Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent piece along the top of each sheet of patterned paper. *Please note that none of the zip strips are used in this workshop.*
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the pattern pieces on your project facing the right direction.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces creating a stack for each project.
- In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the stack of two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled "stack."

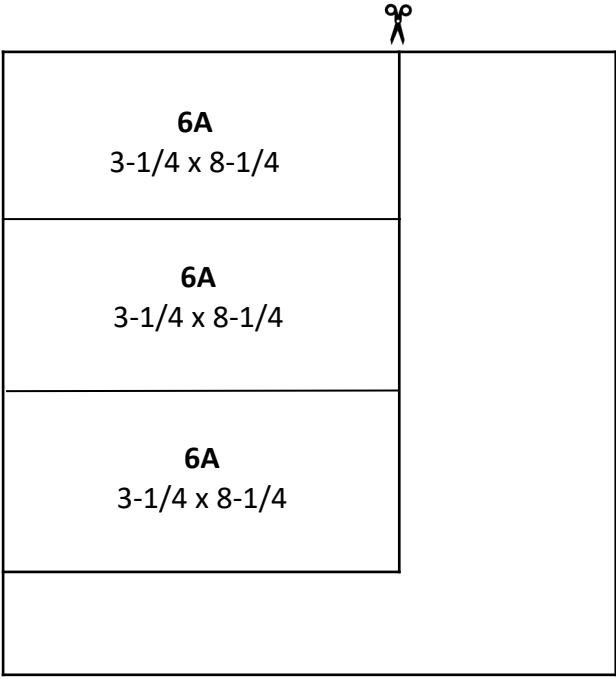


Glacier Cardstock

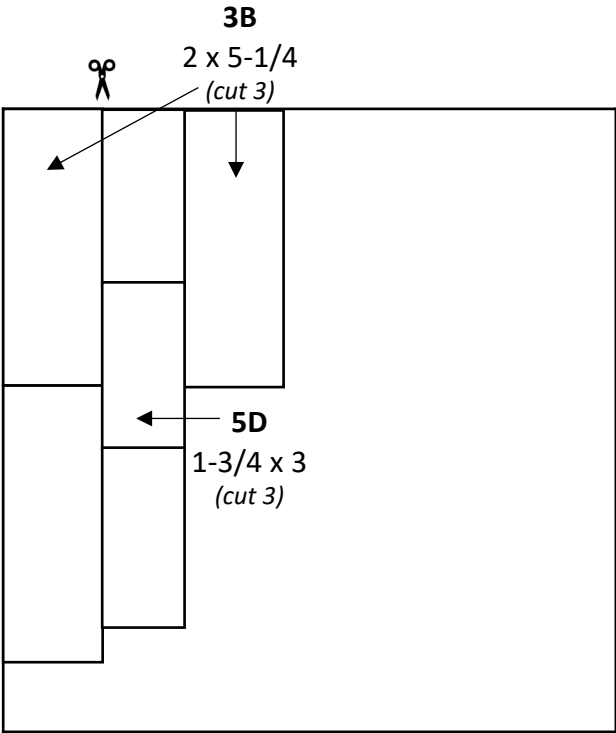

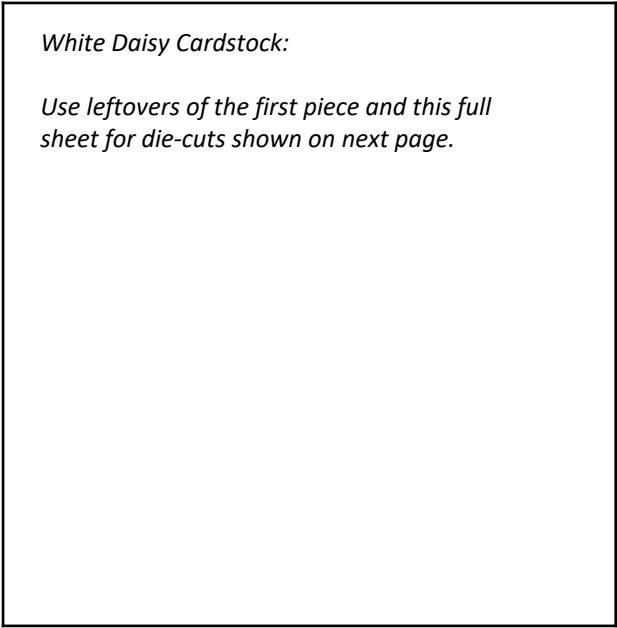

Cutting Diagram for Thin Cuts



1. Round Snowman: Cut 6 and stamp with Intense Black ink
2. Tall Snowman: Cut 6 and stamp with Intense Black ink
3. Crab with Lights: Cut 6 and stamp with Intense Black ink
4. Scallop Shell: Cut 12 and stamp with Intense Black ink
5. Sand Dollar Shell: Cut 9 and stamp with Intense Black ink
6. Seashell: Cut 9 and stamp with Intense Black ink
7. Sunglasses: Cut 6 and stamp with Intense Black ink
8. Flip Flops: Cut 3 and stamp with Intense Black ink
9. Starfish: Cut 12. Stamp 9 with Melon ink and 3 with Glacier Ink

Project 1: Make 3 Standard Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color 3 Round Snowmen, 3 Sunglasses, and 3 Sparkles.



