Getting Started:

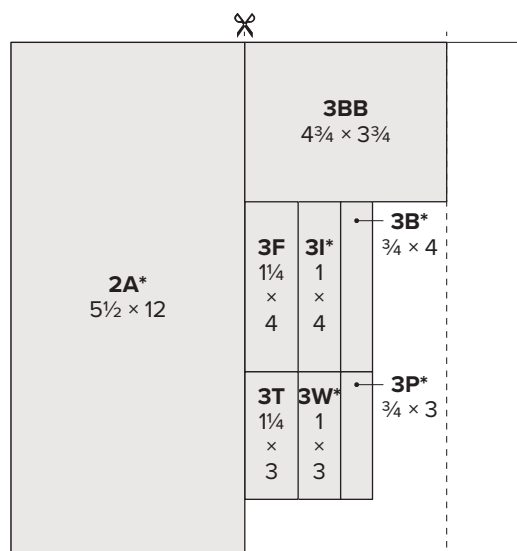
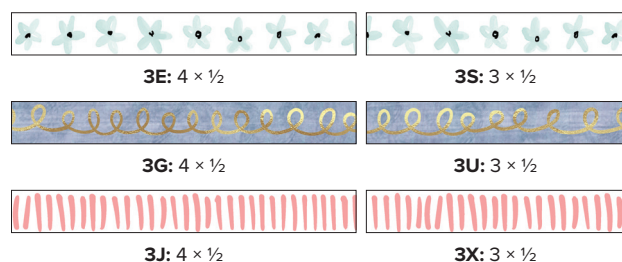
- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

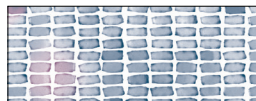
Tip: Using a ruler and pencil, lightly draw a diagonal line from the top corner to the opposite bottom corner. Then, trim along the line with scissors. (It will not fit in most standard paper trimmers.)



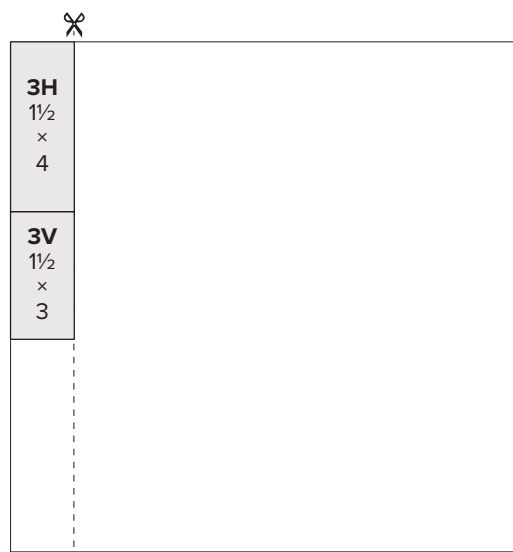

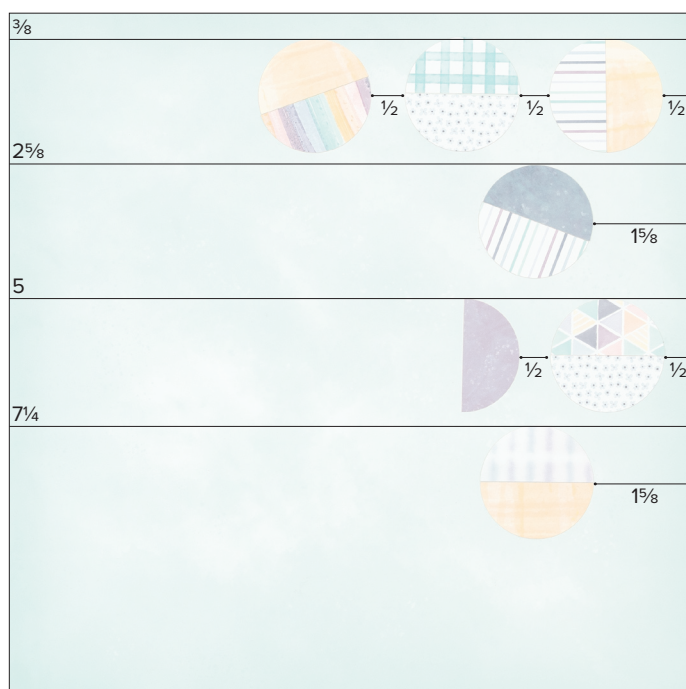
Project 1: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Glacier wash patterned paper for base page
2. Attach semicircle die-cuts, as shown above
Tips: With a pencil and ruler, lightly draw the horizontal guidelines shown, and then attach the die-cuts. Once the die-cuts are all attached, gently erase any visible pencil marks.
3. Attach 1A and 1B with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach photos
5. (Optional) Draw border on base page with Teal LePen™ and a ruler, as shown
Tip: Note that the border goes along just three of the sides.
6. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.

