Getting Started:


- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- · Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.



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Prepare (for both pages):

SUNSES ON SINGS

• (Optional) Spray both base pages (exclusive 12" × 12" Periwinkle patterned paper) with white gloss spray

Tip: Spray the paper from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Periwinkle patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1A
- 3. Attach 1B and 1C
- 4. Attach 1D, 1E, and 1F
- 5. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape

 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom of the right bottom photo so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 6. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a couple of die-cuts behind the bottom right photo. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.





Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Periwinkle patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1G
- 3. Attach 1H and 1I
- 4. Attach 1J and 1K
- 5. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
- 6. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and acrylic shapes Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
- 7. Add journaling

Prepare (for both pages):

(Optional) Spray circle, semicircle, and arrow die-cuts with white gloss spray, as shown

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Tip: Spray the paper from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.





Assemble:

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- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach Lagoon die cut letters to large overlay die-cut, as shown
- 3. Attach photos to large overlay die-cut, as shown
- 4. Attach prepared overlay to base page
- 5. Embellish with stickers, prepared die-cuts, and additional die-cuts

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Trim the two dovetail stickers down, as shown.

Project 2: Right Page





Assemble:

- 1. Use exclusive stripe patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A, 2B, and 2C
 - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge of 2A so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 3. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
- 4. Embellish with stickers, prepared die-cut, and additional die-cuts
 - Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some slightly behind 2A.
- 5. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

 (Optional) Spray base pages (12" × 12" wood grain patterned papers), along bottom of left base page and sides of right base page, with white gloss spray

Tip: Spray the papers from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared wood grain patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3A
- 3. Attach semicircle die-cuts, as shown
 Tips: Begin with the row that lines up with the bottom of 3A.
 Only use adhesive along the flat edge of the semicircles so
 the next row of die-cuts can be tucked and attached behind
 the one preceding it.
- 4. Attach 3B and 3C
- 5. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
- 6. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts

 Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

Project 3: Right Page





Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared wood grain patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3D
- 3. Attach semicircle die-cuts, as shown
 Tips: Begin with the rows that line up with the right and left
 sides of 3D. Only use adhesive along the flat edge of the
 semicircles so the second rows can be tucked and attached
 behind the first row.
- 4. Attach 3E, 3F, 3G, and 3H
- 5. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach 3I
- 7. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts

 Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 8. Add journaling