Gold Brown

- Use Light to color in the head and body.
- Use Medium to feather in sand from the left side. Blend the colors well to get an uneven look.

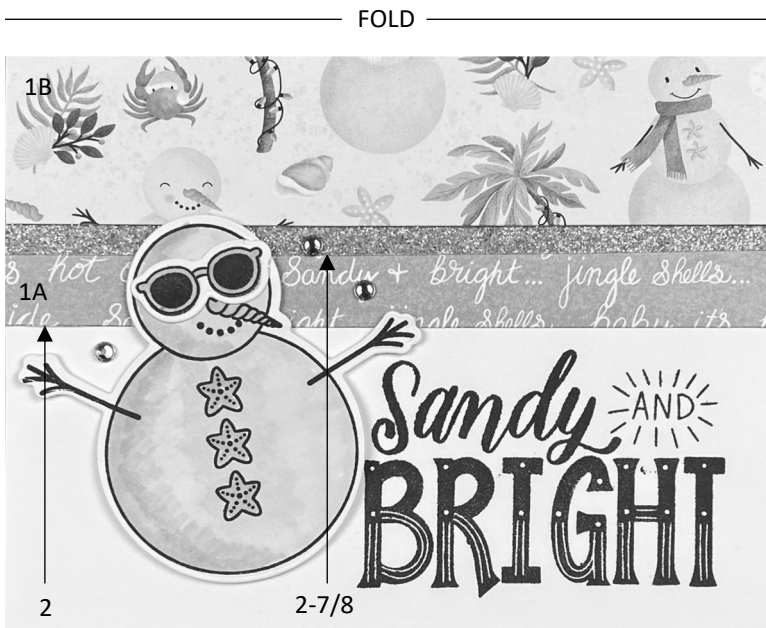
- Color 9 Sparkles with Dark.

Coral

- Use Light to color the nose.

Vintage Blue

- Use Light to color the starfish buttons and sunglasses frames.



Assemble

- Attach 1A. Adhere 5-1/2" strip of Papaya shimmer trim on 1A at the top edge.
- Attach 1B along the top of the card.
- Stamp sentiment on card base with Intense Black ink 1/4" from bottom and right side.
- Attach sunglasses to snowman.
- Attach snowman to card front with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.

Project 2: Make 3 Standard Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color the 3 Crabs, 3 Sand Dollars, 3 Sea Shells, 3 Scallops, and 9 Sparkles.



Gold Brown

- Use Light to color the sand dollar and seashell.
- Use Medium to shadow the sand dollar and seashell. Blend as desired.

Coral

- Use Light to color the crab, the center of the sand dollar, shadow the seashell, and every other section of the scallop.
- Use Medium to shadow the crab and color open sections of the scallop. Blend as desired.
- Use Dark to color 8 bulbs in the light strand and 9 Sparkles.

Vintage Blue

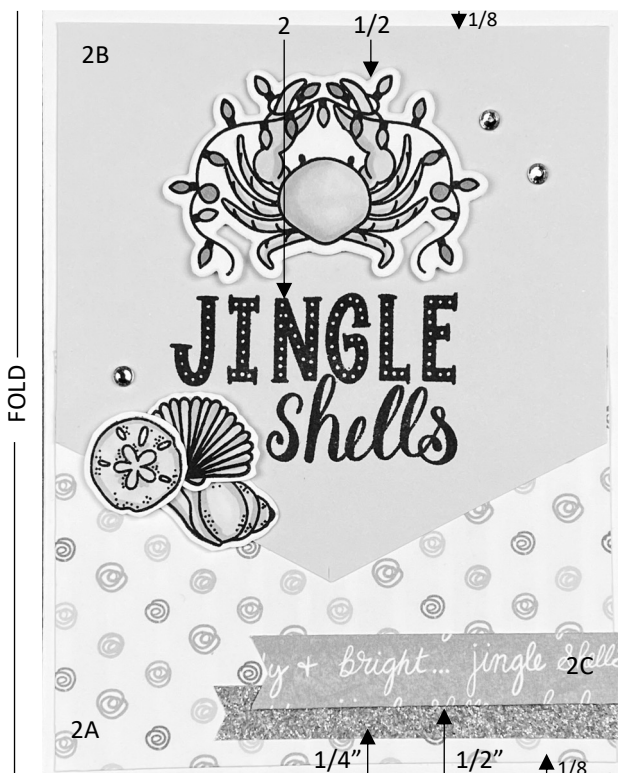
- Use Medium to color 4 bulbs and 2 loops in the light strand.

