## Getting Started:

- Gather all additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ accent paper along the top of each sheet.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Heather, Mink, New England Ivy, Sapphire
Tip: Use second-generation and gradient stamping for "CONGRATS!"
Technique: Ink stamp in Heather and stamp top "CONGRATS!" Then, without re-inking, stamp the middle "CONGRATS!" Stamp the bottom "CONGRATS!" in Mink.


## P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy Ink: New England Ivy Tip: Hand trim.


## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1B, 1C, 1D, and 1E to 1A
3. Embellish 1A with twine Tip: Secure knot and ends with glue dots.
4. Attach 1A to card base
5. Attach arrow accent with thin 3-D foam tape
