

Featured Technique: Adding Colour with Watercolour Pencils

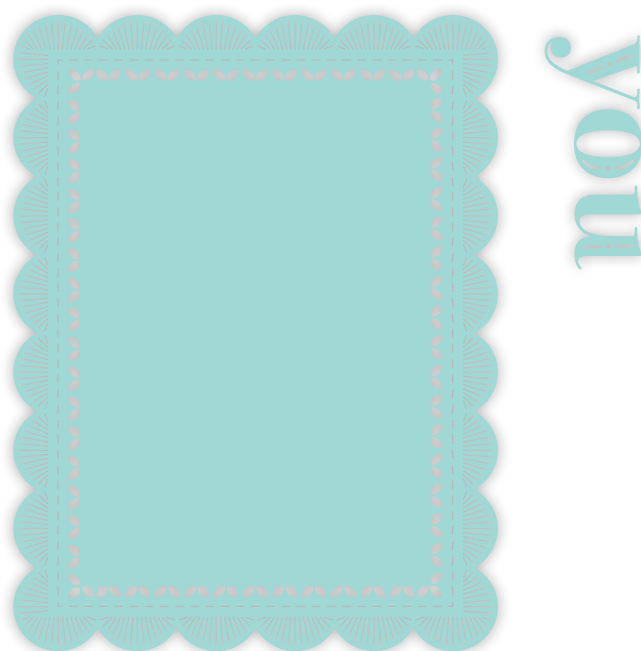

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

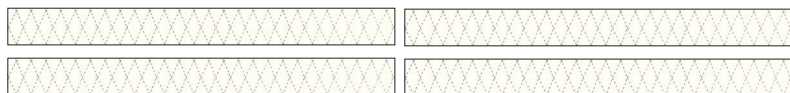

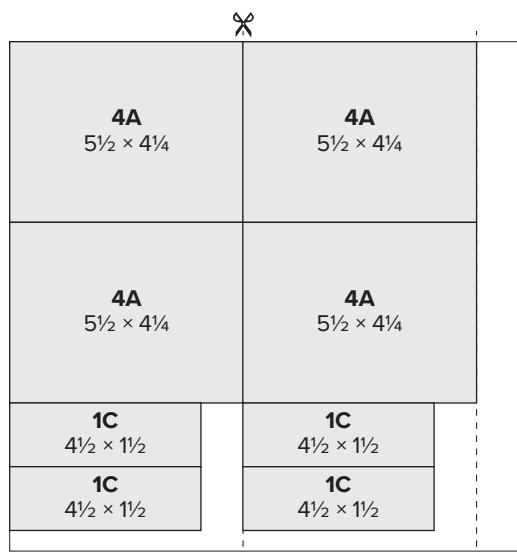

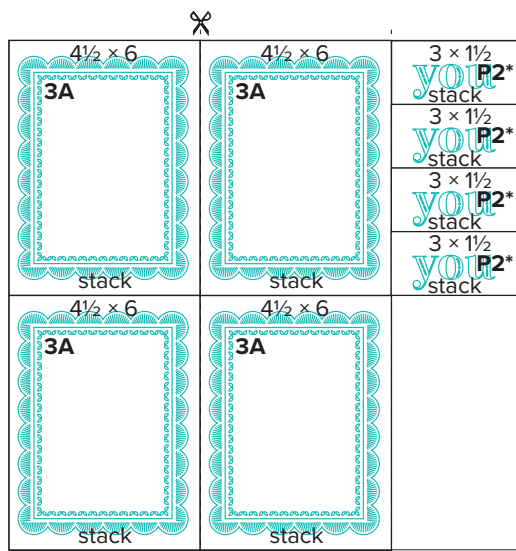

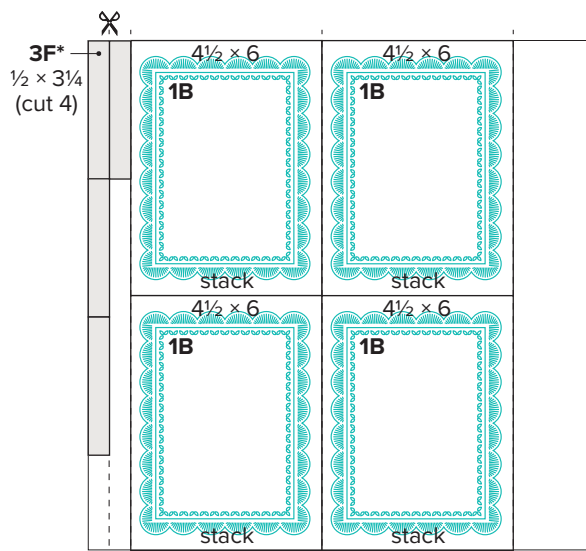
Sage cardstock

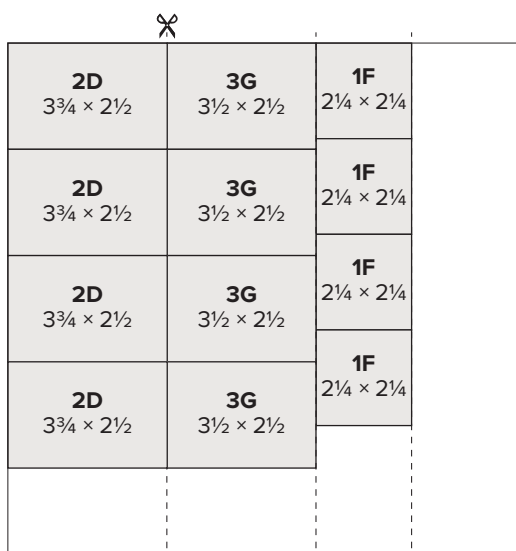

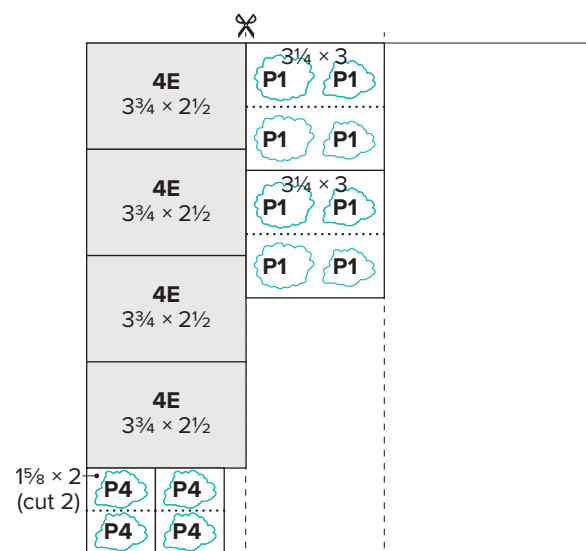

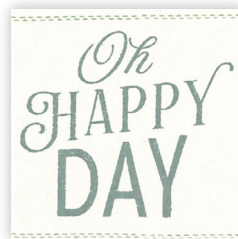

Project 1: Make 4

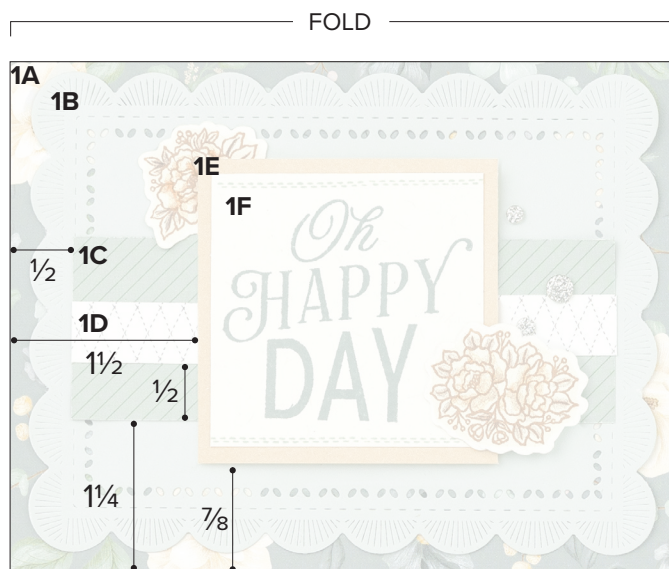
Prepare (4 each):



1F:
Paper: French Vanilla
Inks: Mist, Sage



P1 Accents:
Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Toffee
Tip: Add colour with watercolour pencils (Elephant Grey and Sand Brown).



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C and 1D
4. Attach 1E with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach prepared 1F
6. Attach prepared small flower accent, as shown
Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1E.
7. Attach prepared large flower accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 2: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



2C:

Paper: Mist

Tip: Trim the scalloped edges off, using the faux stitch line as a guide.

