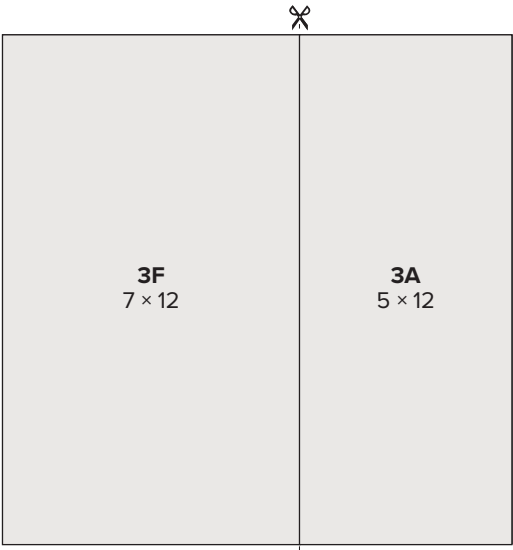
**Getting Started:**

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

## Project 1: Left Page

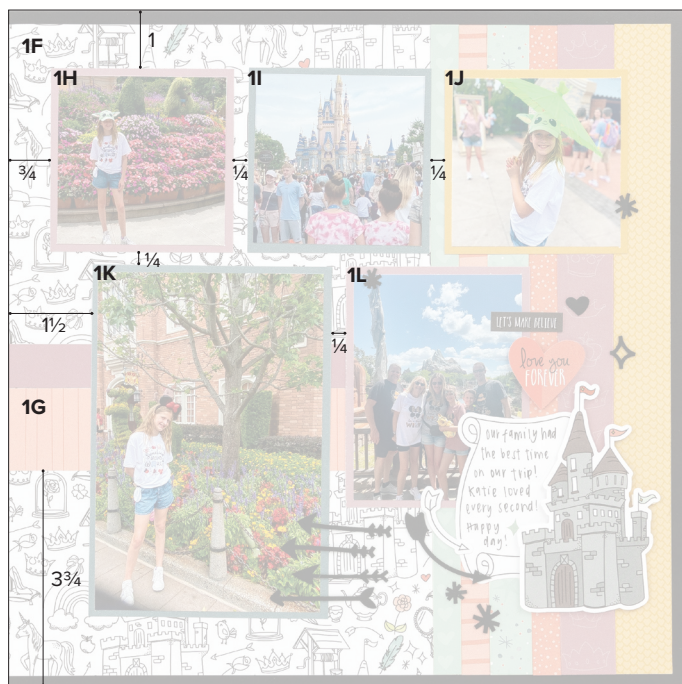


### Assemble:

1. Use Black cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1A  
*Tip: (Optional) Color a few images with Dull Green, Vintage Blue, and Coral blend markers, as desired.*
3. Attach Honey Butter scales, Melon stripe, Mulberry crowns, Seabrook stars, and Papaya dots strip die-cuts  
*Tip: For a boy themed page, use the other side of the die-cuts.*
4. Dovetail and attach 1B and Mulberry strip die-cut
5. Attach 1C  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
6. Attach 1D  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Attach photo
8. Attach circle heart die-cut to 1E and trim excess around edge
9. Attach prepared 1E  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1C.*
10. Embellish with stickers and black paperboard die-cuts  
*Tips: Tuck a few of these embellishments behind 1D. Attach a few with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*



## Project 1: Right Page

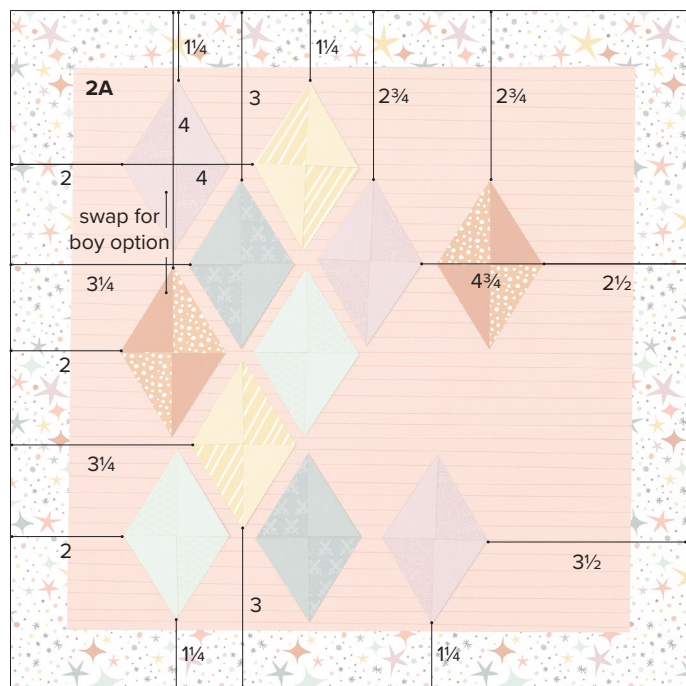


### Assemble:

1. Use Black cardstock for base page  
Attach 1F  
*Tip: (Optional) Color a few images with Dull Green, Vintage Blue, and Coral blend markers, as desired.*
2. Attach Honey Butter scales, Mulberry crowns, Papaya dots, Seabrook stars, Melon stripe, and Seabrook hearts strip die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: For a boy themed page, use the other side of the die-cuts.*
3. Attach 1G and Mulberry strip die-cut
4. Attach 1H, 1I, 1J, 1K, and 1L
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with stickers and black paperboard die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Add journaling



## Project 2: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use star paper as base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Assemble and attach diamond die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Attach the top left Mulberry, Mist, and Papaya diamonds with 3-D foam tape.*
4. Attach photos to 2B and 2C
5. Attach prepared 2B and 2C  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 2B or the*

*top of 2C so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*

6. Embellish with stickers and black paperboard die-cuts  
*Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the castle slightly behind 2C. Trim the rainbow and attach it slightly tucked behind the top left diamond.*



## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use star paper for base page
2. Attach 2D
3. Attach 2E, 2F, 2G, and 2H
4. Attach photos
5. Assemble and attach diamond die-cuts with 3-D foam tape, as shown  
*Tips: Do not use foam tape on the Mist diamond and trim the excess coming off the page.*
6. Embellish with stickers and black paperboard die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Add journaling



## Project 3: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Mist arrow paper for base page
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B, 3C, and 3D
4. Attach 3E
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with printed die-cuts, black paperboard die-cuts, and stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*



## Project 3: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Mist arrow paper for base page
2. Attach 3F
3. Attach 3G and 3H
4. Attach photos
5. Embellish with printed die-cuts, black paperboard die-cuts, and stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
6. Add journaling
