- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

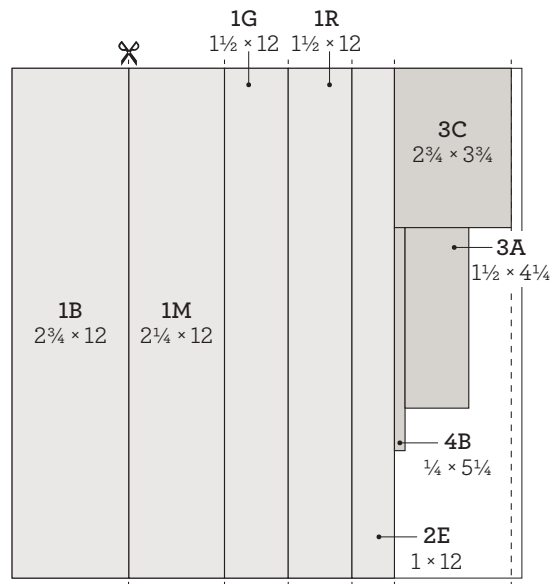

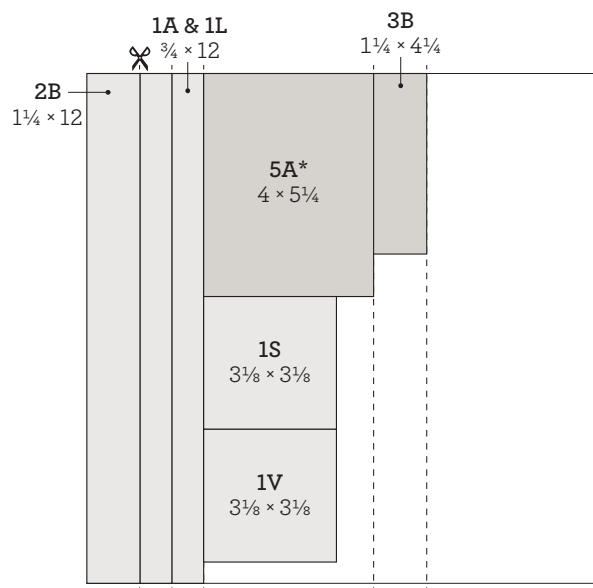


Sapphire cardstock

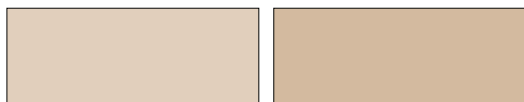

## Prepare:



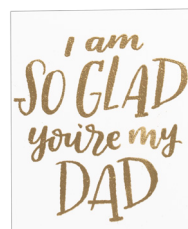
### 1A:

Paper: light Almond  
Inks: Almond, Sapphire  
Tip: Stamp stitch lines first.



### 1E:

Paper: White Daisy  
Inks: Almond, Toffee



### 1J:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: VersaMark™  
(with gold embossing powder)  
Tip: Heat emboss.  
Technique: Emboss the sentiment by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the craft heater until the powder and ink melt together.



### 1K:

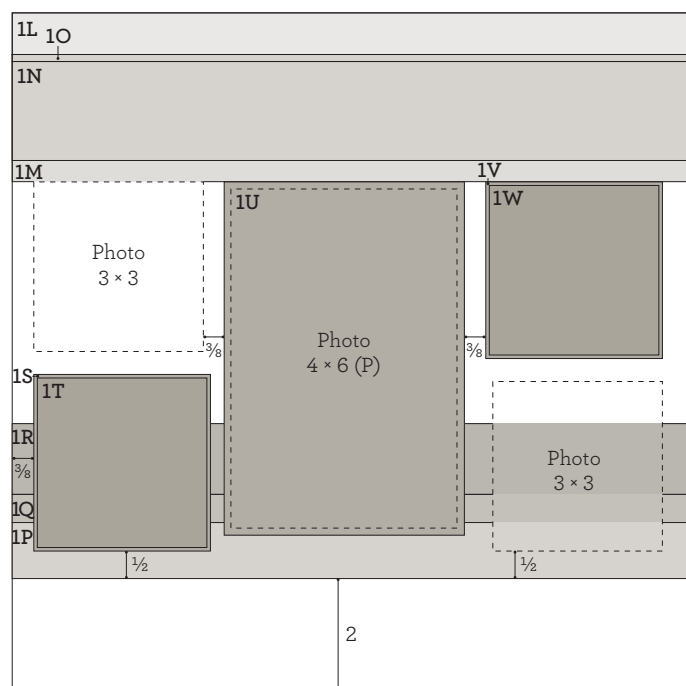
Paper: gold glitter  
Tip: Hand trim to form arrow.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach 1A
4. Tear one long edge of 1C
5. Attach 1C to 1B
6. Tear the long edge of 1B to mimic 1C
7. Attach 1B
8. Attach 1D to top of 1C
9. Attach 1E, 1F, and 1G
10. Attach 1H with thin 3-D foam tape
11. Attach 1J to 1I
12. Attach 1I with thin 3-D foam tape
13. Attach 1K to 1J with glue dot
14. Attach photo
15. Embellish with clip and ribbon

