Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of two stacked paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

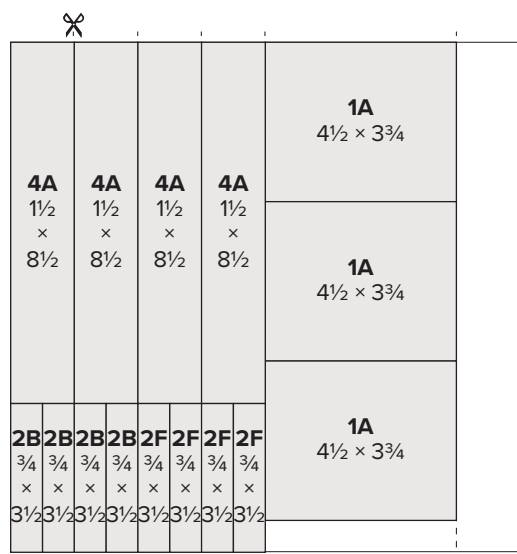

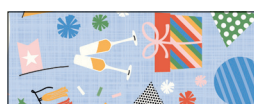
4E: $3 \times \frac{1}{2}$ (cut 4)

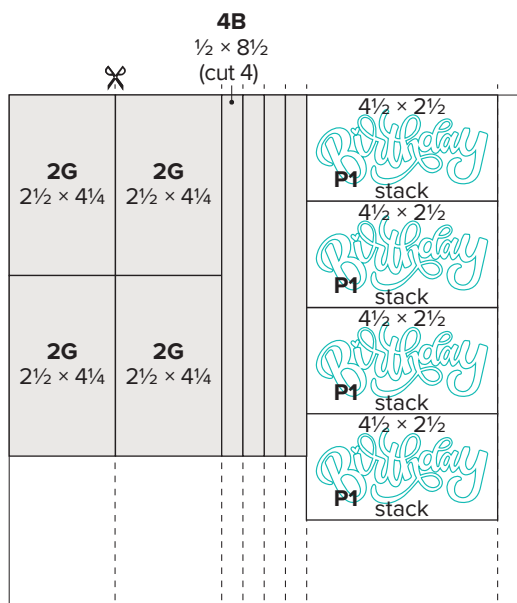
Bluebird cardstock

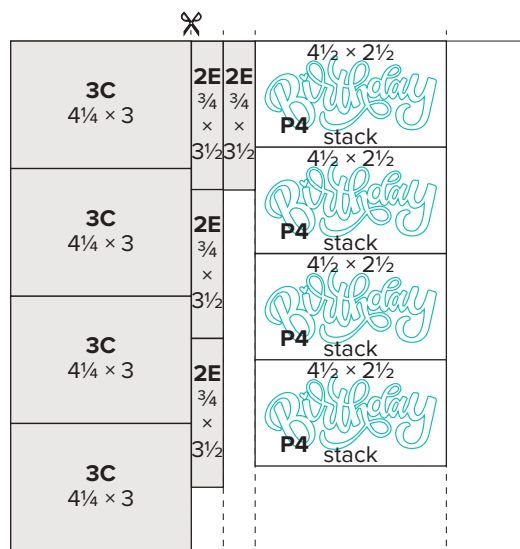
Periwinkle cardstock

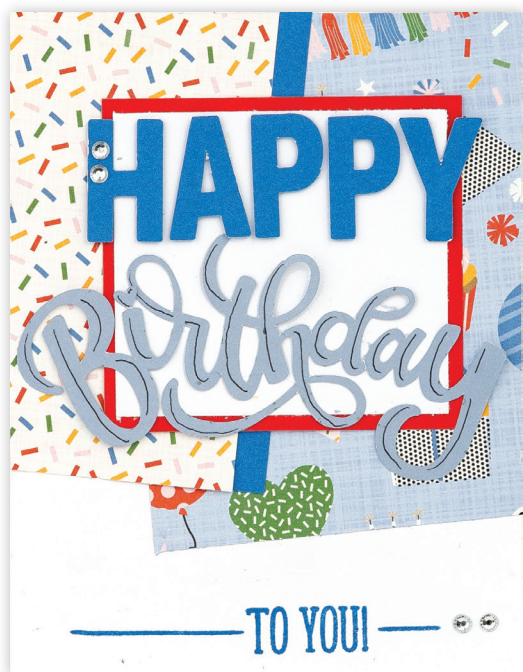

Project 1: Make 4



Prepare (4):

Card Base:

Paper: card base, 1A, 1B

Ink: Bluebird

Tips: Attach 1A, as shown (fig. 1), then trim excess. Attach 1B, as shown (fig. 2), then trim excess. Stamp the sentiment last.

