## Getting Started:

- Gather all additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

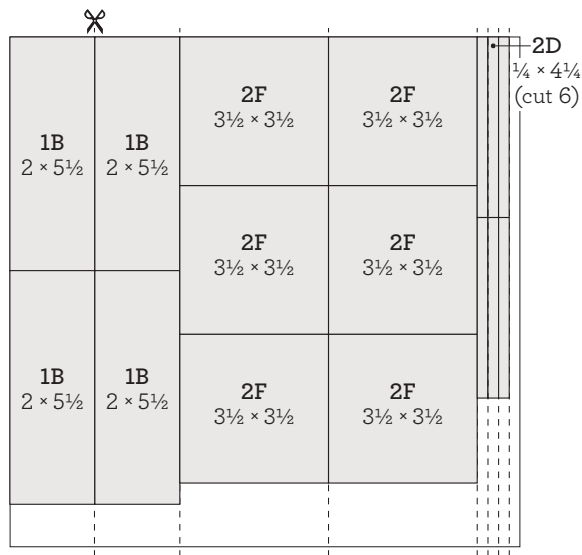

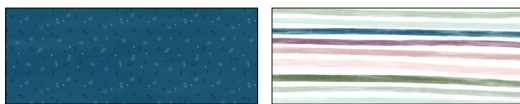

2B & 2C:  $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$  (cut 12)

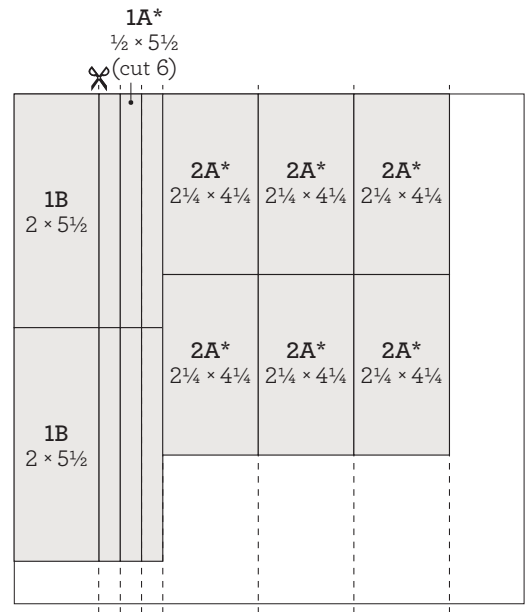

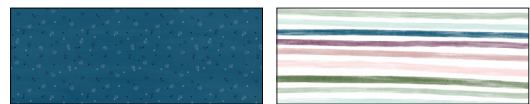

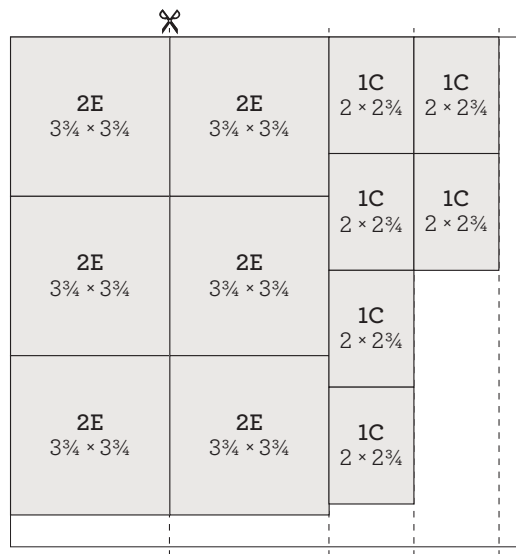

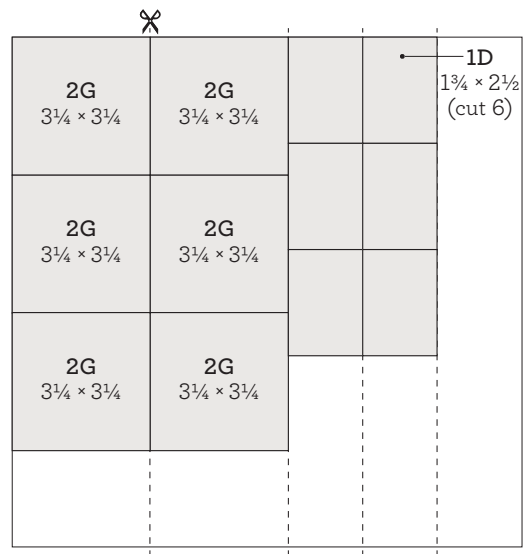

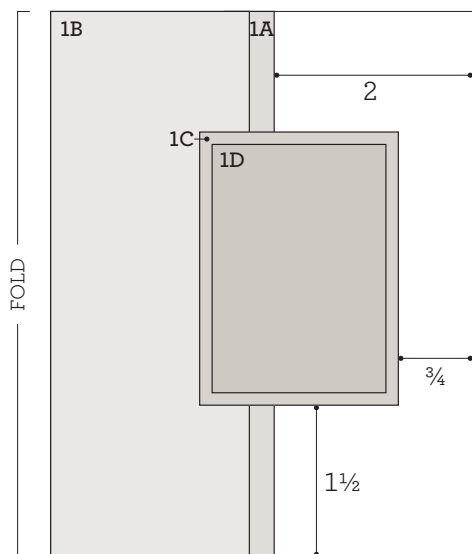

## Project 1: Make 6

## Prepare (6 each):



### Card Base:

Paper: card base

Inks: Eggplant, New England Ivy

Tips: Lightly draw a line with a pencil, 2" from the right edge. Use this line to create a stamped scalloped border. Stamp the leaves using third-generation stamping. Erase the pencil line once the ink is dry.

Technique: Ink stamp in New England Ivy and stamp it twice on a scratch piece of paper. Then, without re-inking, stamp on card base.



### 1D:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Eggplant, New England Ivy, Sapphire



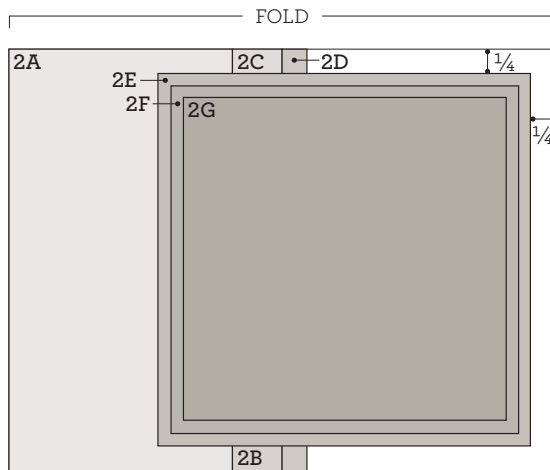
## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A to card base
3. Attach 1B

*Tip: The right side of 1B will overlap part of 1A.*

4. Attach 1D to 1C
5. Attach 1C with 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish with sequins

*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

**2G:**

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Eggplant, Intense Black,

New England Ivy, Sapphire

Tips: Stamp wreath with Intense Black and sentiment with Sapphire. Add color using stamp pad painting technique with Eggplant and New England Ivy inks.

Technique: Squeeze closed stamp pad in center to transfer some ink to the inside lid. Open the pad and use the inked lid as a tray to paint from.

**Assemble:**

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 2A to card base
3. Attach 2B, 2C, and 2D
4. Attach 2F to 2E
5. Attach 2G to 2F with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach 2E
7. Embellish with sequins  
*Tip: Attach with glue dots.*
