

Getting Started:

- · Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- · Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.

D: Paper: White Daisy Ink: Peach

E: Paper: Linen Ink: Mink Tip: Use "If we know..." stamp.



Assemble:

- 1. Prepare pieces shown above
- 2. Use light Linen cardstock for base page
- 3. Attach A, B, C, D, E, and F
- 4. Embellish with ribbon above B *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
- 5. Stamp "forever" with Sapphire ink on base page, between ribbon and C, as shown
- 6. Stamp clamshell with Mink ink on base page, between C and D, as shown
- 7. Stamp the script paragraph with Mink ink above right side of D, as shown
 - Tip: Stamp a total of four times, slightly overlapping images
- 8. Tear ¼ off each edge of G and H, as shown, and attach
 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner of G so it can
 be lifted up to stamp behind it in a later step.
- 9. Stamp script paragraph with Mink ink behind the top left corner of G, as shown
- 10. Stamp decorative corner scroll with Mink ink next to H, as shown
- 11. Stamp "Memories" with Sapphire, as shown
- 12. Stamp roses with Sapphire ink, as shown

 Tip: Use second-generation stamping technique.

 Technique: Ink stamp in Sapphire and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on base page.
- 13. Stamp watch with Mink ink, as shown
- 14. Attach photos to I and J $\,$
- 15. Attach I with thin 3-D foam tape
- 16. Attach J

 Tip: Tuck slightly behind I, as shown.

- 1. Prepare pieces shown above
- 2. Use light Linen cardstock for base page
- 3. Attach K, L, M, N, O, and P
- 4. Embellish with ribbon above L *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
- 5. Stamp "forever" with Sapphire ink on base page, between ribbon and M, as shown
- 6. Stamp the clamshell with Mink ink on base page, between M and N, as shown
- Stamp the script paragraph with Mink ink above left side of N, as shown
 - Tip: Stamp a total of four times, slightly overlapping images.
- 8. Tear ¼ off each edge of Q and R, as shown, and attach
 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner of R or the top
 right corner of Q so they can be lifted up to stamp behind them
 in later steps.
- 9. Stamp the script paragraph with Mink ink under top right corner of Q, as shown
- 10. Stamp Linda Hogan quote in Mink ink above R, as shown
- 11. Stamp bird in Sapphire ink slightly behind R, as shown Tip: Use second-generation stamping technique.

 Technique: Ink stamp in Sapphire and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on page.
- 12. Attach photo to S
- 13. Attach S with thin 3-D foam tape

 Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of S so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- Stamp decorative corner scroll with Mink ink next to S, as shown
- 15. Attach U to T
- 16. Add journaling to U
- 17. Attach T to page Tip: Tuck slightly behind S.
- 18. Attach "remember" accent with thin 3-D foam tape
- 19. Attach tassel accent
