Featured Technique: Assembling Butterflies

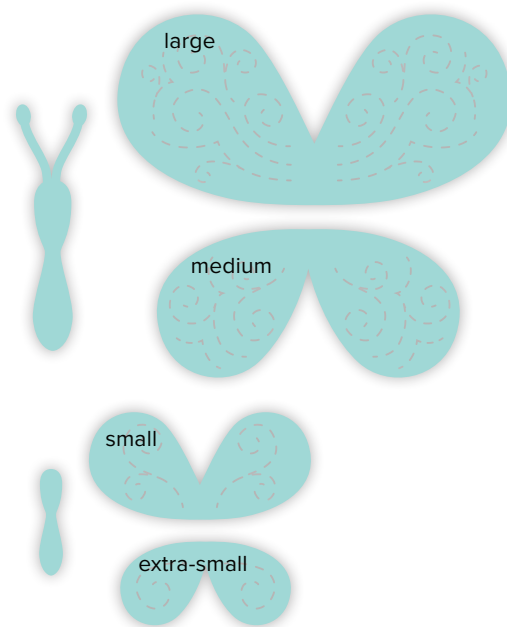

- Z2841 Glacier Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z6575 Limeade Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z3271 Archival Black Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
or Z4189 Intense Black Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
or Z2805 Black Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z5038 Die-cutting & Embossing Machine

- Y1000 1" x 1" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1005 1" x 6½" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1003 2" x 2" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1009 2" x 3½" My Acrylix® Block

