## Getting Started:

- Gather all additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

■ = suggested stamp arrangement | ■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement




P2 Accent:  $2 \times \frac{1}{2}$  (cut 6)






## Project 1: Make 6



## Prepare (6 each):



**1B:**  
Paper: light Raspberry  
Ink: Raspberry



**1E:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Raspberry  
Tip: Dovetail ends.



**1F:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Raspberry  
Tip: Lightly sponge edge with ink.



**Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Raspberry  
Tips: Use second-generation stamping, and rock & roll stamping techniques.  
Hand trim.  
Technique: Ink stamp in Raspberry and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, gently roll the bottom of the stamp back onto the Raspberry pad, and stamp.



**Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Pewter  
Tips: Use second-generation stamping.  
Hand trim.  
Technique: Ink stamp in Pewter and stamp it on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp onto White Daisy.




**Accent:**  
Paper: pink stripes  
Ink: Pewter  
Tip: Hand trim.

## Assemble:


1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A to card base
3. Attach 1B
4. Attach 1C, 1D, and 1E
5. Attach 1F with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach cone and ice cream scoop accents
7. Attach banner accent with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Embellish with gems



## Project 2: Make 6



## Prepare (6 each):



### 2B:

Paper: White Daisy

Ink: Raspberry

Tip: Stamp sentiment  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom.



### Card Base:

Paper: card base

Inks: Lemon, Willow

Tips: Stamp pineapples in different directions, including some off the edges. Use second-generation stamping technique for leaves.

Technique: Ink leaves in Willow and stamp them on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp onto card base.



### Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Lemon, Willow

Tip: Hand trim.



### Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Ink: Raspberry

Tip: Hand trim.



### Accent:

Paper: pink stripes

Ink: Pewter

Tip: Hand trim.



### Accent:

Paper: Willow stripes

Tip: Tear ends.

## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A to card base
3. Attach 2B
4. Attach 2C with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach pineapple accent with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach heart accent with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach banner accent
8. Attach zip strip accent
9. Embellish with gems
