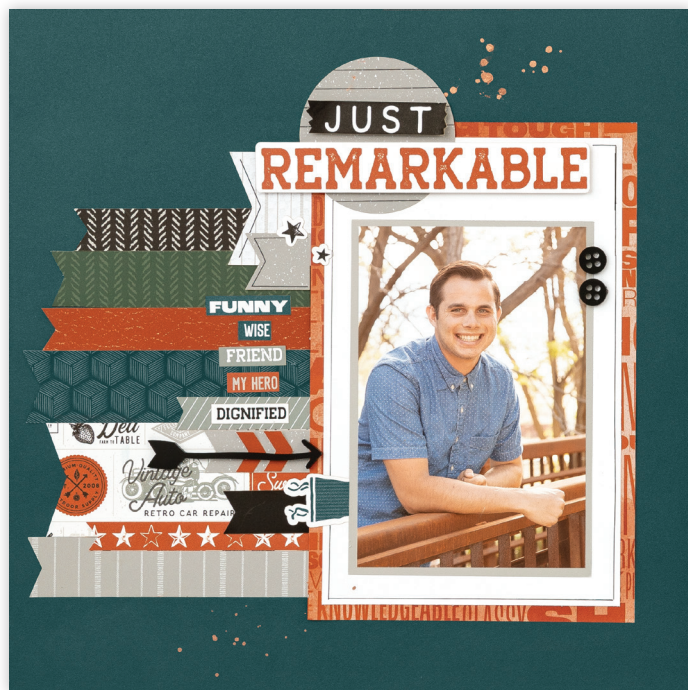

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

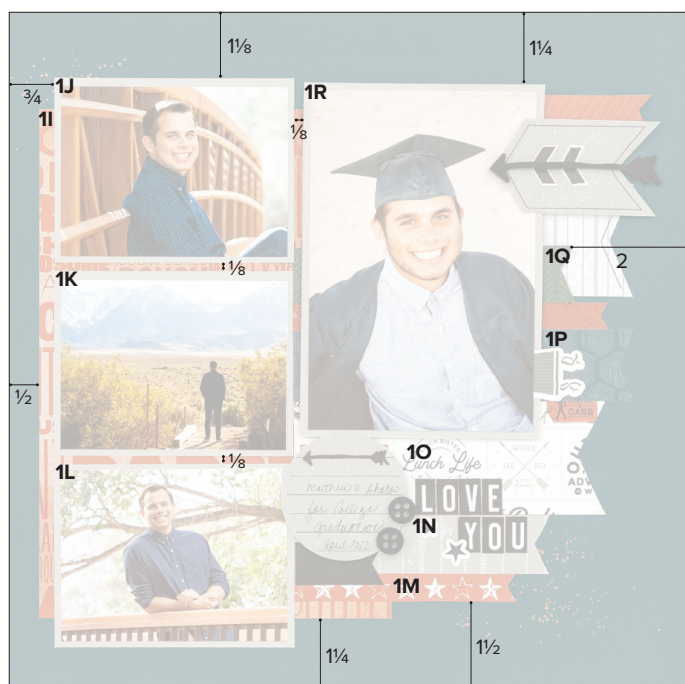
- (Optional) Splatter both base pages (12" x 12" Harbour cardstock) with metallic paint marker (3MM), as shown
Technique: Push the tip of the marker against the all-purpose mat until a small puddle of paint forms. Dip the tip of the marker in the puddle and then gently tap the barrel of the marker against your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.
- Draw border on 1B with black LePen™ and a ruler, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use prepared Harbour cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1A, prepared 1B, and 1C
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge of 1A or the bottom left edge of 1C so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
3. Attach photo
4. Dovetail and attach 1D, 1E, 1F, 1G, and 1H
Tip: Tuck some of these slightly behind 1A.
5. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of them slightly behind 1A. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