Light Green

- Use Light to color 7 bulbs in the light strand.

Assemble

- Attach 2A to the card front.
- Cut the angles on 2B and attach to card front.
- Dovetail a 3" piece of Papaya shimmer trim and adhere to card.
- Dovetail 2C on the left edge and attach to card.
- Stamp Jingle Shells using Intense Black ink.
- Attach crab to card front with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Attach seashell direct to card and use thin 3-D foam tape to adhere the scallop and sand dollar.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.



Project 3: Make 3 Standard Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color 3 Tall Snowmen, 3 Flip Flops, 3 Sand Dollars and 9 Sparkles



Gold Brown

- Use Light to color the sand dollar, hat rim and ball, and star fish on snowman.
- Use Medium to shadow the sand dollar. Blend as desired.

Coral

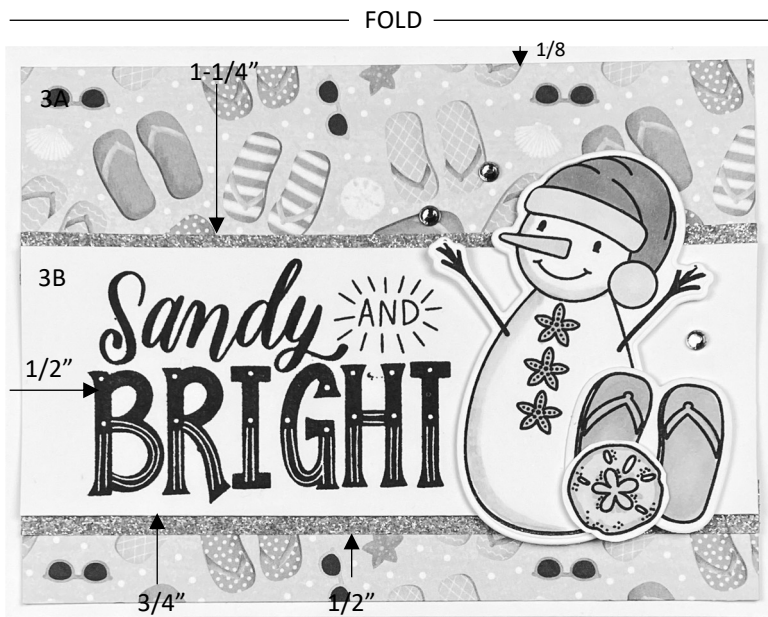
- Use Light to color the nose, flip flops, and center of sand dollar.
- Use Medium x2 to color the hat.

Vintage Blue

- Use Light to shadow the snowman on left side.
- Color 9 Sparkles with Dark.

Light Green

- Use Light to color the straps on the Flip Flops.



Assemble

- Attach 3A to card front.
- Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips of Papaya Shimmer Trim. Add to card front.
- Stamp sentiment on 3B with Intense Black ink. Adhere to card front.
- Attach snowman with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Attach flip flops and sand dollar.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.

Project 4: Make 3 Standard Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color 3 Round Snowmen, 3 Sunglasses, and 9 Sparkles



Gold Brown

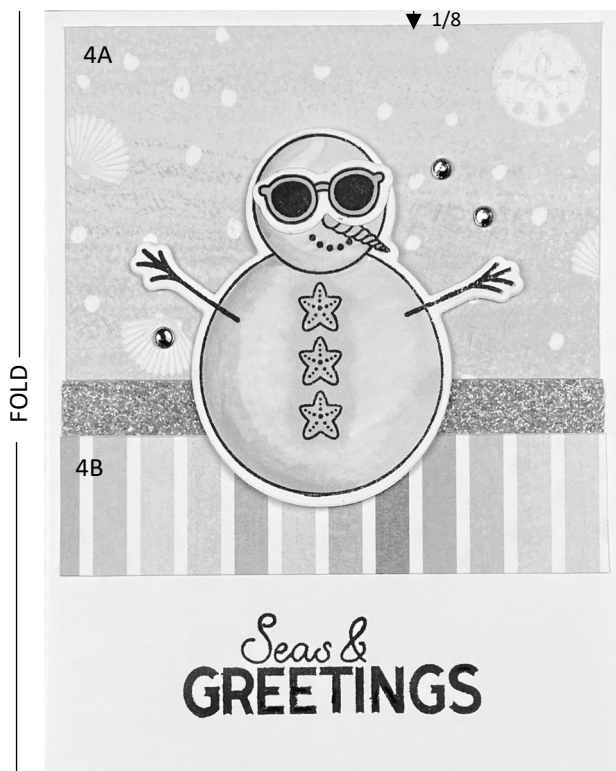
- Use Light to color in the head and body.

