## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2$ accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

Paper: Candy Apple
Tips: Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry. Use a ruler as a guide.

Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Intense Black
Tip: Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.

## P2 Accents:

Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Candy Apple
Tips: Color with colored pencils (Fiery Red, Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.

## P2 Accents:

Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Candy Apple
Tips: Hand trim "FOR" banner and attach to 2 E .


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A, 2B, and prepared 2C
3. Attach 2 D with 3-D foam tape

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach prepared 2 E
5. Attach P2 French Vanilla branch accent, as shown Tips: Tuck it slightly behind 2D. Do not use adhesive on the two lower branches so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
6. Attach prepared stocking accents with 3-D foam tape, as shown
Tip: Tuck them slightly under the branches.
7. Embellish with sparkles


## Assemble:

2. Attach $3 A$ and $3 B$
3. Attach 3C
4. Attach prepared 3F
5. Embellish with sparkles


3F:
Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Pine


## P3 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Intense Black Tips: Color with colored pencil (Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Dovetail and attach 3D, as shown
3. Attach 3E with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach prepared stocking accent with 3-D foam tape Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach P3 zip strip accent, as shown
6. Attach P3 sprig accents, as shown

Tip: Tuck these slightly behind the stocking accent.
11. Embellish with sparkles and glitter glue

4F:
Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Pine
Tip: Dovetail.

## P4 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla Ink: Pine
Tip: Color with colored pencil (Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.

## P4 Accent:

Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Candy Apple
Tip: Color with colored pencil (Fiery Red). Hand trim. Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach $4 A$ and $4 B$
3. Attach 4C and 4D
4. Attach prepared $4 F$ to $4 E$, then dovetail $4 E$
5. Attach prepared 4E with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach prepared stocking accent with 3-D foam tape Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
7. Attach P4 sprig accents, as shown

Tip: Tuck these slightly behind the stocking accent.
8. Attach prepared bow accent, as shown
9. Embellish with sparkles and glitter glue

Tip: Use a ruler as a guide for the glitter glue.