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

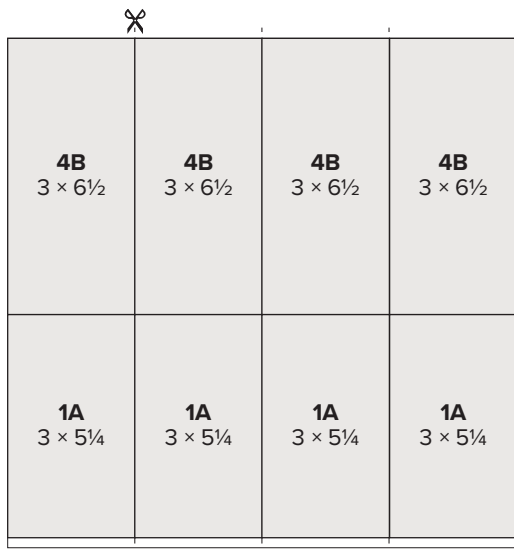

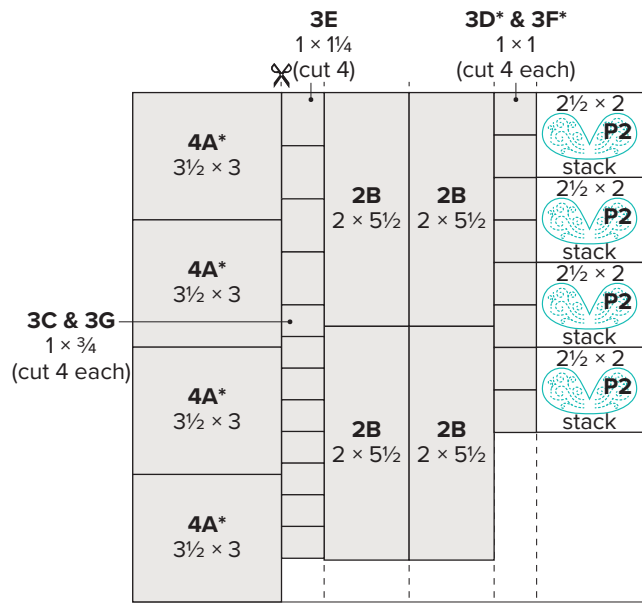

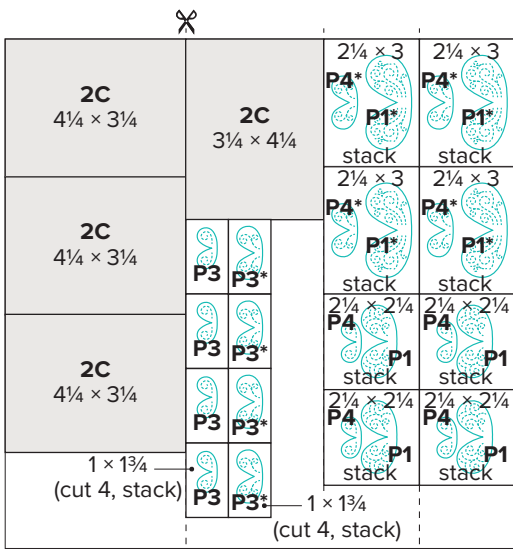

Peach cardstock

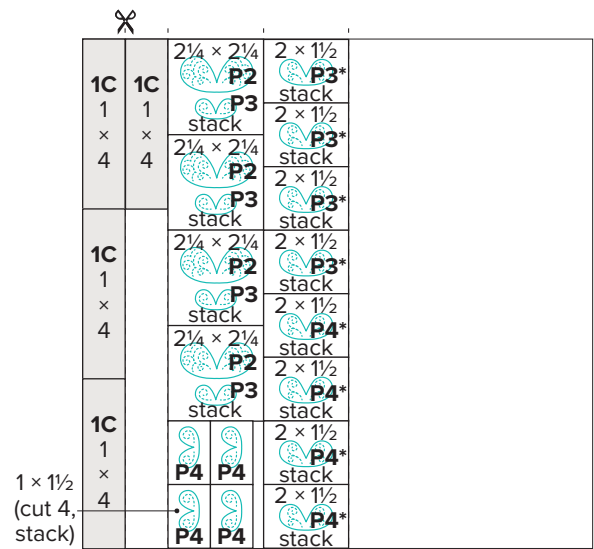

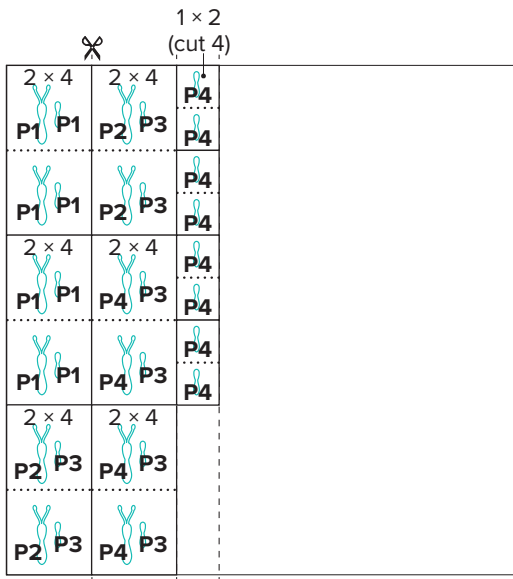

Project 1: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



1C:
Paper: light Limeade
Ink: Black
Tip: Dovetail.



P1 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Black
Tip: Hand trim.



Assemble:

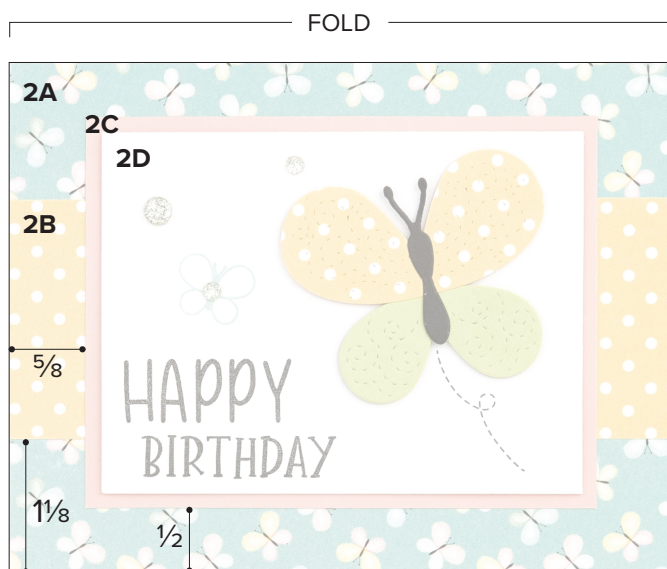
1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A
3. Stamp butterfly borders with Glacier ink, as shown
4. Attach 1B
5. Attach prepared 1C
6. Attach prepared "FRIEND" accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Assemble butterfly accents with P1 Peach, Seabrook, and Black cardstock parts
Tips: Assemble the butterflies on the card. The top half of the butterflies' wings are the true exclusive colour, and the bottoms are the lighter toned side of the cardstock. Technique: First, attach the wings with 3-D foam tape. Then attach the bodies.
8. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 2: Make 4

