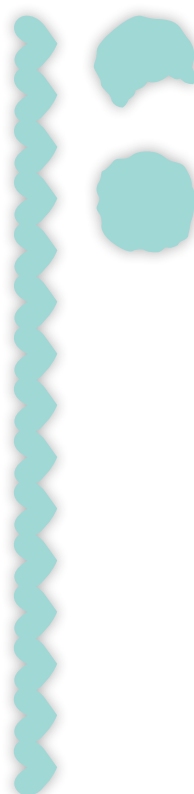

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

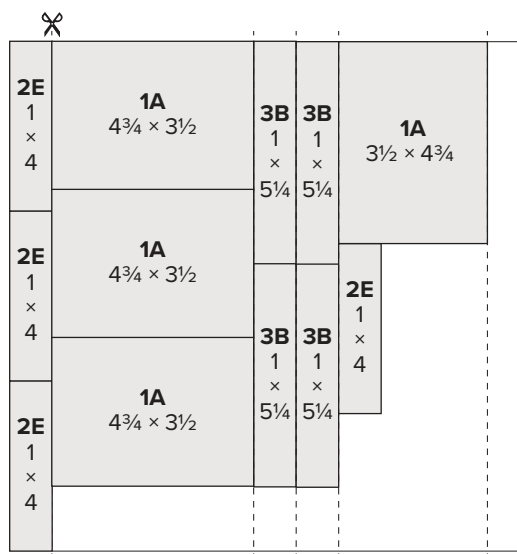

Project 1: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



1E:

Paper: French Vanilla

Ink: Glacier

Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.

Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of colour is achieved.



P1 Accents:

Paper: light Toffee

Ink: Mocha



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach 1B and 1C
4. Attach 1D
5. Attach P1 Flamingo cardstock heart border accent to 1E, as shown
Tip: Trim any excess.
6. Attach prepared 1E with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach prepared cookie accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Embellish with gems

Ink: Glacier



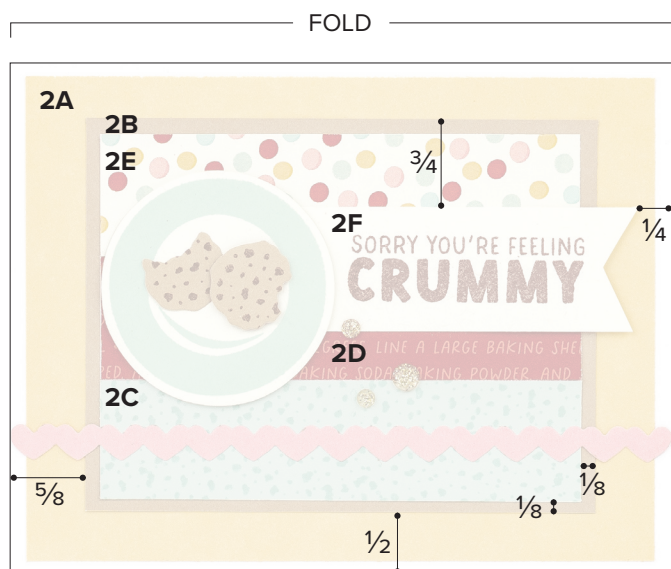

Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B
4. Attach prepared 2C, 2D, and 2E
5. Attach prepared 2F
6. Attach prepared plate and cookie accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Attach P1 Flamingo cardstock heart border accent, as shown
8. Embellish with gems

Project 3: Make 4

Prepare (4):



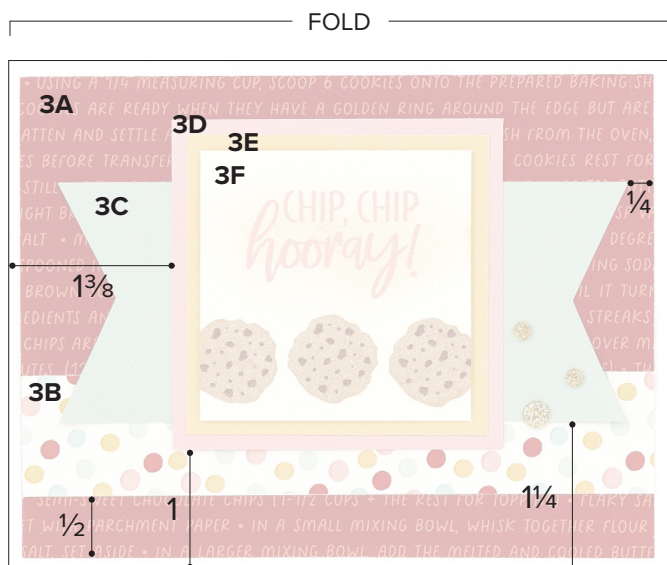
3F:

Paper: French Vanilla

Inks: Flamingo, Mocha, Toffee

Tips: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply Toffee ink behind the sentiment. Stamp the cookies and chocolate chips with the Toffee and Mocha inks.

Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce in on the cardstock until the desired amount of colour is achieved.



Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B
4. Dovetail and attach 3C
5. Attach 3D and 3E
6. Attach prepared 3F with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with gems

Project 4: Make 4



Prepare (4 each):

4B:

Paper: French Vanilla

Inks: Glacier, Mocha, Toffee

Tips: With a pencil and ruler, lightly draw a horizontal line 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " from the bottom. Stamp the cookies below this guideline. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the Glacier ink behind the sentiment.

Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of colour is achieved.



P4 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla

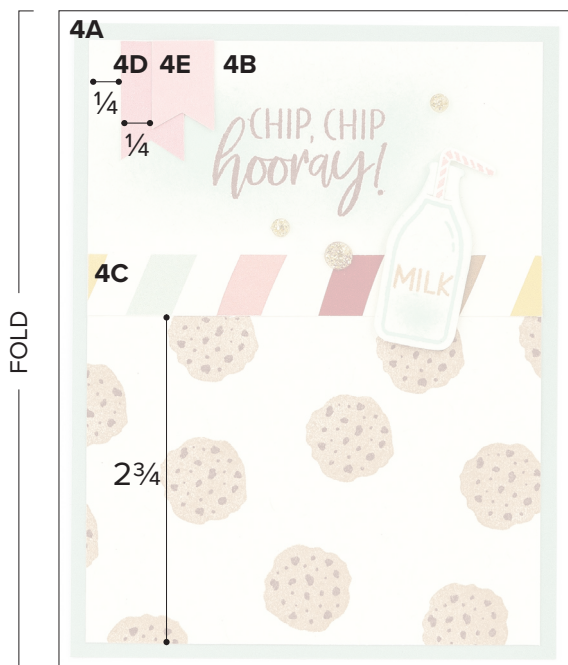
Ink: Glacier, Toffee

Tip: Use the sponge wedge cut for 4B to apply the colour in the bottle.

P4 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla

Ink: Flamingo



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach prepared 4B
4. Attach 4C
5. Dovetail and attach 4D and 4E
6. Attach prepared milk bottle and straw accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
Tip: Slide the straw through the slit along the top of the milk bottle.
7. Embellish with gems