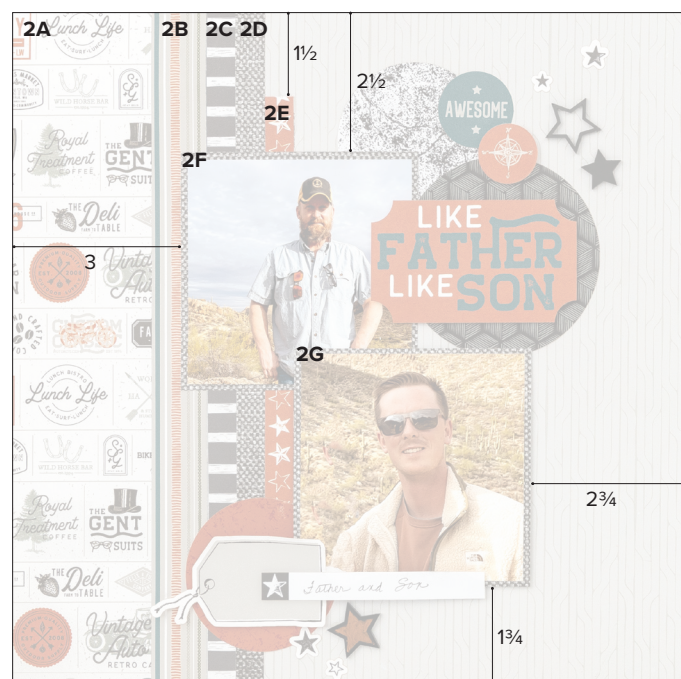
1. Use prepared Harbour cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1I
3. Attach 1J, 1K, and 1L
4. Dovetail and attach 1M, 1N, 1O, 1P, and 1Q
Tips: Do not use adhesive on the final 1" of the right end of 1Q so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach 1R with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 1R so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few of these slightly behind 1R. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
8. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

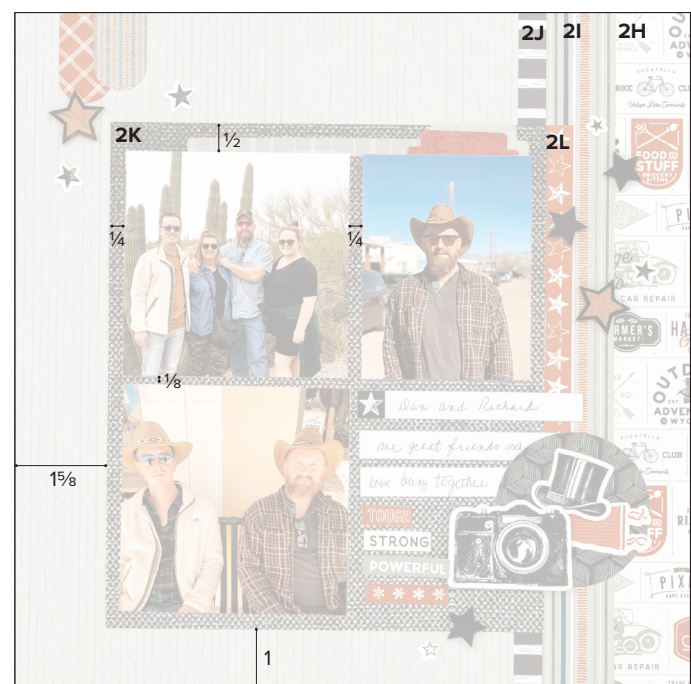
- (Optional) Paint three small acrylic stars with metallic paint marker (3MM), as shown



Assemble:

1. Use Mink patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E
3. Attach photos to 2F and 2G, then attach
Tips: Attach 2G with 3-D foam tape. Do not use adhesive along the top right corner of 2F or the bottom left corner of 2G so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
4. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes, including one prepared star
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these slightly behind 2F and 2G. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
5. Add journaling

