Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper before running the paper through your die-cutting machine.

Opening Page:



Prepare:

- Stamp solid circles on base page, creating a fish scale pattern, with Sapphire, Sage, and Glacier inks, as shown
Tip: Start with the line of Sapphire circles first, then the Sage, and then the Glacier. Begin each line with the left most circle, stamping left to right.
- Stamp long and short solid sunrays on Opening Page White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the short sunrays.
Technique: Ink the stamp with Sundance and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock.
- Stamp solid circle on prepared circle accent with Sundance ink, as shown
- Stamp "Hello" on Opening Page E with Sundance ink, and dovetail
- Sponge edges of "Hello" accent with Toffee ink
Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub it along the edges of the cardstock.



Assemble:

1. Use prepared White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach Opening Page A and Opening Page B
3. Attach Opening Page C
4. Attach Opening Page D with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photo
6. Stamp "Sunshine" on base page with Sundance ink, as shown
7. Attach prepared sun accent, as shown
Tip: Tuck slightly behind Opening Page D.
8. Attach prepared Opening Page E, as shown
9. Embellish with star die-cuts

Layout 1: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

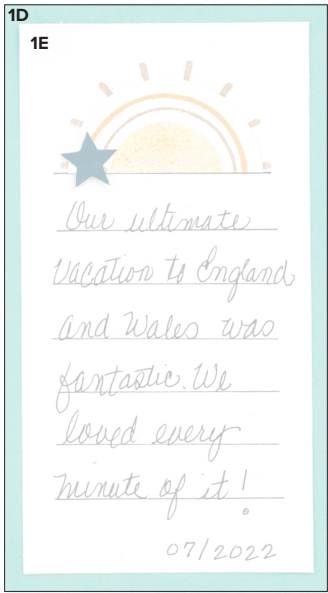
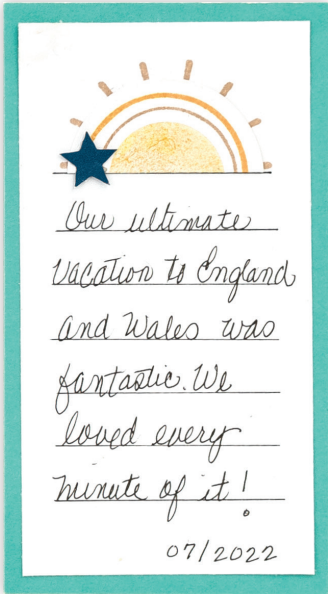
- Stamp "Create Your Own" and "Sunshine" on 1B with Toffee ink, as shown
- Stamp short sunrays on 1E with Toffee ink
Tip: Use the masking technique.
Technique: Place masking tape, or a sticky note, as a mask to cover the area of 1E that you don't want stamped. Stamp the sunrays on 1E and the mask, and then remove the mask.
- Draw journaling lines on 1E with a journaling pen and ruler
- Stamp solid circle, small open circle, and medium open circle on 1½" White Daisy circle die-cut with Sundance and Toffee inks
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the solid circle.
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sundance and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the circle die-cut.
- Cut prepared circle in half and attach to prepared 1E, as shown
- Stamp large open circle on one 2" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Glacier ink
- Stamp large open circle on second 2" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Toffee ink
- Stamp smiling circle and triangle sunrays on prepared Glacier circle accent with Sundance ink
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the smiling circle.
- Stamp opened eyes on prepared sun accent with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Stamp "SHINE BRIGHT" on prepared Toffee circle accent with Sundance ink
- Cut a semicircle into top of 1C with 1" circle die, as shown
Tip: Place the die centered on the edge, and half off the paper. Hold it in place with washi tape and run it through your die-cutting machine.



Assemble:

- Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- Attach 1A
- Attach prepared 1B
- Attach prepared 1C with 3-D foam tape, creating a pocket
Tips: Use ¼" foam tape along the bottom and both sides of 1C. Do not use adhesive along the top or center.
- Attach prepared sun accent, as shown
- Attach prepared 1E to 1D
- Embellish 1D and page with star die-cuts
- Insert page into Memory Protector and cut slit for pocket
Tip: Make sure the page is sitting completely down in the protector.
Technique:
 - With a pencil and ruler, carefully draw a line on the protector along the pocket's opening.
 - Remove the page from the Memory Protector.
 - Place a cutting mat or sturdy cardboard inside the Memory Protector.
 - Carefully trace the pencil mark with a tip of the micro-tip scissors to cut the protector.
 - Wipe off any pencil residue and remove the mat.
 - Insert the page back into the Memory Protector.
- Add journaling to 1E and insert into pocket
- Insert two 3" × 4" photos into pocket

