Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

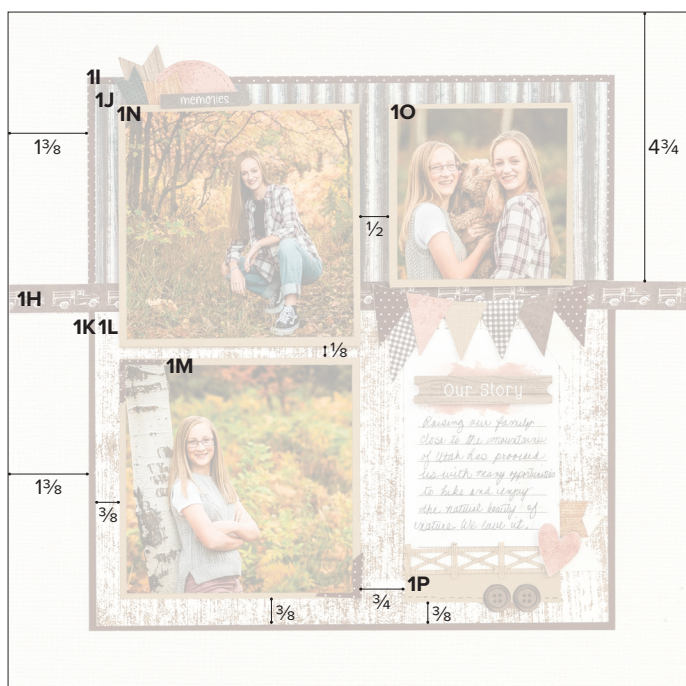
- (Optional) Colour landscape scene die-cut with coloured pencils (Mossy Green, Sap Green, Nettle Green, Woodland Green, Sky Blue, Flint Grey, Chestnut Brown, Dark Timber, and Oak Tree)
- (Optional) Colour woodgrain arrow die-cut with Dark Timber coloured pencil
- (Optional) Colour three small woodgrain dovetail die-cuts with Chestnut Brown coloured pencil
- Layer and attach four triangle pennant die-cuts on Mocha polka-dot banner die-cut, as shown
- Draw dash line on 1P with black LePen™



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive French Vanilla patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach 1B and 1C
4. Attach 1D and 1E
5. Attach Mocha gingham and Mocha wash die-cuts to 1E
6. Attach 1F with 3-D foam tape
7. Attach 1G
 - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
8. Attach two Mocha polka-dot corner die-cuts to 1F, as shown
9. Attach photos
10. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
 - Tips: Attach the "grateful" circle die-cut with 3-D foam tape. Tuck one sticker slightly behind 1G.*

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

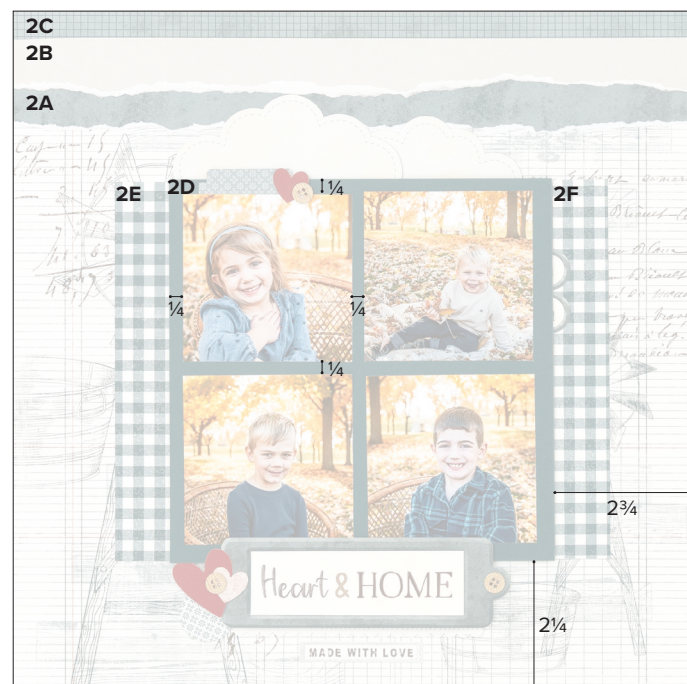
1. Use exclusive French Vanilla patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 1H
3. Attach 1I and 1J
4. Attach 1K and 1L
5. Attach 1M
6. Attach 1N and 1O with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left of 1N so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
7. Attach prepared 1P
8. Attach two Mocha polka-dot corner die-cuts to 1M, as shown
9. Attach photos
10. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, including prepared die-cut
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some slightly behind 1N.
11. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- Hand trim “MADE WITH LOVE” sticker, as shown
- Tear approximately ½" from one long edge of 2A, 2B, 2H, and 2I
- (Optional) Colour apple tree die-cut with coloured pencils (Chestnut Brown, Leafy Green, and Dark Timber)



