## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are scrapbooking project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

Tips: Lightly draw pencil guidelines to die cut the butterflies. Once they are cut, erase the guidelines.


## Prepare:

- Lightly draw guidelines with a pencil and ruler, at 6 " and $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom of 1C, then stamp "I am BEAUTIFUL" with Blue Belle ink along guidelines, as shown. Erase guidelines once ink is completely dry.


## Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Use ombré watercolor wash paper for base page
3. Attach 1 A and 1 B

Tip: $1 B$ is centered on $1 A$ and will be behind $1 C$.
4. Attach prepared 1C, on top of 1B, with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 1D and 1E
6. Attach pennant stickers, as shown

Tip: Lay 7F and 1G on layout to help with the placement of the stickers.
7. Attach 1 F and 1 G with thin 3-D foam tape

Tip: Only use foam tape on the sides of these pieces that are not on top of 1C. Use regular adhesive for the rest.
8. Attach photos
9. Attach butterfly accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
10. Embellish with sequins
11. Add journaling


## Prepare (for both pages):

- Assemble layered butterfly accents, as shown Tip: Only use adhesive along the center of the butterflies so the wings can be bent up for added dimension.
- Stamp Ballerina cardstock butterfly accents with Sangria ink, as shown
Tips: Stamp the solid base first, using the second-generation stamping technique. Then, stamp the wings.
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sangria and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the accent.
- Stamp flower vine on 21 with Sangria ink, as shown


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use Blue Belle and Sapphire watercolor wash paper for base page
3. Attach 2A
4. Attach 2B and 2C
5. Attach 2D with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photo
7. Attach title stickers, as shown
8. Stamp "you are WONDERFUL" on 2B with Sangria ink, as shown
9. Attach prepared butterfly accents with thin 3-D foam tape Tip: With your fingers, gently pull up on the wings of the layered butterflies for added dimension.
10. Embellish with circle stickers, as shown Tip: Attach "today" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape.
11. Embellish with sequins


## Assemble:

1. Use Blue Belle and Sapphire watercolor wash paper for base page
2. Attach 2 E
3. Attach 2 F and 2 G
4. Attach 2 H with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach 21
6. Attach photos
7. Attach prepared butterfly accents with thin 3-D foam tape Tip: With your fingers, gently pull up on the wings of the layered butterfly for added dimension.
8. Embellish with sequins
9. Add journaling

## Prepare (for both pages):



- Stamp butterflies on Peach cardstock accents with Sangria ink, as shown
Tips: Stamp the solid base first, using the second-generation stamping technique. Then, stamp the wings.
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sangria and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the accent.
- Stamp geometric star shape on White Daisy cardstock accent with Blue Belle ink, as shown


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach 3A
4. Attach 3B, 3C, and 3D
5. Attach 3E and 3F with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers and prepared butterfly accents, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Embellish with sequins


## Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3G
3. Attach $3 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{I}$, and 3 J
4. Attach 3 K and 3 L with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photos
6. Lightly draw a vertical guideline on the base page, $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ from left edge, with a pencil and ruler
7. Stamp "you are BEAUTIFUL STRONG ENOUGH BRAVE WONDERFUL" along guideline with Sangria, Blue Belle, and Sapphire inks, as shown
Tip: Use the second-generation stamping technique to stamp the word "STRONG."
Technique: Ink the stamp in Sangria and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on page.
8. Embellish with stickers and prepared die-cut accents, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Embellish with sequins
10. Add journaling


- Stamp gems on light Glacier cardstock accents with Sapphire ink
- Tear approx. $1 / 2$ " off $4 \mathrm{E}, 4 \mathrm{~F}, 4 \mathrm{G}, 4 \mathrm{M}, 4 \mathrm{~N}$, and 4 O , as shown


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use hexagon paper for base page
3. Attach 4A
4. Attach $4 \mathrm{~B}, 4 \mathrm{C}$, and 4 D
5. Attach prepared $4 \mathrm{E}, 4 \mathrm{~F}$, and 4 G

Tip: The top, untorn edges of each of these will touch 4C.
6. Attach 4 H
7. Attach photo with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach title stickers, as shown
9. Embellish with additional stickers and prepared gem accents Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Embellish with sequins


Assemble:

1. Use hexagon paper for base page
2. Attach 41
3. Attach $4 \mathrm{~J}, 4 \mathrm{~K}$, and 4 L
4. Attach prepared $4 \mathrm{M}, 4 \mathrm{~N}$, and 4 O

Tip: The top, untorn edges of each of these will touch $4 K$.
5. Attach 4P, 4Q, and 4R
6. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with stickers and prepared gem accents Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Embellish with sequins
9. Add journaling


## Assemble:

1. Use Sangria word paper for base page
2. Attach 5A
3. Attach 5B and 5C
4. Attach 5 D on top of 5 C

Tip: Trim the excess hanging off the page with scissors.
5. Attach 5E with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photos

Tip: Attach $4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ photo with thin 3-D foam tape.
7. Attach title sticker, as shown
8. Embellish with additional stickers and butterfly accents Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Embellish with sequins


## Assemble:

1. Use Sangria word paper for base page
2. Attach 5F
3. Attach 5 G and 5 H
4. Attach 5 I on top of 5 H

Tip: Trim the excess hanging off the page with scissors.
5. Dovetail and attach 5 J
6. Attach 5 K with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach photos

Tip: Attach $4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ photo with thin 3-D foam tape.
8. Embellish with stickers and butterfly accent

Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Embellish with sequins
10. Add journaling