Assemble:

1. Use 1F as base for top pocket insert
2. Attach 1G and photo
3. Attach 1H to 1G
4. Attach prepared "SHINE BRIGHT" accent, as shown
5. Embellish with star die-cuts
6. Use 1I as base for bottom pocket insert
7. Attach photos
8. Draw journaling lines on 1I with a journaling pen and ruler, as shown
9. Embellish with star die-cut
10. Add journaling
11. Insert 1F and 1I into Memory Protector

Layout 2: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Stamp short sunrays on 1½" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Toffee ink
- Stamp solid circle on 1" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp shy eyes and smile line on stamped circle with Sapphire ink
- Stamp long solid sunrays on 2" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink

Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique.

Technique: Ink the stamp with Sundance and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock.

- Stamp long sunrays and "Sunshine" on stamped 2" circle accent with Toffee ink, as shown

Tip: Use the selective inking technique. Use masking tape if necessary.

Technique: Carefully apply ink to the "Sun" portion of the stamp, only, and stamp it on the cardstock. Clean the stamp, and then, carefully apply ink to the "shine" portion of the stamp and stamp it on the cardstock. For easier inking, use masking tape along the side of the word that you are not inking.



Assemble:

1. Use 2A as base for top pocket insert
2. Attach 2B
3. Attach 2C
4. Attach photo
5. Attach prepared sun accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the sun's face accent with 3-D foam tape.
6. Embellish with star die-cuts
7. Insert 2A and photo into Memory Protector

Assemble:

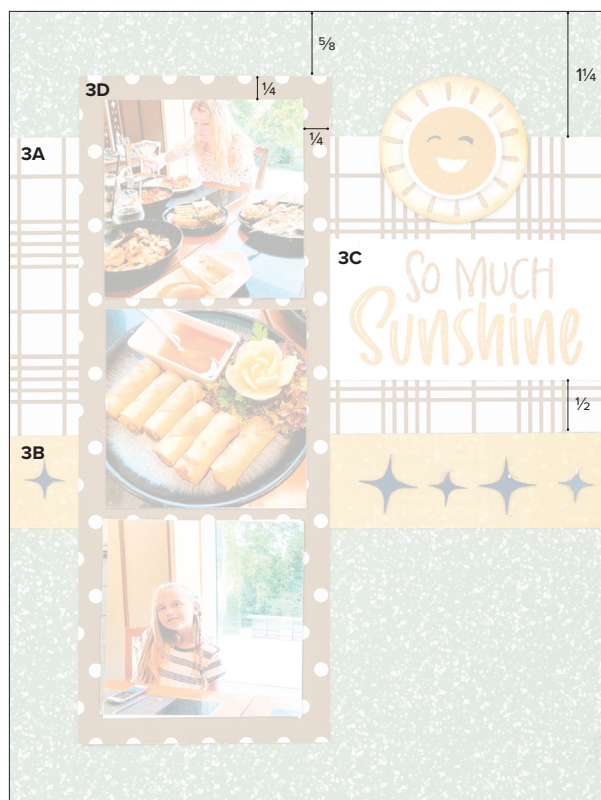
1. Use Sapphire diamond patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2D
3. Attach 2E and 2F
4. Attach photos
5. Stamp "Be the" on 2D with Toffee ink, as shown
6. Attach prepared "Sunshine" accent, as shown
7. Embellish with star die-cuts
8. Add journaling

Layout 3: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Stamp short sunrays on 1½" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Toffee ink
- Sponge edge of stamped circle with Sundance ink
Tip: Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub it along the edge.
- Stamp smiling circle on one 1" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp smiley eyes on stamped smiling circle with Sapphire ink
- Stamp solid circle on remaining 1" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp "So MUCH" and "Sunshine" on 3C with Toffee and Sundance inks, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use Sage speckled patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach prepared 3C
4. Attach 3D
5. Attach photos
6. Attach prepared sun accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the sun's face accent with 3-D foam tape.
7. Embellish with star die-cuts

Assemble:

