## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

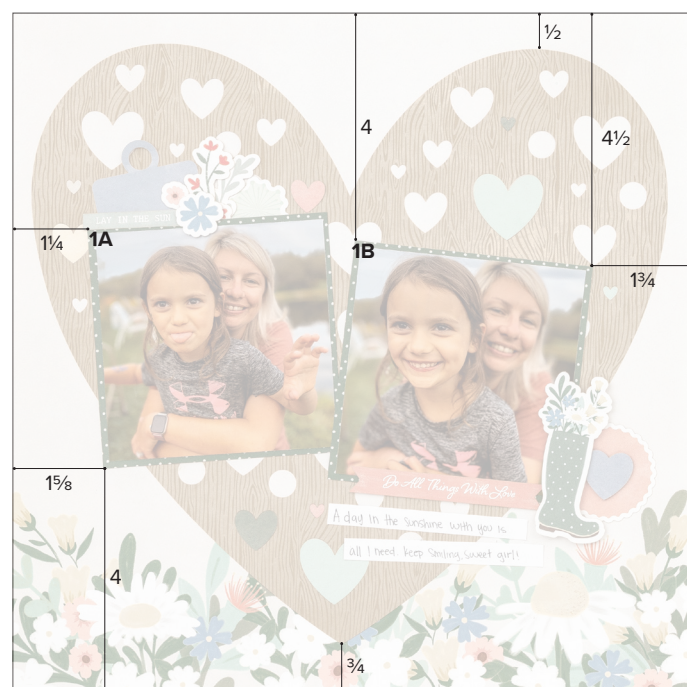


## Project 1: Left Page



## (Optional) Prepare for Right Page:

- Sponge Papaya ink on right base page (exclusive Mink floral paper), as shown  
*Tips: Lay the title out, without attaching, for placement. With a pencil, lightly mark where the word "LOVE" will get attached, remove the title, and sponge along this marked area. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink. Erase any visible pencil marks once the ink is dry.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the paper until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



## Assemble:

- Use exclusive Mink floral paper for base page
- Attach large heart overlay die-cut
- Attach 1A and 1B  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 1A so other pieces can be tucked behind in a later step.*
- Attach photos
- Add journaling
- Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use prepared exclusive Mink floral paper for base page
2. Attach title, as shown
3. Attach 1C, 1D, and 1E
4. Attach photos
5. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*



## Project 2: Left Page



## (Optional) Prepared for Left Page:

- Sponge White Daisy circle die-cut with Papaya ink, as shown  
*Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the die-cut until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



## Assemble:

1. Use Papaya vine paper for base page
2. Attach photos behind openings of White Daisy die cut overlay
3. Attach flower and leaf die-cuts over center circle, as shown
4. Attach prepared White Daisy die-cut overlay
5. Cut one Papaya circle die-cut in half and attach, as shown  
*Tip: Set aside the other half for another step.*
6. Add journaling on Shortbread circle die-cuts and attach, as shown
7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach remaining circle die-cuts, as shown
4. Attach 2B
5. Attach 2C and 2D  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left of 2C and bottom right corner of 2D so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tips: Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 2C and 2D. Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*



### Project 3: Left Page



### (Optional) Prepared for Left Page:

- Sponge Shortbread die-cut with Papaya ink, as shown  
*Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the die-cut until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



### Assemble:

1. Use Pine cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Dovetail and attach 3C
4. Attach 3D and 3E  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 3D and the bottom left edge of 3E so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
5. Attach photos
6. Attach prepared Shortbread die-cut
7. Attach title
8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tips: Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 3D and 3E. Attach a few pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*



### Project 3: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Pine cardstock paper for base page
2. Attach 3F and 3G
3. Attach 3H, 3I, and 3J
4. Attach photos
5. Attach 3K
  - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom left corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
6. Attach journaling die-cut to 3K
7. Add journaling
8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts
  - Tips: Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 3K. Attach a few pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
