Getting Started:


- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.





















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Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

• (Optional) Add color to both base pages (exclusive 12" × 12" Sage patterned paper) with Speckled Egg and Rustic Wilderness Distress Oxide™ inks and a blending brush, as shown Tip: Layer and blend the colors in a few places, applying them one at a time.

Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the paper using a gentle circular motion.

 (Optional) Spray both base pages with white gloss spray, as shown

Tip: Spray the paper from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Sage patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1A and 1B
- 3. Attach 1C
- 4. Attach 1D

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

5. Attach photos


Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of the top right photo so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

6. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few die-cuts behind 1D and the top right photo.

Project 1: Right Page





Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Sage patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 1E and 1F
- 3. Attach 1G
- 4. Attach 1H

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top third so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 5. Attach 1I with 3-D foam tape

 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom or the left edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 6. Attach photos
- 7. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts
 Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam
 tape for added dimension. Tuck a few stickers and die-cuts
 behind 1H and 1I.
- 8. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Spray both base pages (exclusive 12" × 12" Mink patterned paper) with white gloss spray, as shown
 Tip: Spray the paper from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.
- (Optional) Color title sticker and two French Vanilla die cut hearts with Speckled Egg Distress Oxide™ ink and a blending brush, as shown

Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the embellishments using a gentle circular motion.



Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Mink patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A and 2B
- 3. Attach 2C and 2D

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 2C so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 4. Attach 2E
- 5. Attach 2F


Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right or bottom right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 6. Attach 2G
 - Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 7. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared title sticker and one prepared heart die-cut

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few stickers and die-cuts behind 2C, 2F, and 2G.

Project 2: Right Page





Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared exclusive Mink patterned paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2H and 2I
- 3. Attach 2J and 2K
- 4. Attach 2L
- 5. Attach 2M with 3-D foam tape

 Tips: Do not use adhesive along the top or bottom right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 6. Attach 2N

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right edge or the bottom so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Attach 20 and 2P

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 20 so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 9. Embellish 2P with frame sticker
- 10. Embellish with additional stickers and die-cuts, including second prepared heart die-cut

 Tins: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foon

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Trim the Mink scalloped circle diecut in half. Tuck a few stickers and die-cuts slightly behind 2M, 2N, and 2O.

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Add color to both base pages (12" × 12" French Vanilla cardstock) with Rustic Wilderness and Speckled Egg Distress Oxide™ inks and a blending brush, as shown Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the cardstock using a gentle circular motion.
- (Optional) Add color to a French Vanilla heart die cut with Speckled Egg Distress Oxide™ ink and a blending brush, as shown



Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared French Vanilla cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3A, 3B, and 3C
- 3. Attach 3D with 3-D foam tape
 Tips: Do not use adhesive along the top left or bottom right
 corners so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a
 later step.
- 4. Attach Pine frame die-cut to 3E, then attach
 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of the frame die-cut
 so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared heart die-cut
 - Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.





Assemble:

- 1. Use prepared French Vanilla cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3F, 3G, and 3H
- 3. Attach 3I, 3J, and 3K

 Tip: Only use adhesive along the top right corner of 3J so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 4. Attach photos
- 5. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts

 Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam
 tape for added dimension. Tuck a few of the hex-shaped diecuts behind 3J.
- 6. Finish attaching 3J
- 7. Add journaling