Prepare (4):



2D:
Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Black, Glacier
Tip: Stamp "BIRTHDAY" first.



Assemble:

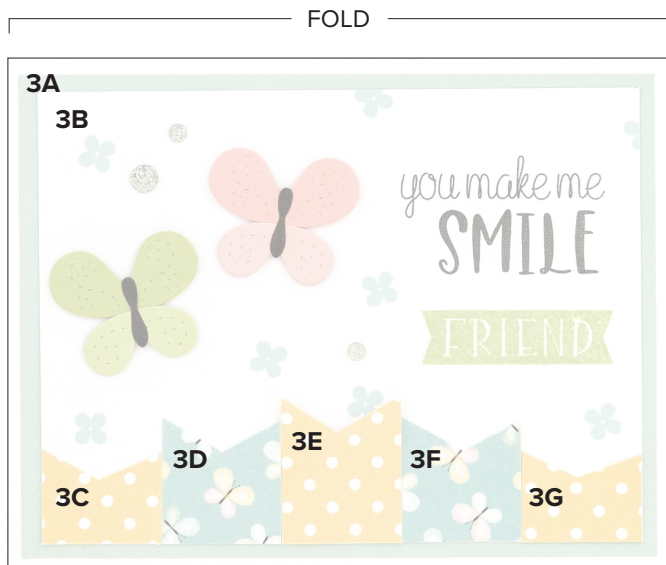
1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B
4. Attach 2C and prepared 2D
Tip: Attach 2D with thin 3-D foam tape.
5. Assemble butterfly accent with P2 polka dot patterned paper, light Limeade cardstock, and black cardstock parts, as shown
Tip: Assemble the butterfly on the card, lining it up with the stamped flight trail.
Technique: First, attach the wings with 3-D foam tape. Then attach the body.
6. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 3: Make 4

Prepare (4):



3B:
Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Black, Glacier, Limeade

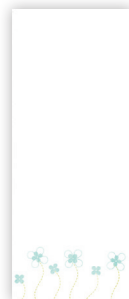


Assemble:

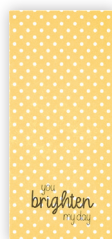
1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 3A and prepared 3B
3. Dovetail and attach 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F, and 3G, as shown
Tip: Make sure the dovetails are cut from one of the 1" sides of each piece.
4. Assemble butterfly accents with P3 Peach, Seabrook, and Black cardstock parts, as shown
Tips: Assemble the butterflies on the card. The top half of the butterflies' wings are the true exclusive colour, and the bottoms are the lighter toned side of the cardstock. Technique: First, attach the wings with 3-D foam tape. Then attach the bodies.
5. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 4: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



Card Base:
Paper: card base
Inks: Glacier, Limeade



4B:
Paper: Honey Butter polka dot
Ink: Black



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach prepared 4B
4. Assemble butterfly accents with P4 Peach, Seabrook, Limeade, and Black cardstock parts, as shown
Tips: Assemble the butterflies on the card. The top half of the butterflies' wings are the true exclusive colour, and the bottoms are the lighter toned side of the cardstock.
Technique: First, attach the wings with 3-D foam tape. Then attach the bodies.
