 Z5010 White Gloss Spray (optional)  
 Z1151 3-D Foam Tape

## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

## Project 1: Left Page



## Prepare for Both Pages:

- Spray both Sundance patterned paper base pages with white gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry  
*Tips: Spray the papers from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.*

Note: The three die-cuts that make up the banner on this page are mislabeled on the die-cut sheet, as Project 3.



## Assemble:


- Use prepared Sundance patterned paper for base page
- Attach three 4" × 4" photos behind large hexagon die-cut, as shown  
*Tip: Trim any parts of the photos that show in other hexagon openings.*
- Attach prepared hexagon die-cut
- Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- Embellish with rubber shapes
- Add journaling

## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use prepared Sundance patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 1A, 1B, and 1C  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom left corner and left edge of 1A, and the top left corner of 1B, so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
3. Attach 1D, 1E, and 1F
4. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach a hexagon frame die-cut to 1G and 1H  
*Tip: Trim any excess off 1G and 1H extending past their frames.*
6. Embellish with prepared 1G and 1H, stickers, and die-cuts  
*Tips: Tuck a few of these pieces behind 1A and 1B. Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Embellish with rubber shapes
8. Add journaling  
*Tips: Cut journaling strips from the Shortbread lined strip die-cut. Save the leftovers for project 2.*




## Project 2: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Capri cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach die-cut strips, as shown
4. Attach 2B and 2C
5. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Embellish with rubber shapes

## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Capri cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2D
3. Attach die-cut strips, as shown
4. Attach 2E and 2F
5. Attach 2G, as shown
6. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
7. Attach 2H
8. Embellish with stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. Embellish with rubber shapes
10. Add journaling  
*Tip: Use remaining Shortbread lined strip die-cut.*

### Project 3: Left Page



### (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

- Spray both Bluebird wave die-cuts with white gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry  
*Tips: Spray the die-cuts from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.*



### Assemble:

1. Use red and white stripe paper for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach photos
4. Attach wave die-cuts, as shown
5. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
6. Embellish with rubber shapes

### Project 3: Right Page



#### Assemble:

1. Use red and white stripe paper for base page
2. Attach 3C and 3D
3. Attach wave die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Make sure these waves line up with those on the left page.*
4. Attach photo with 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
6. Embellish with rubber shapes
7. Add journaling