Project 1: Right Page

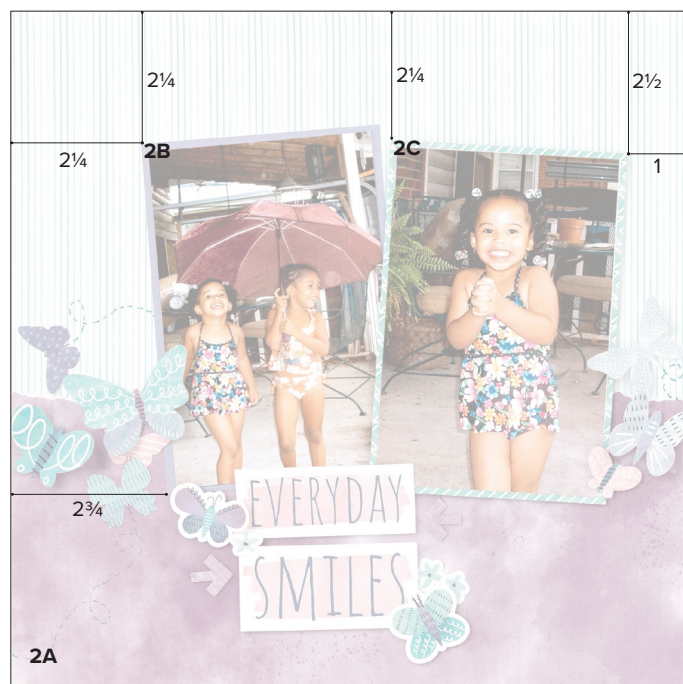


Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Glacier wash paper for base page
2. Attach semicircle die-cuts, as shown above
Tips: With a pencil and ruler, lightly draw the horizontal guidelines shown, and then attach the die-cuts. Once the die-cuts are all attached, gently erase any visible pencil marks.
3. Attach 1C, 1D, and 1E with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach photos
5. (Optional) Draw border on base page with Teal LePen™ and a ruler, as shown
Tip: Note that the border goes along just three of the sides.
6. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.
7. Add journaling
8. (Optional) Draw dash lines on journaling strips with Teal LePen™



Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Lagoon stripe paper for base page
2. Tear approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ " from 2A, as shown, then attach
3. Attach 2B
4. Attach photo to 2B
5. Attach 2C
6. Attach photo to 2C
7. Attach butterfly die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. By using adhesive just under the center of the butterflies, you can bend and lift the wings up to make them look like they are in motion.
8. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.
9. (Optional) Draw butterfly trails with Teal LePen™, as shown

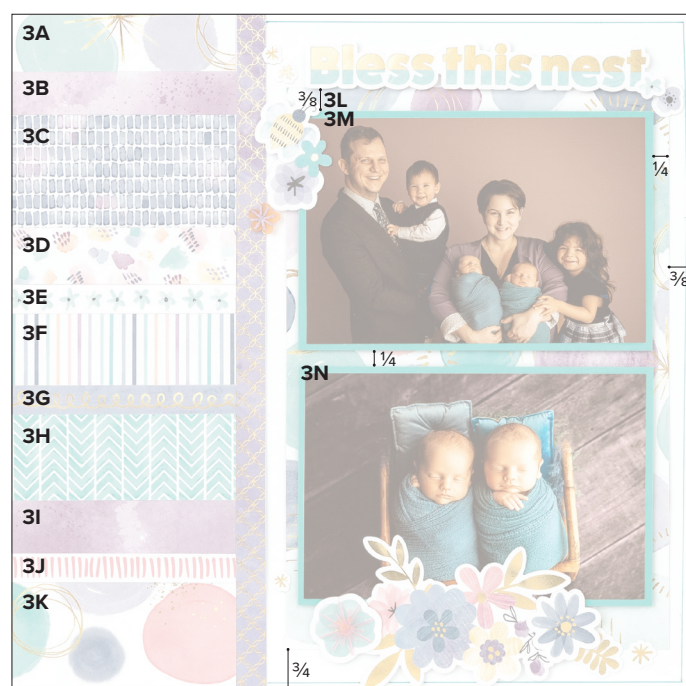
Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Lagoon stripe paper for base page
2. Tear approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ " from 2D, as shown, then attach
3. Attach 2E, 2F, 2G, and 2H
4. Attach photos
5. Attach butterfly die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. By using adhesive just under the center of the butterflies, you can bend and lift the wings up to make them look like they are in motion.
6. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.
7. (Optional) Draw butterfly trails with Teal LePen™, as shown
8. Add journaling
9. (Optional) Draw dotted lines on journaling strips with Teal LePen™

Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
 2. Attach 3A–3K
 3. Attach 3L
 4. Attach 3M and 3N with 3-D foam tape
 5. Attach photos
 6. (Optional) Draw border on base page with Teal LePen™ and a ruler, as shown
 7. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
- Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 30–3Y
3. Attach 3Z, 3AA, 3BB, and 3CC
4. Attach 3DD, 3EE, 3FF, and 3GG with 3-D foam tape
Tips: Do not use adhesive along the top right corner of 3EE so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photos
6. (Optional) Draw border on base page with Teal LePen™ and a ruler, as shown
7. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck Flamingo flower sticker slightly behind 3EE. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.
8. Add journaling
9. (Optional) Draw dash lines on journaling strips with Teal LePen™
