Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.

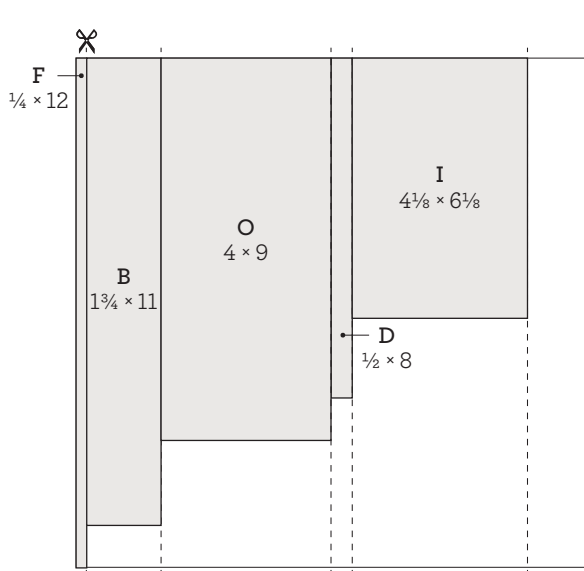

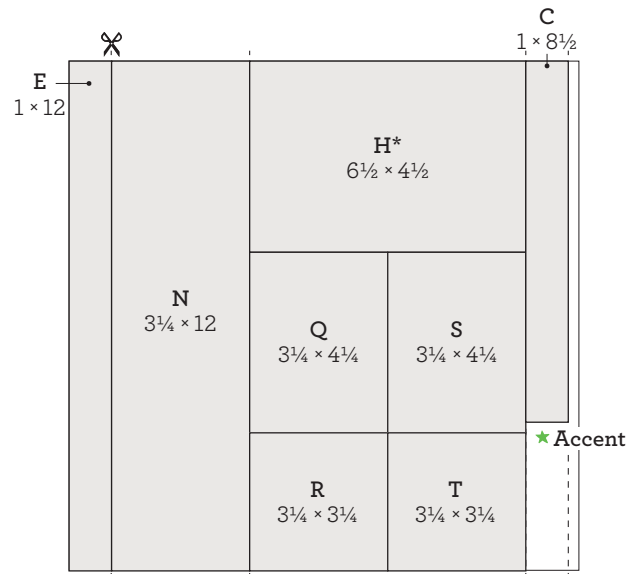

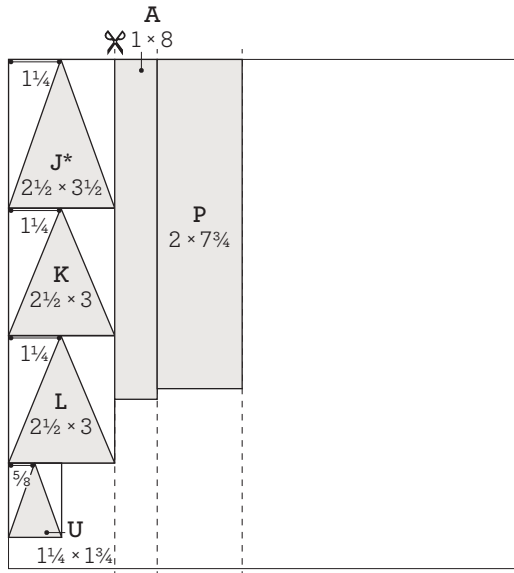

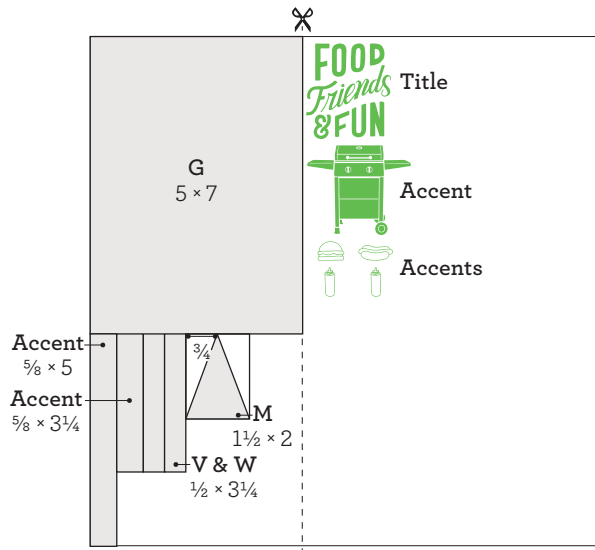

Tip: To cut a triangle, first cut a rectangle the size indicated under the letter label. Then, use the measurement provided to find where the top point of the triangle should be and mark it with a pencil. With your paper trimmer, cut from the bottom corners of the piece to this pencil mark.

Tip: Draw stitch line with a journaling pen.

Accent (5):

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Sapphire
Tips: Use a 1 x 3½ block to line up the stamped images with more ease. Lay the cardstock vertically and stamp down the piece, from top to bottom.