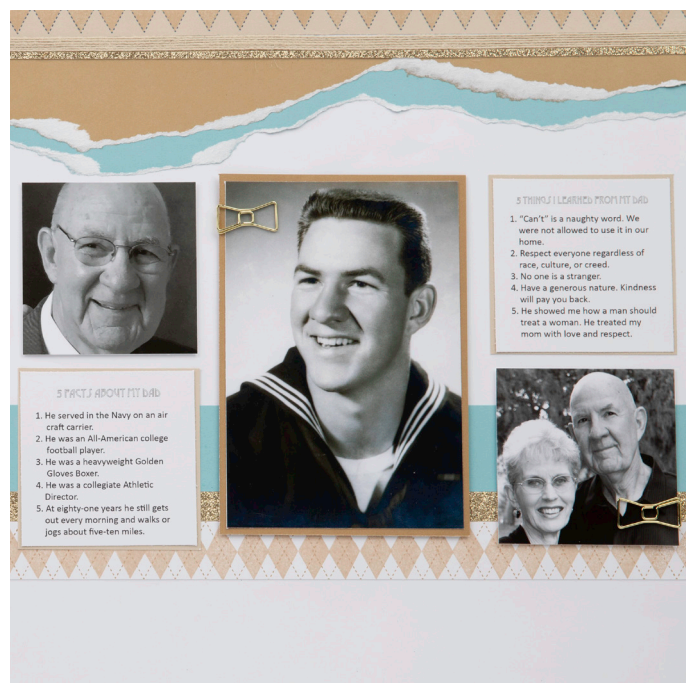

Inks: Almond, Sapphire  
Tip: Stamp stitch lines first.



### 1P:

Paper: White Daisy  
Inks: Almond, Toffee

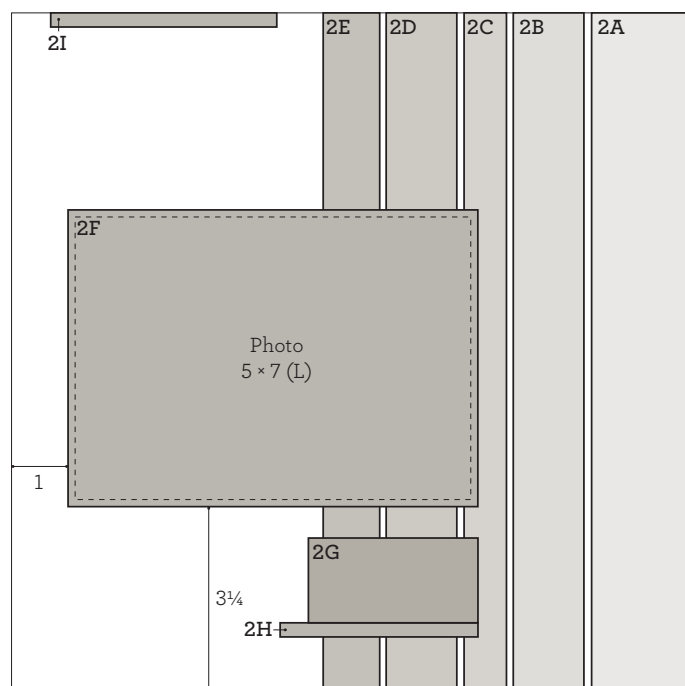


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach 1L
4. Tear one long edge of 1N
5. Attach 1N to 1M
6. Tear long edge of 1M to mimic 1N
7. Attach 1M
8. Attach 1O to top of 1N
9. Attach 1P, 1Q, and 1R
10. Attach 1T to 1S
11. Attach 1S
12. Attach 1U with thin 3-D foam tape
13. Attach 1W to 1V
14. Attach 1V
15. Attach photos
16. Embellish with clips and ribbon