Coral

- Use Light to color the nose and star fish buttons.
- Use Medium to color sunglasses frame.

Vintage Blue

- Use Light to shadow the left side of the snowman. Blend into the Gold Brown.
- Use Dark to color the 9 Sparkles.



Assemble

- Attach 4A to top of card front.
- Attach 4" strip of Papaya shimmer trim directly below 4A.
- Attach 4B directly below Papaya shimmer trim.
- Stamp sentiment on card base with Intense Black ink.
- Attach sunglasses to snowman.
- Attach snowman to card front with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.

Project 5: Make 3 Slimline Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color 3 Crabs, 3 Seashells, 3 Scallops and 9 Sparkles



Gold Brown

- Use Light to color in the crab, seashell, and every other section of the scallop.
- Use Medium to shade the crab, seashell, and the rest of the scallop. Blend as desired.
- Use Dark to color the 9 Sparkles.

Coral

- Use Light to shade the crab and seashell. Blend.
- Use Dark to color 6 bulbs and 2 loops on light strand.

Light Green

- Use Dark to color 13 bulbs on the light strand.



Assemble

- Attach 5A followed by 5B.
- Adhere (2) 3" pieces of Papaya shimmer trim.
- Attach 5C.
- Stamp Jingle Shells on 5D with Intense Black ink. Attach to card.
- Attach crab to card with thin 3-D foam tape. Tuck Melon starfish as shown next to the crab.
- Attach seashell, scallop, and Glacier starfish with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.

Project 6: Make 3 Slimline Cards



Preparation for 3 Cards

Color 3 Tall Snowmen, 3 Seashells, 6 Scallops, 3 Sand Dollars and 9 Sparkles.



Gold Brown

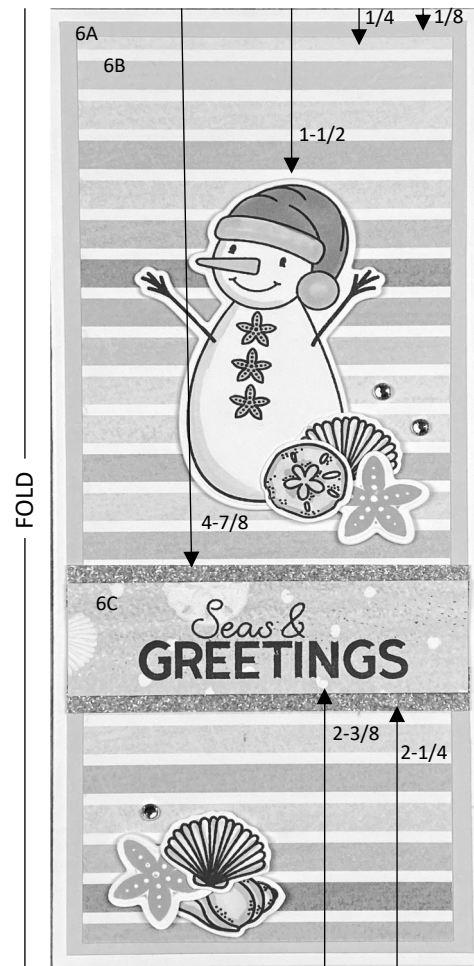
- Use Light to shadow the left side of the snowman. Also use to color the starfish buttons, sand dollar, the seashell, and every other section on three scallops.
- Use Medium to shade the seashell, sand dollar, and the rest of the scallop. Blend as desired.

Coral

- Use Light to color the snowman nose, the inside of the sand dollar, and every other section of the scallop. Shade the seashell.
- Use Medium to the remainder of the scallop.
- Use Dark to color the snowman hat and the 9 Sparkles.

Vintage Blue

- Use light to color the hat fur and ball.



Assemble

- Attach 6A followed by 6B.
- Adhere (2) 3-1/4" pieces of Papaya shimmer trim.
- Stamp Seas & Greetings on 6C with Intense Black ink. Attach to card.
- Attach snowman to card with thin 3-D foam tape. Cluster scallop, sand dollar, and starfish as shown next to the snowman.
- Attach lower left cluster of seashell, scallop, and starfish with thin 3-D foam tape.
- Embellish with colored Sparkles.