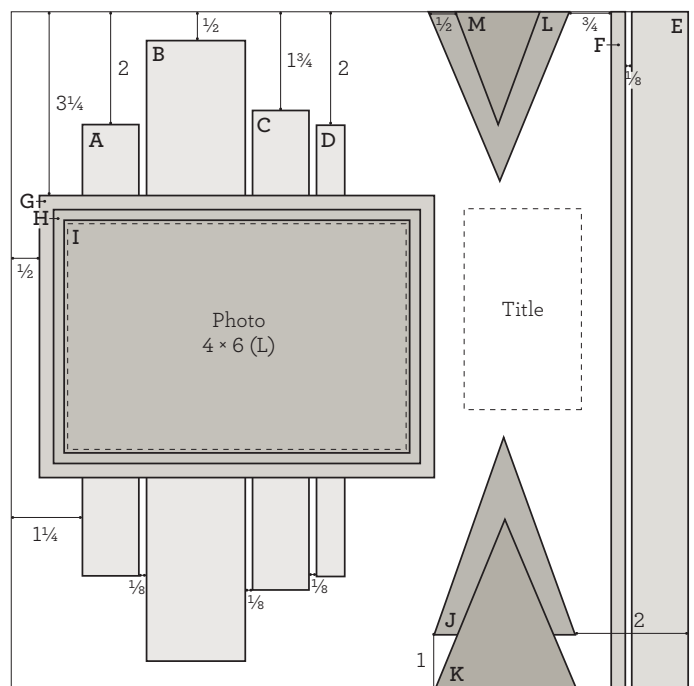

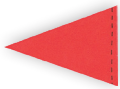


Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach A, B, C, D, E, and F
4. Draw stitch lines next to A and D with a journaling pen, as shown
5. Attach G, H, and I
6. Attach photo thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach J
8. Attach K with thin 3-D foam tape

9. Attach L and M
10. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape
11. Stamp utensils with Candy Apple ink above title, as shown
12. Stamp star with Sapphire ink on utensils, as shown
13. Attach border accent above photo, as shown
14. Embellish with ribbon
Tip: Attach with a glue dot.

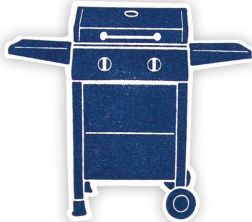

Paper: light Candy Apple
Tip: Draw stitch line with a journaling pen.



Accent (3 1/4):
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Sapphire
Tips: Use a 1 x 3 1/2 block to line up the stamped images with more ease. Lay the cardstock vertically and stamp down the piece, from top to bottom.

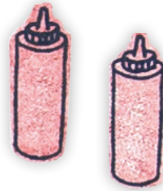

Ink: Sapphire
Tip: Hand trim.

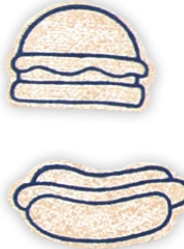

Tip: Hand trim.

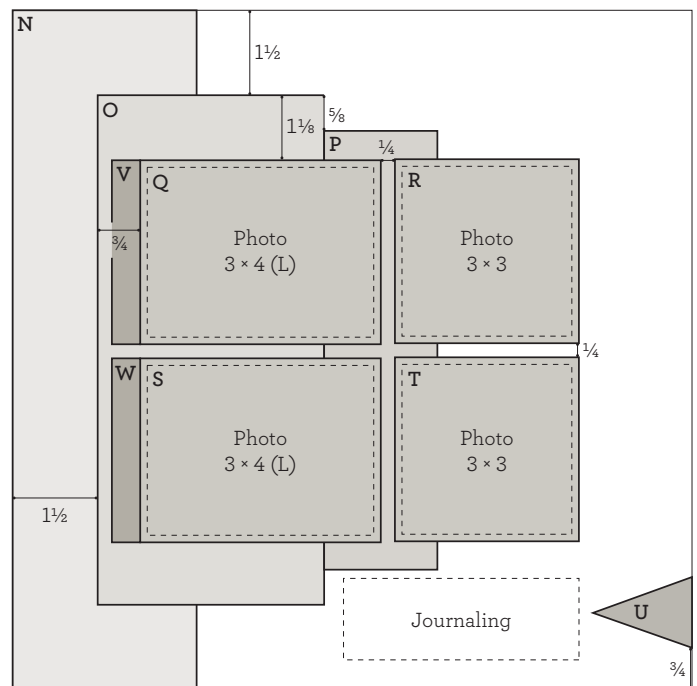
Prepare:



Accents:
Paper: White daisy
Inks: Candy Apple, Sapphire
Tips: Stamp ketchup bottle outlines with Sapphire ink. Then, turn the stamp over and use the back to stamp solid color with Candy Apple ink, using second-generation stamping. Hand trim.
Technique: Ink the back of the stamp in Candy Apple and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the Sapphire outline. (Repeat for second bottle image.)



Accents:
Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Almond, Sapphire
Tips: Stamp hamburger and hot dog outlines with Sapphire ink. Then, turn the stamps over and use the backs to stamp solid color with Almond ink, using second-generation stamping. Hand trim.
Technique: Ink the back of the stamp in Almond and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on the Sapphire outline. (Repeat for second image.)



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
3. Attach N, O, and P
4. Draw stitch lines next to N with a journaling pen, as shown
5. Attach Q, R, S, and T
6. Attach photos
7. Attach U, V, and W
8. Draw journaling lines below bottom right photo with a journaling pen, as shown
Tip: Draw first line approximately 1" from the bottom.
9. Attach grill accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown

10. Attach remaining accents, as shown
11. Stamp "&" with Sapphire ink next to journaling lines, as shown
12. Stamp burst with Candy Apple ink below "&," as shown
13. Embellish with ribbon
Tip: Attach with a glue dot.
14. Add journaling