## Prepare:



**2B:**  
Paper: light Almond  
Ink: Almond

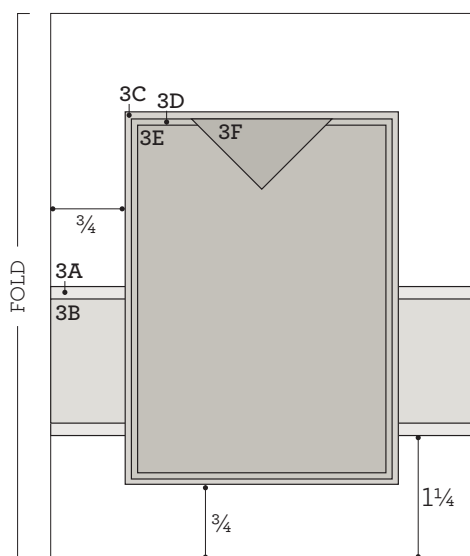
**2G:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Inks: Crystal Blue, Sapphire  
Tips: Create this watercolor wash look by using the back side of the "#1" stamp and the second-generation stamping technique.  
Technique: Ink stamp in Crystal Blue, stamp it on scratch paper, then without re-inking stamp on 2G.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E
4. Attach 2F
5. Dovetail left end of 2G
6. Attach 2H behind 2G, allowing 1/8" to show
7. Trim 2G to match dovetail
8. Attach 2G using thin 3-D foam tape
9. Stamp diamonds on top left using Sapphire, Crystal Blue, and Almond inks, as shown
10. Stamp "YOU'RE" above top left of photo using ombré stamping  
*Tip: Ink top half of stamp with Crystal Blue and bottom half with Sapphire, overlapping colors in the middle.*
11. Stamp two dots next to "YOU'RE" with Sapphire ink
12. Stamp asterisks using first- and second-generation images, as shown
13. Attach 2I
14. Embellish with ribbon  
*Tip: Tie a knot separately and attach it with a glue dot.*

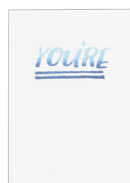

### Prepare:



**3B:**  
Paper: light Almond  
Inks: Almond, Sapphire, Toffee



**3E:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Inks: Crystal Blue, Sapphire  
Tip: Stamp  $\frac{3}{4}$ " from top using ombré stamping technique.  
Technique: Ink top half of "YOU'RE" with Crystal Blue and bottom half with Sapphire, overlapping colors in the middle.



Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: VersaMark™  
(with gold embossing powder)  
Tips: Heat emboss and hand trim.  
Technique: Emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the craft heater until the powder and ink melt together.

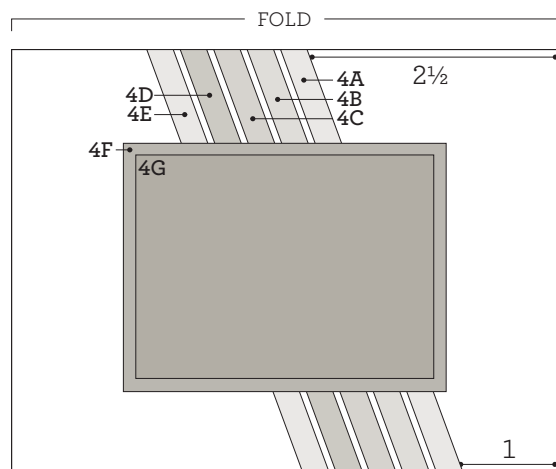
### Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3B to 3A
3. Attach 3A to card base
4. Stamp asterisks with Crystal Blue ink, as shown
5. Attach 3E to 3D with glue dots
6. Attach 3D to 3C
7. Attach 3C to card base with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach 3F with glue dot
9. Attach "#1" to 3E with thin 3-D foam tape

## Prepare:



### 4G:

Paper: White Daisy  
 Inks: Almond, Toffee, Sapphire  
 Tips: Stamp diamonds using second-generation stamping technique.  
 Stamp "Dad" using ombre stamping technique.  
 Techniques: Ink diamonds with Sapphire and stamp on scratch paper. Re-ink just the tips and stamp half the image, as shown. Ink top half of "Dad" with Almond and bottom half with Toffee, overlapping colors in the middle, then stamp on 4G.