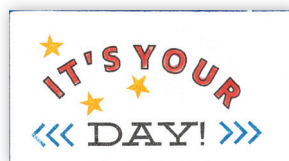
Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 1C, as shown
Tip: Trim the excess hanging off the card base.
3. Attach 1D and 1E
4. Attach P1 Bluebird cardstock "HAPPY" sentiment with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish P1 Periwinkle cardstock "Birthday" sentiment with Black LePen™, then attach
6. Embellish with sparkles



Project 2: Make 4

Prepare (4):



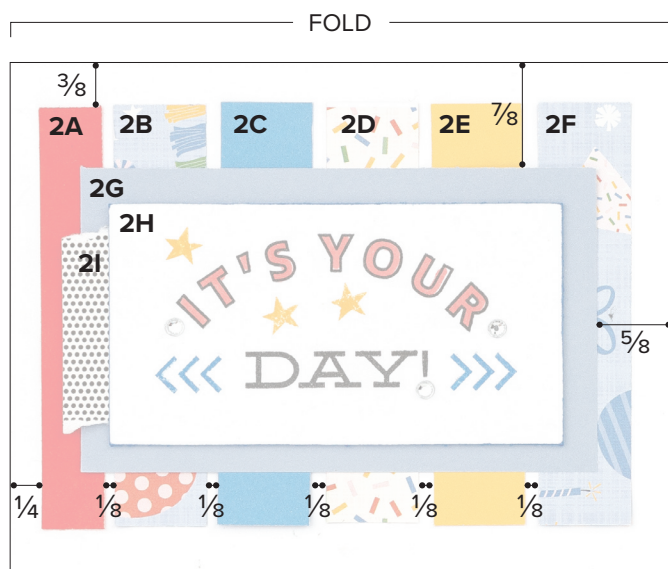
2H:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Bluebird, Sundance, Intense Black

Tips: Stamp the arrows and "DAY!" using the selective inking and masking techniques. Once the ink is dry, colour the sentiment with the lightest Coral Shades blend marker. Ink the edges of the cardstock with Bluebird ink by sliding them on the ink pad, until the desired amount of colour is achieved.

Technique: Cover the arrows on the stamp with sticky notes, then ink the stamp with Intense Black. Remove the sticky notes, then stamp on 2H. Clean the stamp. Carefully apply Bluebird ink to the arrows on both ends of the stamp, not inking the "DAY!" portion, and stamp on 2H.



Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E, and 2F
3. Attach 2G
4. Attach prepared 2H with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Tear approx. 1/4" from each short end of 2I and attach with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with sparkles

Project 3: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



3D:
Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Bluebird, Candy Apple,
Sundance, Intense Black



P3 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Bluebird
Tip: Hand trim.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B and 3C
4. Attach prepared 3D
5. Attach P3 Candy Apple cardstock "Birthday" sentiment
6. Attach prepared "Wishes" accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Embellish with sparkles

Project 4: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



4D:

Paper: White Daisy

Ink: Intense Black

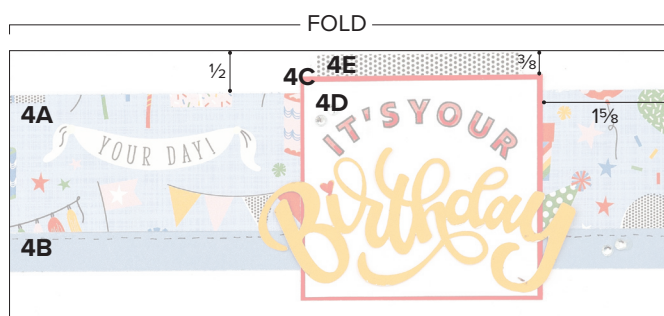
Tip: Once the ink is dry, colour the sentiment with the lightest and middle Coral Shades blend markers.



P4 Accent:

Paper: Sundance

Tip: Colour the heart with the middle Coral Shades blend marker.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Draw dashed line on 4B with Black LePen™
4. Attach 4C and prepared 4D
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 4C so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach prepared "Birthday" sentiment
6. Tear approx. 1/4" from both short ends of 4E, then attach, as shown
Tip: Tuck slightly behind 4C.
7. Embellish with sparkles