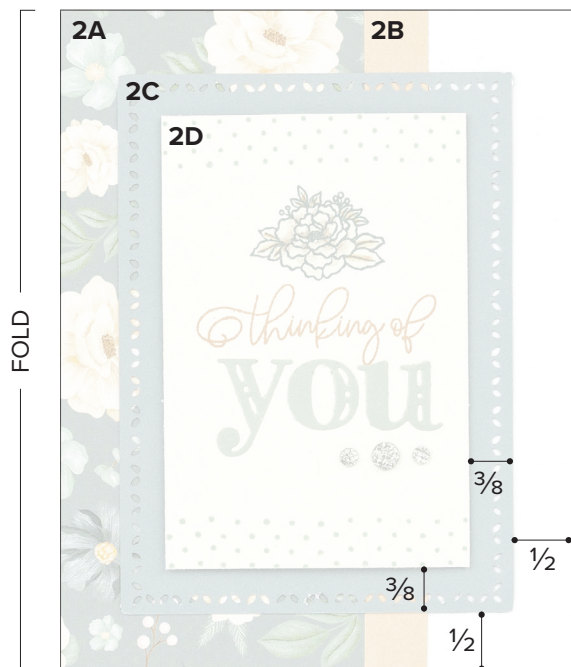


2D:

Paper: French Vanilla, Sage

Inks: Mist, Sage, Toffee

Tips: Stamp the borders first. Then, stamp the flower. Next, attach the "y-o-u" die-cuts. Stamp "thinking of" last. Add colour to flower with watercolour pencils (Elephant Grey and Sand Brown).



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. Attach prepared 2C
4. Attach prepared 2D with 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with glitter gems

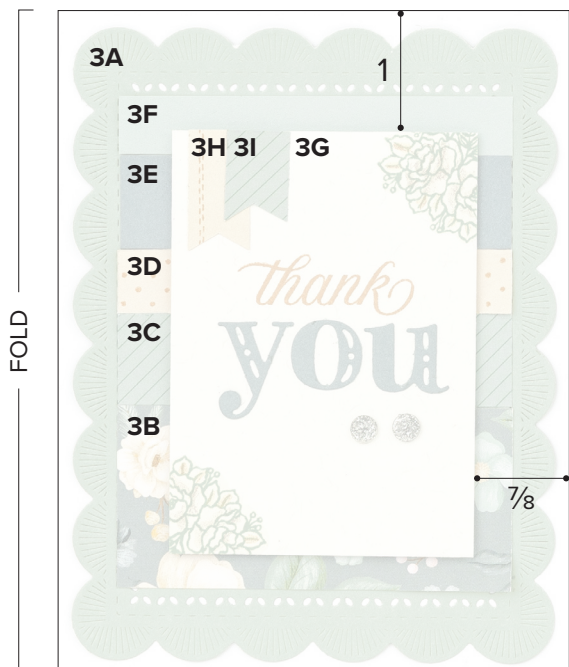

Paper: French Vanilla, Mist
Inks: Sage, Toffee
Tips: Stamp the flowers in the corners first. Then, attach the "y-o-u" die-cuts. Stamp "thank" last. Add colour to the flowers with watercolour pencils (Elephant Grey and



3H:
Paper: light Shortbread
Ink: Toffee
Tip: Dovetail.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, as shown
3. Attach 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, and 3F, as shown
4. Attach prepared 3G with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 3H, as shown
6. Dovetail and attach 3I, as shown
7. Embellish with glitter gems

Paper: light Shortbread
Ink: Toffee



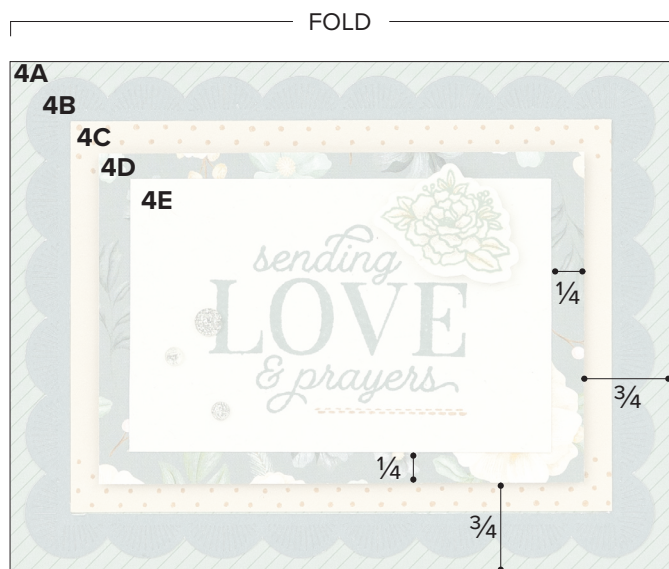

P4 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Sage

Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Attach 4C, as shown
4. Attach 4D with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach prepared 4E
6. Attach prepared small floral accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Embellish with glitter gems