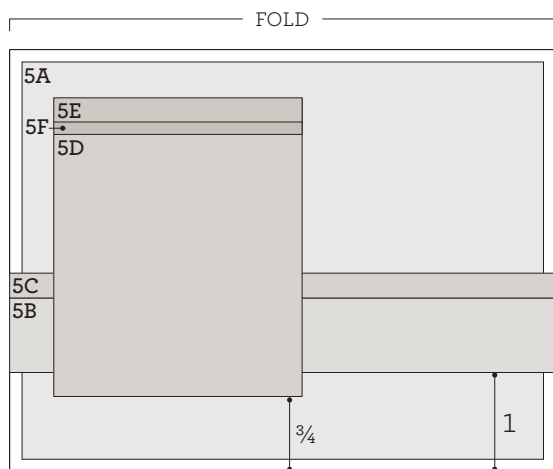


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
  2. Attach 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, and 4E to card base and trim edges
  3. Embellish with ribbon and trim edges
  4. Attach 4G to 4F
  5. Attach 4F with thin 3-D foam tape
  6. Embellish with clip
- Tip: Attach using gluedots.*

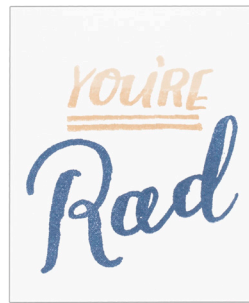

## Prepare:



### 5B:

Paper: light Sapphire  
Ink: Sapphire



### 5D:

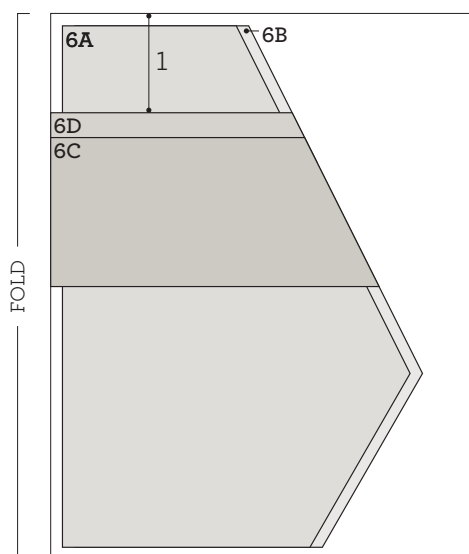
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Almond, Toffee, Sapphire  
Tip: Stamp "YOU'RE" using ombré stamping technique.  
Technique: Ink top half of "YOU'RE" with Almond and bottom half with Toffee, overlapping colors in the middle, then stamp on 5D.



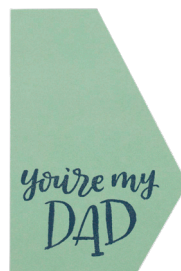
## Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 5A to card base
3. Attach 5B and 5C
4. Attach 5E and 5F to 5D
5. Attach 5D with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish with clip

## Prepare:



### 6A:

Paper: light Juniper

Ink: Sapphire

Tips: Mask off upper portion of stamp with a sticky note after inking.



### 6C:

Paper: Sapphire

Ink: VersaMark™

(with gold embossing powder)

Tip: Mask sentiment and heat emboss.

Technique: Emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the craft heater until the powder and ink melt together.



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 6B behind 6A with glue dots  
*Tip: Trim edge of 6B 1/8" from 6A as shown.*
3. Attach 6D behind 6C, allowing 1/4" to show
4. Attach 6C and 6D to 6A with thin 3-D foam tape  
*Tips: Leave 1/4" of 6C and 6D hanging over the left side of 6A. Trim the right side even with 6B.*
5. Attach 6A to card base  
*Tips: Create a 1/8" border between 6A and card base edges, as shown. Trim the left side of 6C and 6D.*
6. Heat emboss two gold dots next to 6C  
*Technique: Emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the craft heater until the powder and ink melt together.*