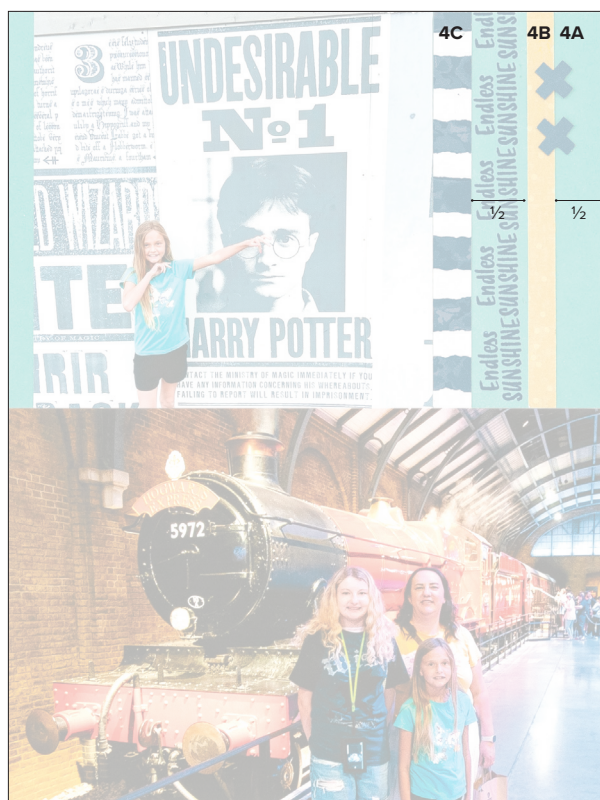
1. Use 3E as base for bottom pocket insert
2. Attach 3F and 3G
3. Attach 3H
4. Draw journaling lines on 3F with a journaling pen and ruler
5. Attach photo
6. Attach prepared circle accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
7. Embellish with star die-cuts
8. Add journaling
9. Insert photo and 3E into Memory Protector

Layout 4: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Stamp triangle sunrays and solid circle on one White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the circle.
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sundance and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock.
- Stamp “Endless Summer” on stamped sun with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Stamp short solid sunrays and solid circle on remaining White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the sunrays.



Assemble:

1. Use 4A as base for top pocket insert
2. Attach 4B and 4C
3. Stamp “Endless SUNSHINE” on 4A with Sapphire ink, as shown
4. Attach photo
5. Embellish with star die-cuts
6. Insert 4A and photo into Memory Protector

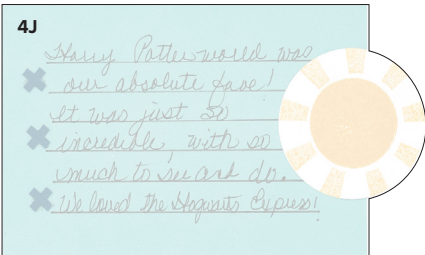
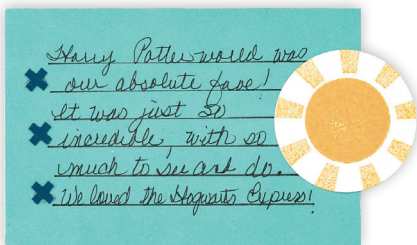
Layout 4: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Sapphire and white striped patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 4D and 4E
3. Attach 4F with 3-D foam tape, creating a pocket
Tips: On the back side of 4F, place 1/4" foam tape along the top, bottom, and left edge. When it's attached, the opening should be on the left side.
4. Attach photos
Tip: Attach one photo on top of 4F.
5. Embellish with star die-cuts
6. Assemble 4F's pocket insert
Technique:
 - a. Attach 4J to the back of 4G.
 - b. Draw journaling lines on 4J with a journaling pen and ruler.
 - c. Attach 4H and 4I to 4G, as shown.
 - d. Attach the 2" x 2" photo to 4I.
 - e. Attach the prepared circle accents to 4G and 4J, back-to-back, as shown.
Tip: Do not use adhesive on the right half of the "Endless SUNSHINE" accent so it can later hook onto the front of the pocket.
7. Insert page into Memory Protector and cut slit for pocket
Tip: Make sure the page is sitting completely down in the protector.
Technique:
 - a. With a pencil and ruler, carefully draw a line on the protector along the pocket's opening.
 - b. Remove the page from the Memory Protector.
 - c. Place a cutting mat or sturdy cardboard inside the Memory Protector.
 - d. Carefully trace the pencil mark with a tip of the micro-tip scissors to cut the protector.
 - e. Wipe off any pencil residue and remove the mat.
 - f. Insert the page back into the Memory Protector.
8. Insert prepared 4G into pocket
Tip: Hook the "Endless SUNSHINE" circle on the photo's edge.

