Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are scrapbooking project pieces. Dark grey pieces are cardmaking project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

✂ = first cut | * = use back of paper | P = project
 cut diagonal = angle in trimmer
 = suggested stamp arrangement

Tip: Make the diagonal cut by measuring from the top right corner to the bottom left of the paper with a ruler and lightly drawing a line with a pencil. Cut along the line with your scissors. Erase the pencil mark afterward.

Tip: Make the diagonal cut by measuring from the top right corner to the bottom left of the 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" square with a ruler and lightly drawing a line with a pencil. Cut along the line with your scissors. Erase the pencil mark afterward.



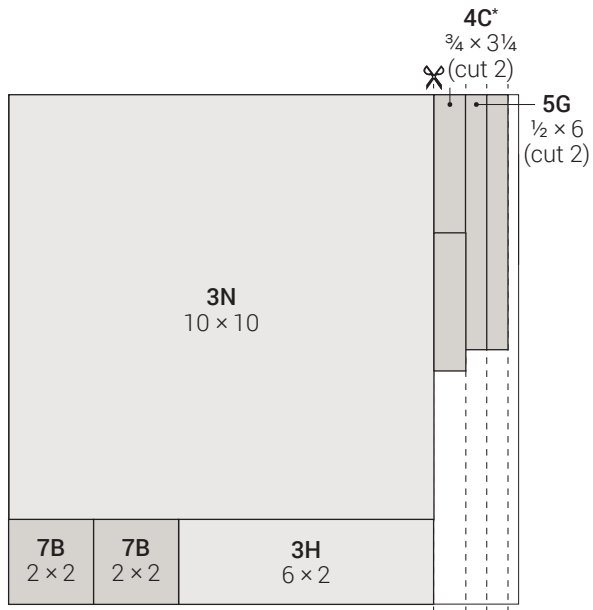

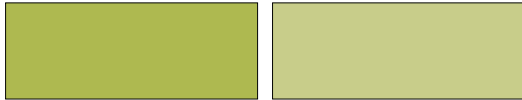

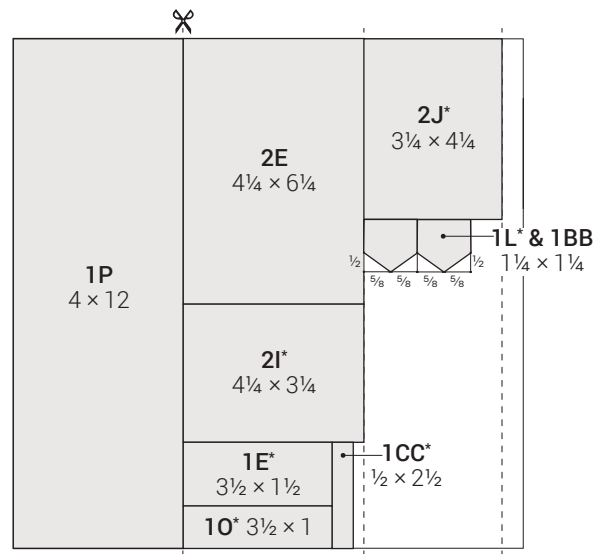


Avocado cardstock

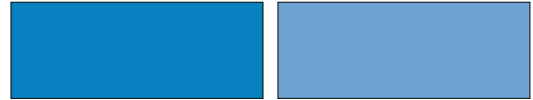

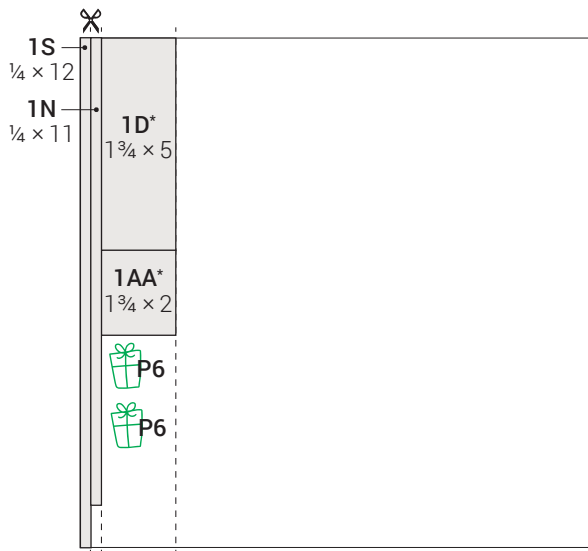


Bluebird cardstock

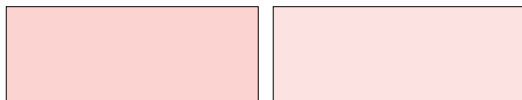

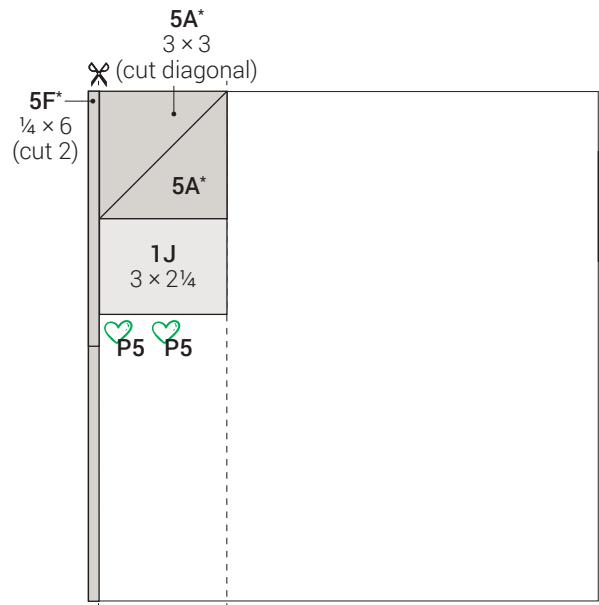


Ballerina cardstock

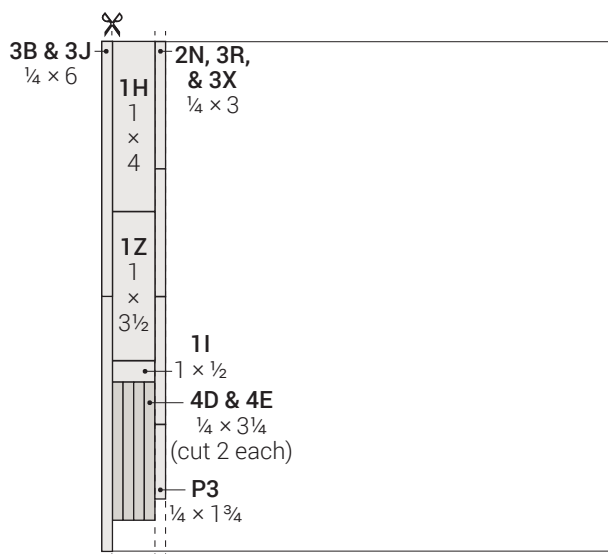


Wild Berry cardstock

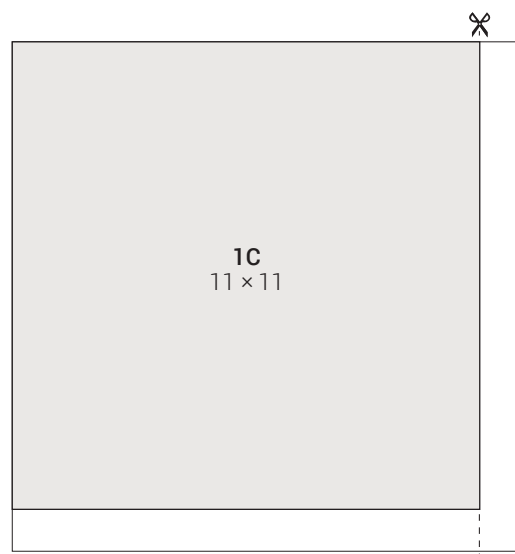

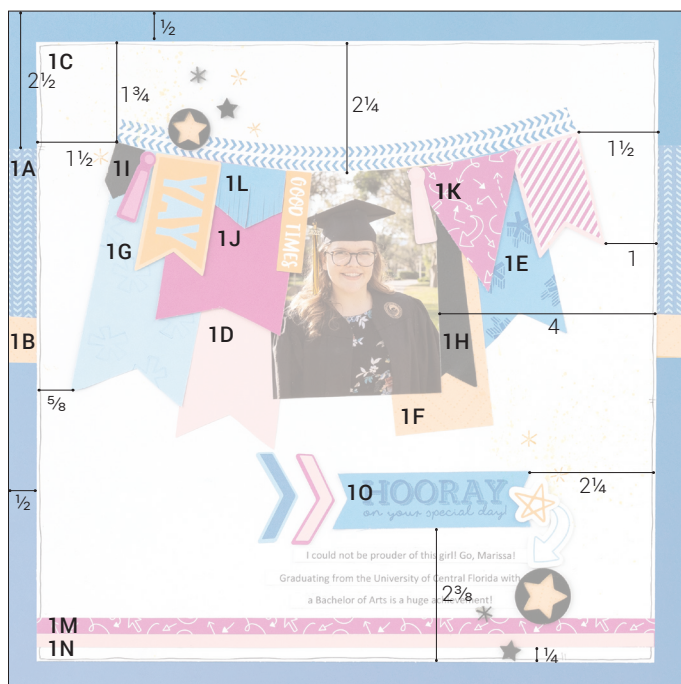


Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

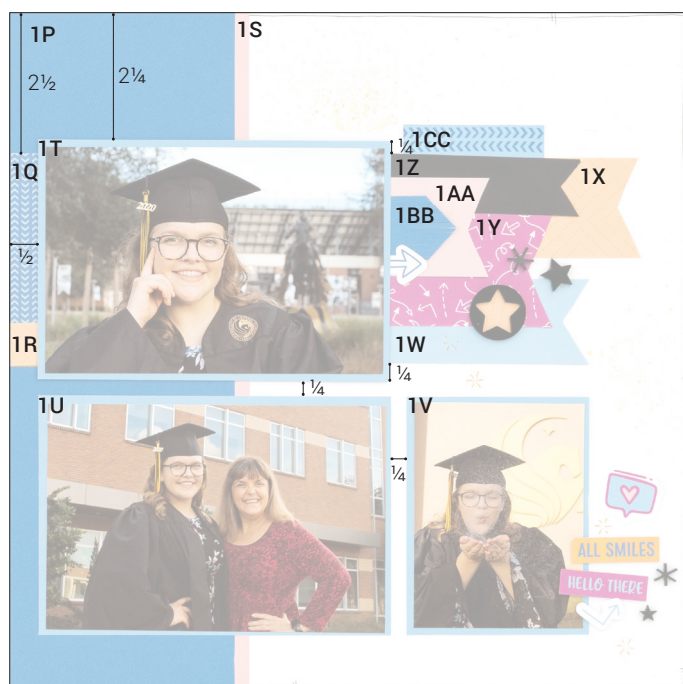
- Splatter Sundance ink on top left and bottom right corners of 1C and the right 2/3 of the right base page, as shown.
Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas that you do not want splattered.
Technique: Squeeze closed stamp pad in the center to transfer some ink to the inside lid. Open the pad and use the inked lid to pick up ink from. Pick up the ink with the tip of the waterbrush and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger above where you want the splatters to land.
- Attach two large open acrylic stars and one small open acrylic star to P1 accents, then hand trim
Tip: Attach acrylic stars to P1 accents with glue dots.
- Stamp solid asterisks on 1E with Bluebird ink, then dovetail, as shown
- Stamp open asterisks on 1G with Bluebird ink, then dovetail, as shown
Tip: Stamp asterisks using second-generation stamping technique.
Technique: Ink stamp in Bluebird ink and stamp it on a piece of scratch paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 1G.
- Stamp "HOORAY on your special day" on 1O with Bluebird ink, then dovetail, as shown
- Stamp arrow border on 1CC with Bluebird ink, as shown
- Stamp arrow border on 1C with Bluebird ink, as shown