Assemble:

1. Use windmill patterned paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 2A, prepared 2B, and 2C
3. Attach 2D with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top or upper right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach 2E and 2F
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, including prepared sticker
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few behind 2D.

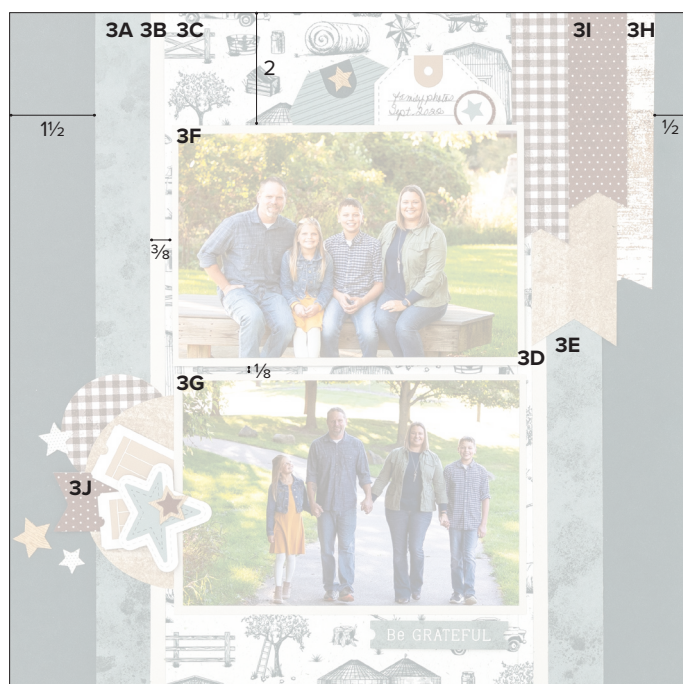
Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use windmill patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2G
3. Attach prepared 2H, prepared 2I, and 2J
4. Attach 2K with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top or the lower right and left edges so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach frame die-cut, as shown
6. Attach photos, as shown
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom of the right photo so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
7. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared die-cut
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some slightly behind 2K and right photo.
8. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use light Harbour cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, and 3E
3. Attach 3F with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top or top right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach 3G
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photos
6. Dovetail and attach 3H
7. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts
Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few of these behind 3F and 3G. Do not use adhesive along the ends of the die cut tickets so another piece can be tucked behind them in a later step. Attach the gingham dovetailed die-cut along the top right of the page, as shown, and trim the excess.
8. Dovetail and attach 3I and 3J, as shown
Tip: Tuck 3J slightly behind 3F and die cut tickets.
9. Add journaling

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use light Harbour cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3K, 3L, 3M, 3N, and 3O
3. Attach photos
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of the top left photo or the right edge of the bottom right photo so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
4. Attach 3P
5. Dovetail and attach 3Q and 3R
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top half of these so another piece can be tucked behind them in a later step.
6. Attach the title sticker with 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts
Tips: Tuck some of these embellishments slightly behind the top and bottom right photos. Trim the sides of the "You & Me" sticker and attach it to the journaling sticker. Tuck the journaling sticker behind the bottom right photo and 3Q and 3R. Dovetail the remaining Harbour flag sticker and tuck it behind the top left photo. Attach the dovetailed die-cuts along the bottom of the page, as shown, and trim the excess.
8. Add journaling