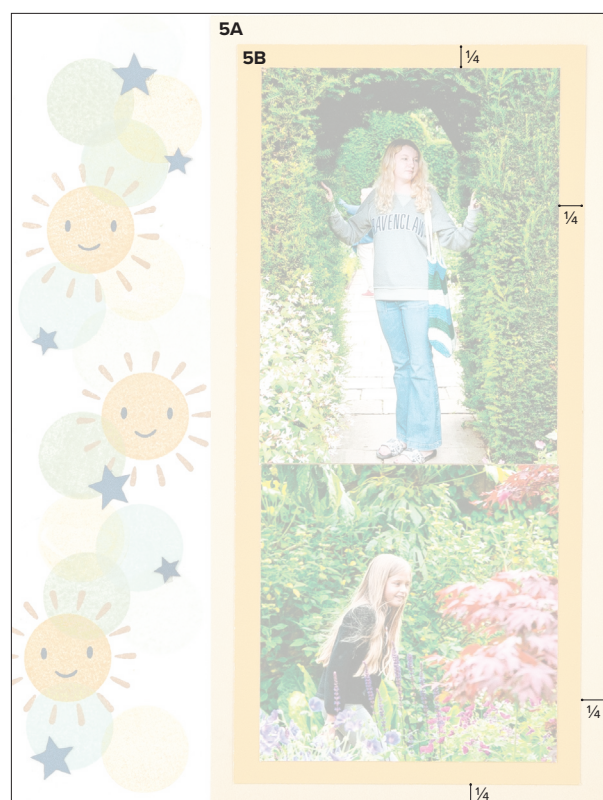


Layout 5: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Stamp solid circles along left side of left base page with Glacier, Sage, and Sundance inks, as shown
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique for all of the circles, except for three Sundance ones.
Technique: Ink the stamp then stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the cardstock.
- Stamp short sunrays around stamped Sundance circles on base page with Toffee ink, as shown
- Stamp open eyes and smile lines on stamped suns with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Stamp solid circle and short sunrays on 5C with Sundance ink, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use prepared White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 5A
3. Attach 5B
4. Attach photos
5. Embellish with star die-cuts

Layout 5: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared 5C as base for top pocket insert
2. Attach 5D
3. Attach 5E and 5F
4. Stamp open eyes next to lines on 5C with Sapphire ink, as shown
5. Draw journaling lines on 5C with a journaling pen and ruler, as shown
6. Attach photo
7. Embellish with star die-cuts
8. Add journaling
9. Insert 5C and photo into Memory Protector

Layout 6: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Draw journaling lines on 6C with a journaling pen and ruler, as shown
- Stamp "The Sun Will Rise Again" on 6D with Toffee ink, as shown
- Stamp long solid sunrays on 1½" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Toffee ink
- Stamp solid circle on 1" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp shy eyes on stamped solid circle with Sapphire ink, as shown



Assemble:

- Use 6A as base for top pocket insert
- Attach 6B, prepared 6C, and prepared 6D
- Stamp solid circles on 6A with Sundance ink, as shown
Tips: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the lighter circles.
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sundance and stamp it on 6A. Then, without re-inking, stamp again on 6A. Repeat until the desired effect is achieved.
- Stamp shy eyes on 6A with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Attach photo
- Embellish with star die-cuts
- Add journaling
- Use 6E as base for bottom pocket insert
- Attach photos
- Insert 6A and 6E into Memory Protector

Layout 6: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 6F, 6G, 6H, and 6I
3. Attach photos
4. Attach prepared sun accents
Tip: Attach the sun's face accent with 3-D foam tape.
5. Embellish with star die-cuts

Prepare for both pages:

