- G1275 Cosette Scrapbooking Workshop Kit
- Z6532 Mulberry Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z2828 Toffee Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad (optional)
- Z697 Round Sponge (optional)
- Z1151 3-D Foam Tape

- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Ruler

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

## Project 1: Left Page



## Prepare (for both pages):

- Tear approx. ¼" off one long edge of 1C, 1E, and 1F, as shown
- (Optional) Sponge torn edges of 1C, 1E, and 1F with Toffee ink  
*Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



## Assemble:

1. Use Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 1A  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom, right, or left edges so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
3. Attach 1B  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach prepared 1C  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach photo
6. Attach title sticker with 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with additional stickers and die-cuts, tucking a few behind 1A, 1B, and 1C, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
8. Add journaling

## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 1D, prepared 1E, and prepared 1F  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the lower left edge of 1E, or the upper right edge of 1F, so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
3. Attach photos  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of the bottom photo so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, tucking a few behind 1E, 1F, and bottom photo, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
5. Add journaling

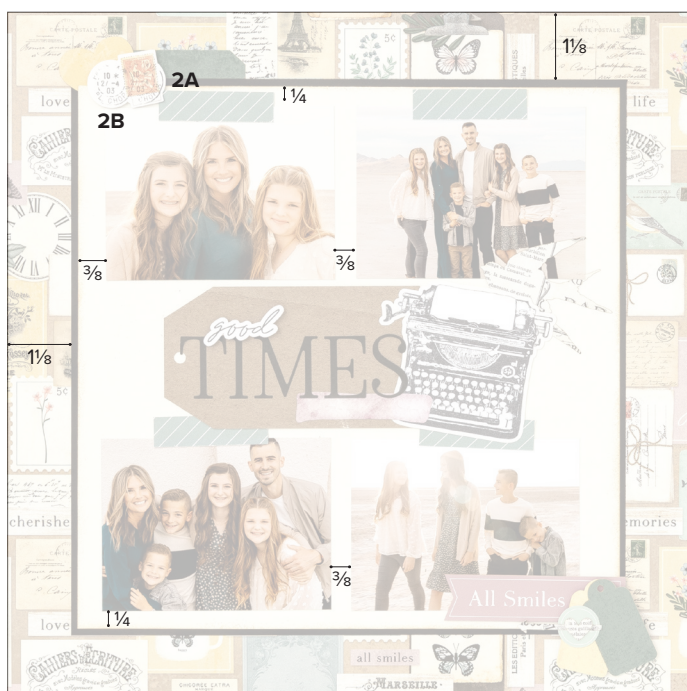


## Project 2: Left Page



## Prepare (for both pages):

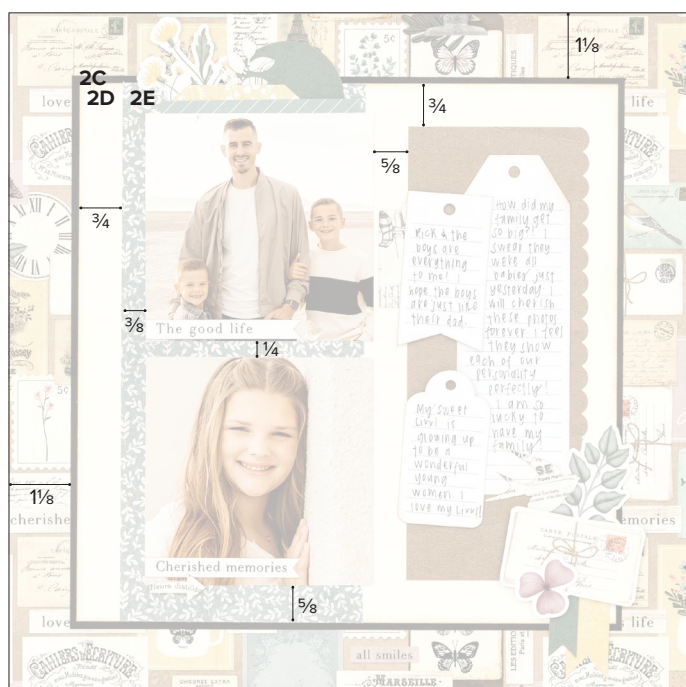
- (Optional) Sponge edges of 2B and 2D with Toffee ink  
*Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub it along the cardstock edges until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



## Assemble:

- Use postcard patterned paper for base page
- Attach 2A and prepared 2B  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner of 2A and 2B so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
- Attach photos
- Attach zip strip accents
- Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, tucking a few behind 2A and 2B, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use postcard patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2C and prepared 2D
3. Attach 2E
4. Attach kraft scalloped die-cut, as shown  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach photos  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of the top photo so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
6. Embellish with stickers, zip strip accent, and die-cuts, tucking a few behind the top photo and kraft scalloped die-cut, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Add journaling

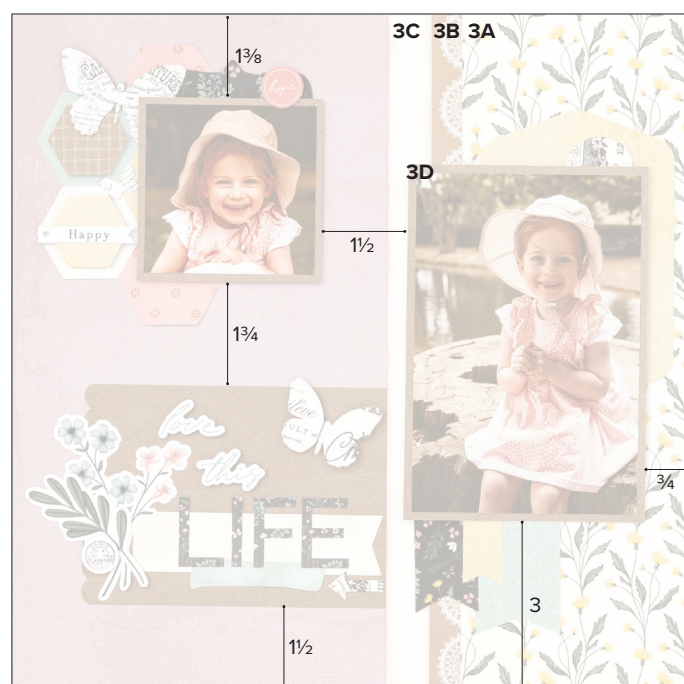


### Project 3: Left Page



### Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Sponge edges of 3C and 3G with Mulberry ink  
*Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.*  
*Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub it along the cardstock edges until the desired amount of colour is achieved.*



### Assemble:

- Use exclusive Mulberry patterned paper for base page
- Attach 3A, 3B, and prepared 3C  
*Tip: Only use adhesive along the top left edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- Attach 3D with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Only use adhesive along the lower right side so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- Attach kraft photo mat die-cut with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Only use adhesive along the lower right side so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, tucking a few behind 3D and kraft photo mat, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- Finish attaching 3D and kraft photo mat with 3-D foam tape

## Project 3: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Mulberry patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 3E and 3F
3. Attach Honey Butter journaling tag die-cuts, as shown
4. Attach prepared 3G
5. Attach 3H, 3I, and 3J
 

*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 3H and 3J so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.*
6. Attach 3K with 3-D foam tape
 

*Tip: Only use adhesive along the center, bottom left edge, and the top right corner of the cardstock so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, tucking a few behind 3H, 3J, and 3K, as shown
 

*Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
8. Add journaling