Tips: With a pencil and ruler, make a mark 1¼" from top and 1½" from left side of 1C, and another 1¼" from top and 1½" from right side of 1C. Lightly draw a slightly curved line from mark to mark. Mask each edge with sticky notes. Using the line as a guide, stamp the arrow border. Curve the stamp on the block, as needed. Make sure that the splatters on 1C are completely dry before starting this step. Erase guideline once ink is completely dry.
- Hand trim fringe on 1L and 1BB
Tip: Hand trim approximately every ⅛" across the bottom edge, stopping approximately ¼" from the top with each cut.
- Draw borders on 1C and right base page with journaling pen, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use Bluebird Cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Dovetail and attach 1D, as shown
5. Attach prepared 1E, 1F, and prepared 1G, as shown
6. Dovetail and attach 1H, as shown
7. Hand trim 1I to form an arrow tip, and attach, as shown.
8. Attach photo
9. Dovetail and attach 1J, as shown
10. Attach prepared 1K with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
11. Attach prepared 1L, as shown
12. Attach 1M
13. Attach 1N on 1M
14. Attach prepared 1O
15. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
16. Embellish with acrylic stars and prepared P1 accents, as shown
Tip: Attach acrylic stars with glue dots.
17. Stamp tiny asterisks on 1C with Sundance ink, as shown
Tips: Attach a small acrylic asterisk to a stamp block with a glue dot. Ink the asterisk in Sundance ink and stamp onto scratch paper several times to season it before stamping directly onto project.
18. Add journaling to journaling strips, trim as desired, and attach, as shown

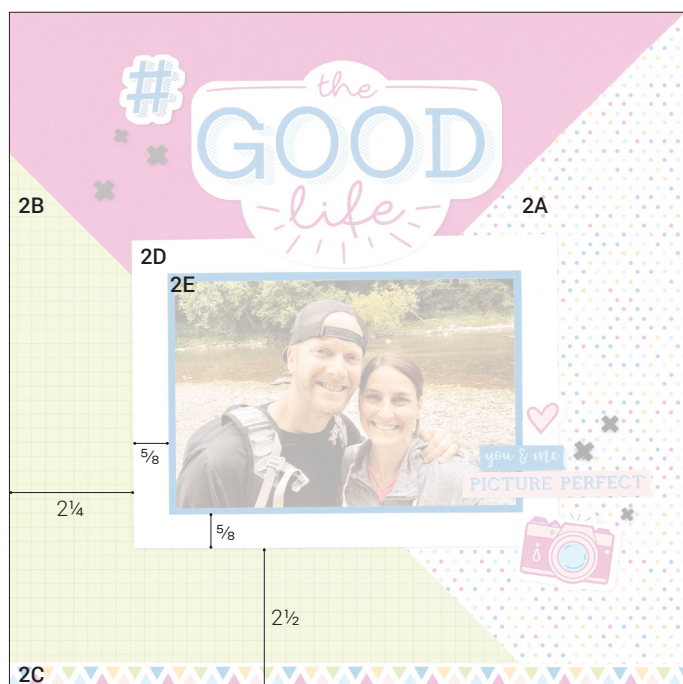
Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared White Daisy Cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1P
3. Attach 1Q, 1R and 1S
4. Attach 1T with thin 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right side so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach 1U and 1V
6. Attach photos
7. Dovetail and attach 1W, 1X, 1Y, 1Z, and 1AA, as shown
Tip: Tuck 1Y and 1Z slightly behind 1T.
8. Attach 1BB and 1CC, as shown
9. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Embellish with black acrylic stars and prepared P1 accent, as shown
Tip: Attach acrylic stars with glue dots
11. Stamp tiny asterisk on base page with Sundance ink, as shown
Tips: Attach a small acrylic asterisk to a stamp block with a glue dot. Ink the asterisk in Sundance ink and stamp onto scratch paper several times to season it before stamping directly onto project.

Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use Wild Berry cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B
4. Attach 2C
5. Attach 2D with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach 2E
7. Attach photo
8. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Wild Berry cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2F
3. Attach 2G
4. Attach 2H
5. Attach 2I with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach 2J
7. Attach 2K with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach 2L and 2M
9. Attach photos
10. Attach 2N to 2M
11. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
12. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
13. Add journaling to 2L

Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use Black cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, and 3D
3. Attach photo
4. Attach 3E, 3F, and 3G
5. Attach 3H to 3G
6. Attach 3I
7. Attach Sundance border sticker above 3J
Tip: Trim to 6" and reserve remaining border sticker for another project.
8. Attach 3J on Sundance border sticker
9. Tear approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " from one long sides of 3K and 3L, then attach, as shown
10. Embellish with additional stickers, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Trim the long Sundance border sticker to measure 6" x $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and reserve remaining border sticker for another project.
11. Stamp "HAPPY" on 3M with Bluebird ink, and attach with 3-D foam tape
12. Add journaling to journaling strip, trim as desired, and attach
13. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

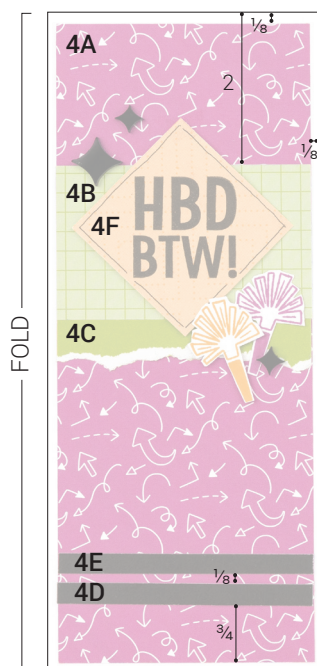
1. Use Black cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3N
3. Tear approximately 1/4" from one long side of 3O, then attach
4. Attach 3P
5. Attach 3Q and 3R to 3P
6. Attach 3S
7. Attach 3T to 3S
8. Attach photos
9. Attach 3U and 3V
10. Attach 3W and 3X to 3V
11. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
12. Attach Black cardstock accent
Tip: Hand trim one end into an angle.
13. Embellish with acrylic stars
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 4: Make 2



Prepare (2):

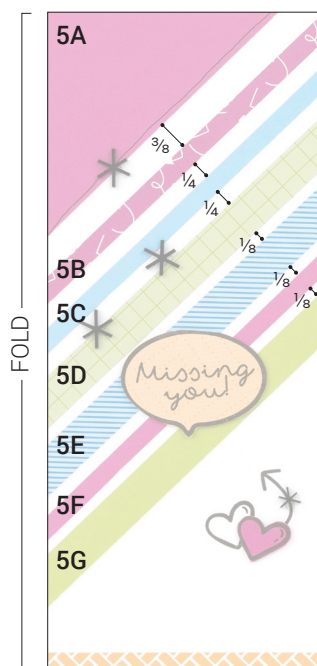
- Stamp "HBDBTW" on 4F with Intense Black ink and draw border with journaling pen, as shown
- Stamp party noisemakers onto White Daisy cardstock P4 accents with Sundance ink, then hand trim, as shown
- Stamp party noisemakers onto White Daisy cardstock P4 accents with Wild Berry ink, then hand trim



