Featured Technique: Adding Colour with Markers and a Shimmer Brush

## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

P1 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Intense Black
Tip: Add colour to the wreath with the lightest Citrus and lightest and middle Magenta blend markers and the Mint shimmer brush.


## P1 Accent:

Paper: polka dot Ink: Intense Black

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach $1 \mathrm{~A}, 1 \mathrm{~B}$, and 1 C
3. Attach 1D
4. Attach prepared P1 wreath accent with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 1E
6. Attach prepared P1 banner accents, as shown
7. Embellish with gems



3E:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Intense Black
Tip: Add colour with the middle Citrus blend marker, then splatter with the Mint shimmer brush.
Technique: Squeeze the shimmer brush over an All-purpose Mat, or piece of plastic, to make a small puddle of ink. Pick up ink from the puddle with the tip of the brush, and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.

## P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Intense Black
Tip: Add shimmer with the Mint shimmer brush, first, then stamp.

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B
4. Dovetail and attach 3C
5. Attach 3D with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach prepared $3 E$, as shown
7. Dovetail and attach 3F, as shown Tip: Use thin 3-D foam tape on the ends.
8. Attach prepared P3 banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Embellish with gems


## 4F:

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Intense Black
Tip: Add colour to sundaes with lightest Citrus and middle Magenta blend markers and the Mint

P4 Accent:
Paper: polka dot Ink: Intense Black

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach 4B
4. Attach 4 C

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom left and top right edges so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Dovetail and attach 4D and 4E, as shown Tip: Tuck slightly behind 4C.
6. Attach prepared 4 F with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach prepared P4 banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Embellish with gems
