the other half on the left page. Trim any excess circle pieces that are hanging off the edges of the page.

- 3. Attach 2D and 2E
- 4. Attach photos
- 5. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 6. Add journaling

## **Project 3: Left Page**





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use Sapphire tone on tone paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3A

- 3. Attach Sundance rectangle die-cut
- 4. Attach Peach rectangle die-cut
- 5. Attach 3B with 3-D foam tape

  Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom and the top right corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 6. Attach photo

  Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 7. Add journaling to 3C, then attach with 3-D foam tape
- 8. (Optional) Sponge edges or center of Sapphire, Carolina, and Mink circle and flower die-cuts with Carolina ink, as shown
- 9. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 3B.

## **Project 3: Right Page**





## Assemble:

- 1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3D and 3E
- 3. Attach 3F with 3-D foam tape
- 4. Assemble large camera die-cut and attach with 3-D foam tape
  - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so that other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. (Optional) Sponge bottom half of "This is our" die-cuts with Papaya ink
  - Tips: Cover the parts you don't want sponged with a sticky note, first. Remove these masks after you are done sponging.
- 6. Attach prepared "This is our" die-cuts
- 7. (Optional) Lightly sponge base page where "{STORY}" diecuts will be placed with Papaya ink, as shown
- 8. Attach "{STORY}" die-cuts, as shown
- 9. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 10. Attach photos