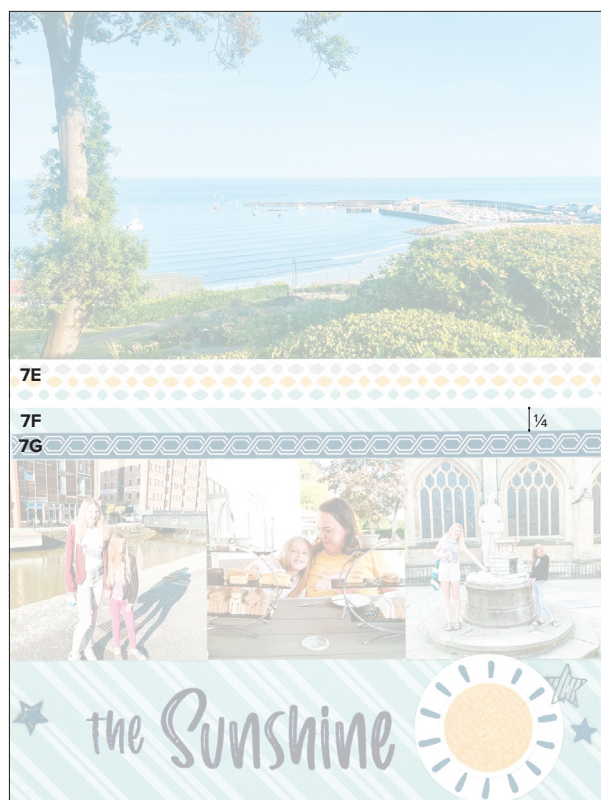
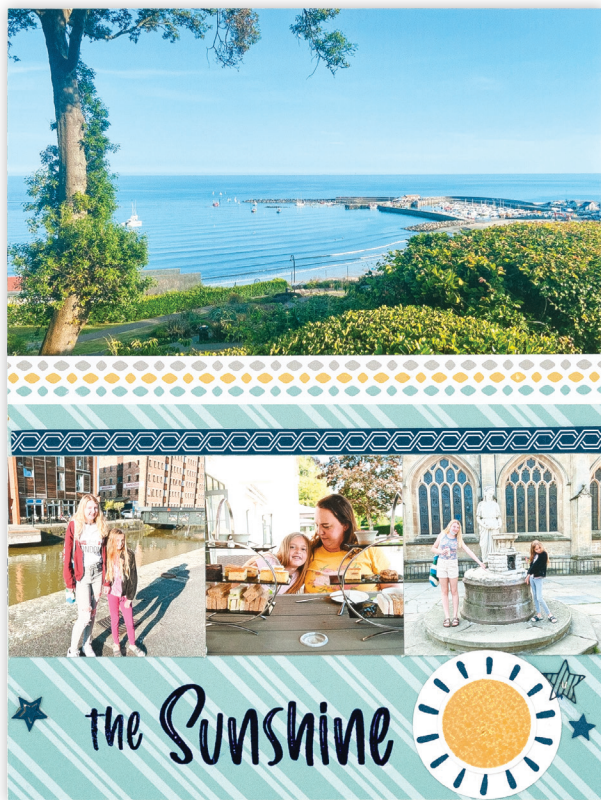
- Stamp long sunrays on left base page with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Stamp solid circles on left base page with Glacier ink, as shown
- Stamp small open circle and solid circle on 7C with Sapphire and Glacier inks, as shown
Tip: Use the masking technique.
Technique: Place masking tape, or a sticky note, as a mask to cover the area of 7C that you don't want stamped. Stamp the circles on 7C and the mask, and then remove the mask.
- Trim top corners of 7C, creating tag shape
- Draw lines on prepared 7C with a journaling pen and ruler
- Stamp "Be" on prepared 7C with Sapphire ink
- Stamp "the Sunshine" on 7F with Sapphire ink
- Stamp short sunrays on 1½" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sapphire ink
- Stamp solid circle on 1" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink



Assemble:

1. Use prepared Glacier diagonal stripe patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 7A and 7B
3. Embellish with star die-cuts
4. Attach photo
5. Attach 7D to prepared 7C
6. Add journaling to 7C
7. Attach prepared 7C with 3-D foam tape
8. Embellish with additional star die-cuts

Layout 7: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Attach 7E to top pocket photo
2. Use prepared 7F as base for bottom pocket insert
3. Attach 7G
4. Attach photos
5. Attach prepared sun accents
6. Embellish with star die-cuts
7. Insert prepared photo and 7F into Memory Protector