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

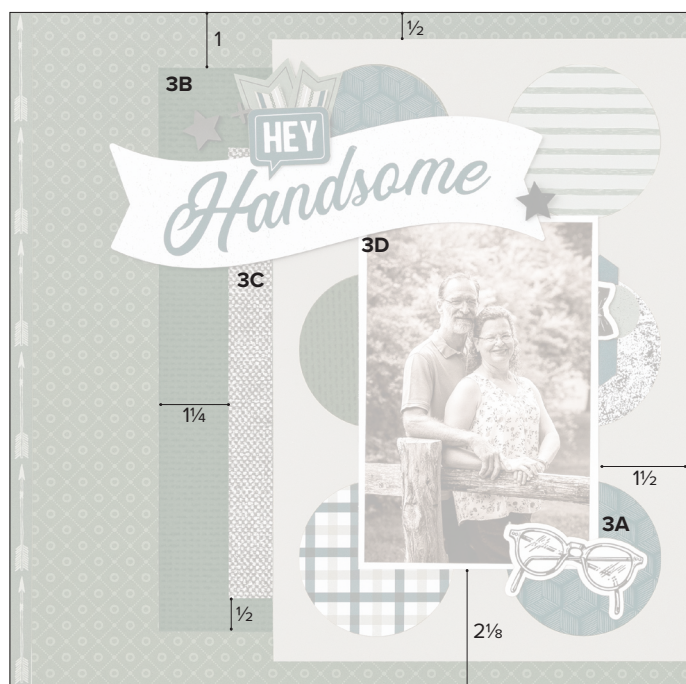
1. Use Mink patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2H, 2I, and 2J
3. Attach 2K and 2L
4. Attach photos
5. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes, including remaining prepared stars
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
6. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- Cut the large Mink circle frame die-cut, between second and third columns, as shown
- Attach 3A to the two-column circle frame die-cut, behind the bottom right circle
- Attach 3E and 3F to the single-column circle frame die-cut, behind the top and bottom circles



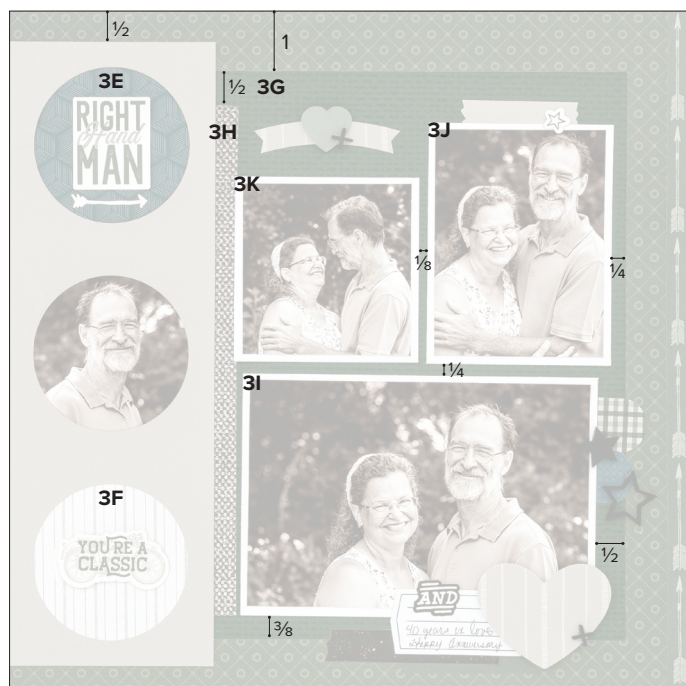
Assemble:

1. Use Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach prepared frame die-cut
3. Attach circle die-cuts inside remaining circle frames, as shown
4. Attach 3B and 3C
5. Attach 3D

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 3D so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
6. Attach photo
7. Embellish with die-cuts, stickers, and acrylic shapes

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 3D. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach one 3" x 3" photo behind remaining open frame of prepared die-cut
3. Attach prepared frame die-cut
4. Attach 3G and 3H
5. Attach 3I, 3J, and 3K
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 3I so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
6. Attach remaining photos
7. Embellish with die-cuts, stickers, and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind 3I. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