Assemble:

1. Attach 4A
2. Attach 4B
3. Tear approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " from one long edge of 4C, then attach
4. Attach 4D and 4E
5. Attach prepared 4F with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish prepared P4 noisemaker accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the Sundance one with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 5: Make 2



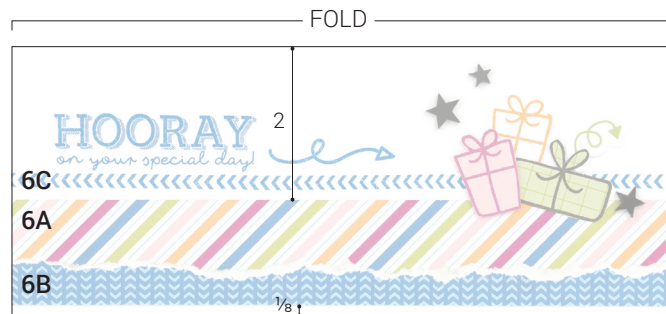
Prepare (2):

- Stamp large speech bubbles on Sundance diamonds paper with Intense Black ink and hand trim, as shown
- Stamp heart on Wild Berry cardstock with Intense Black ink and hand trim, as shown
- Draw border along the long diagonal edge of 5A with journaling pen, as shown

Assemble:

1. Attach 5A
2. Attach 5B, 5C, 5D, 5E, 5F, and 5G
Tip: Trim excess after attaching.
3. Stamp heart and curved arrow on card base with Intense Black ink, as shown
4. Attach prepared Sundance diamonds speech bubble accent with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach prepared Wild Berry heart accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with Sundance border sticker, as shown
Tip: Trim sticker to measure $\frac{1}{4}$ " \times $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".
7. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tips: Attach with glue dots. Clean and use the small asterisk used for stamping.

Project 6: Make 2



Prepare (2):

- Stamp tall present on light Ballerina cardstock with Wild Berry ink and hand trim, as shown
- Stamp short present on Avocado grid paper with Intense Black ink and hand trim, as shown
- Stamp border on 6C with Bluebird ink and trim to show only one row of arrows, as shown

Assemble:

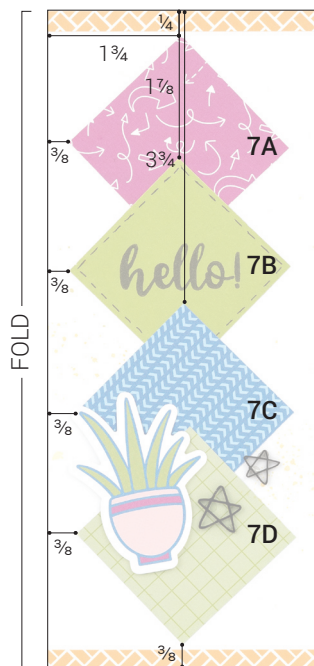
1. Attach 6A
2. Tear approximately 1/4" from one long edge of 6B, then attach to 6A
3. Attach prepared 6C
4. Stamp "HOORAY on your special day" and long arrow on card base with Bluebird ink, as shown
5. Stamp tall present on card base with Sundance ink, as shown
6. Attach prepared Ballerina cardstock and Avocado grid present accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the Ballerina cardstock present accent with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with arrow sticker, as shown
Tip: Each card uses a different arrow sticker.
8. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 7: Make 2



Prepare (2):

- Stamp "hello" on 7B with Intense Black ink, and draw stitched border around edges with journaling pen, as shown



Assemble:

1. Attach 7A
2. Attach prepared 7B
3. Attach 7C and 7D
4. Embellish with plant and border stickers, as shown
Tips: Attach the plant stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Trim border stickers to measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{4}''$. Each card uses a different plant sticker.
5. Embellish with acrylic stars, as shown
Tip: Attach with a glue dots.