Layout 8: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

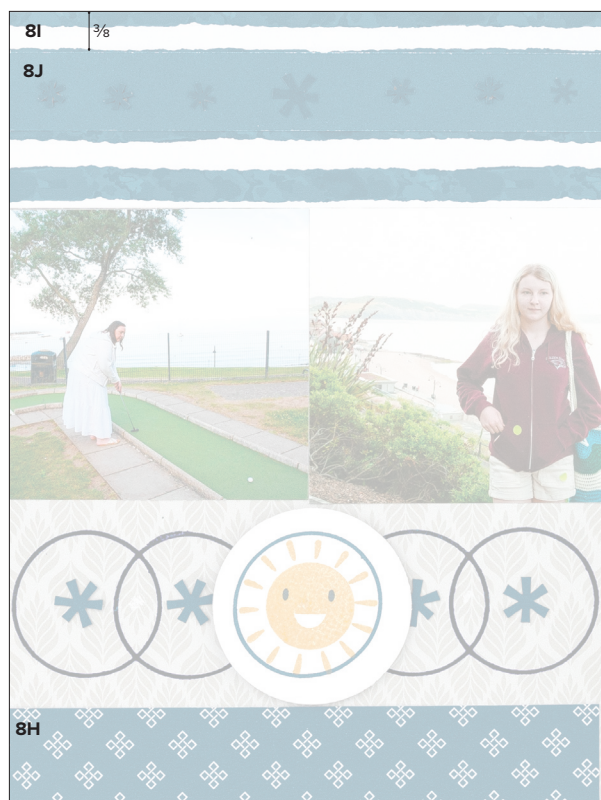
- Attach photo and 8B to 8A
- Stamp "Sunshine" on 8A with Sapphire, Glacier, and Sundance inks, as shown
Tips: Use the second-generation stamping technique for the lighter images.
Technique: Ink the stamp and stamp it on 8A. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 8A again. Repeat with each ink color.
- Stamp short sunrays and smiling circle on 2" White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp open eyes and large open circle on and around stamped sun with Sapphire ink, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use prepared 8A as base for top pocket insert
2. Embellish with star die-cuts
3. Use 8C as base for bottom pocket insert
4. Attach 8D, 8E, and 8F
5. Dovetail and attach 8G, as shown
6. Attach photo
7. Draw journaling lines on 8C with a journaling pen and ruler, as shown
8. Add journaling
9. Embellish with star die-cuts
10. Insert 8A and 8C into Memory Protector

Assemble:

1. Use Mink leaf patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 8H and 8I
3. Attach 8J
4. Attach photos
5. Stamp large open circles on base page with Sapphire ink, as shown
6. Embellish with star die-cuts
7. Attach prepared sun accent with 3-D foam tape

Layout 9: Left Page



Prepare for both pages:

- Dovetail and draw journaling lines on 9C with a journaling pen and a ruler, as shown
- Stamp "The Sun Will Rise Again" on prepared 9C with Toffee ink, as shown
- Stamp smiling circle on White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink
- Stamp shy eyes on stamped circle with Sapphire ink, as shown
- Stamp small open circle, large open circle, and short sunrays on 9F with Toffee ink, as shown
- Stamp "Create Your Own" on 9F with Sapphire ink, as shown
Tip: Curve and mount the "Create Your Own" stamp on the stamping block to achieve the shown effect.
- Stamp smile lines on 9F with Sundance ink, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use light Lagoon cardstock for base page
2. Attach 9A
3. Attach two 3" x 4" photos
4. Dovetail and attach 9B
5. Attach prepared 9C
6. Attach 9D and 9E
7. Attach remaining photos
8. Embellish with star die-cuts
9. Add journaling

Layout 9: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared 9F as base for bottom pocket insert
2. Attach 9G
3. Attach 9H
4. Attach 9I
5. Attach photo
6. Attach prepared sun face accent with 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with star die-cuts
8. Insert photo and 9F into Memory Protector

Closing Page:



Prepare:

- Stamp smiling circle and long and short solid sunrays on White Daisy cardstock die cut circle with Sundance ink, as shown
- Stamp open eyes on stamped sun accent with Sapphire ink, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use Closing Page A as base for top pocket insert
2. Attach photo
3. Attach prepared sun accent, as shown
4. Stamp "The Sun Will Rise Again" with Toffee ink, as shown
Tips: Curve and mount the stamp on the stamping block to achieve the shown effect. Use the masking technique. Technique: Place masking tape, or a sticky note, as a mask to cover the photo. Stamp the sentiment around the sun accent and the mask, and then remove the mask.
5. Embellish with star die-cuts
6. Attach Closing Page B and Closing Page C to bottom pocket photo, as shown
7. Insert Closing Page A and prepared photo into Memory Protector
