Additional Materials Needed:

Z3132 Watercolor Paints (optional)

Z3224 Waterbrush—Small Round (optional)

Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape

Z2089 Glue Dots® Micro Dots

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Punch out all die-cuts and sort by project.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

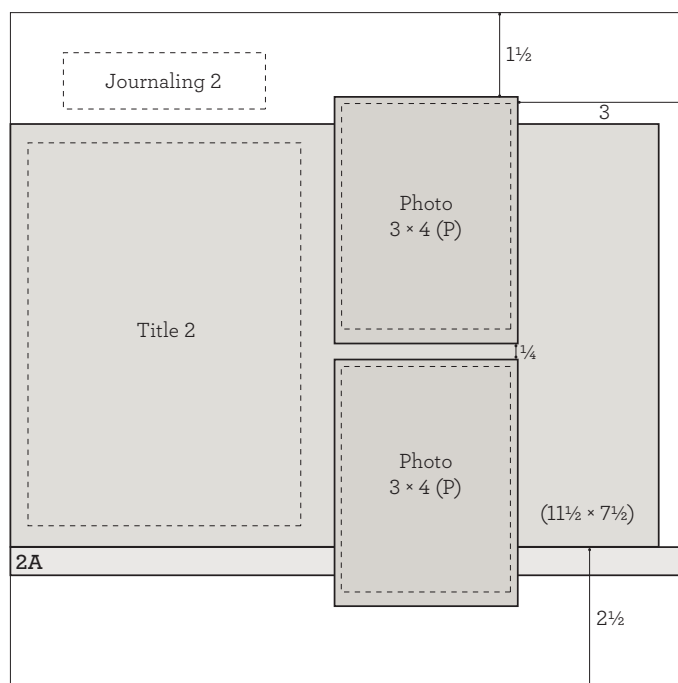
Project 1



Assemble:

1. Use Julep striped paper for base page
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach large scalloped circle die-cut
Tips: Center on page, 1 1/4" from all sides. Be sure to position the splatters as shown.
4. Attach 1B and 1C
Tip: Only use adhesive in center of 1B so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photos
6. Attach title, as shown
7. Attach sprig die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tips: Tuck ends behind 1B, as shown. For added dimension, only use adhesive along the bottom part of the sprig die-cuts and gently lift some of the leaves up with your fingers.
8. Assemble butterflies using die-cuts, as shown, and attach to project with thin 3-D foam tape
Tips: Layer the corresponding butterfly shapes and attach each layer with thin 3-D foam tape. For added dimension, use foam tape only in the center of the butterflies and gently lift the wings up with your fingers.
9. Attach 1D
10. Attach tab die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
11. Attach journaling strips
12. Attach acrylic butterflies (3) with glue dots, as shown
13. Embellish with sparkles
14. (Optional) Add watercolor to wings of white butterfly centers
15. Add journaling

Project 2



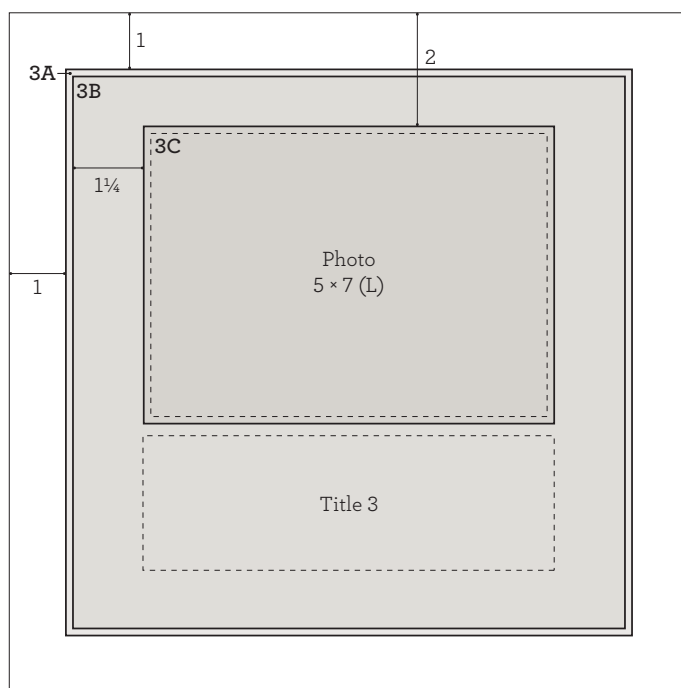
Assemble:

1. Use Evergreen dotted circle paper for base page
2. Attach large multi-stripe die-cut
3. Attach 2A
4. Attach photo mat die-cuts
5. Attach photos
6. Attach journaling, sprig, and rose die-cuts, as shown
7. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Attach stickers, as shown

Tip: The stickers on this project are the remaining images that are not butterflies.
9. Attach all butterfly die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown

Tips: Before attaching the ones on the right side, position the butterflies first to make sure they are all in their correct space. For added dimension, use foam tape only in the center of the butterflies and gently lift the wings up with your fingers.
10. Attach acrylic butterflies (2) with glue dots, as shown
11. Embellish with sparkles
12. (Optional) Add small amount of watercolor to wings of white butterfly centers
13. Add journaling

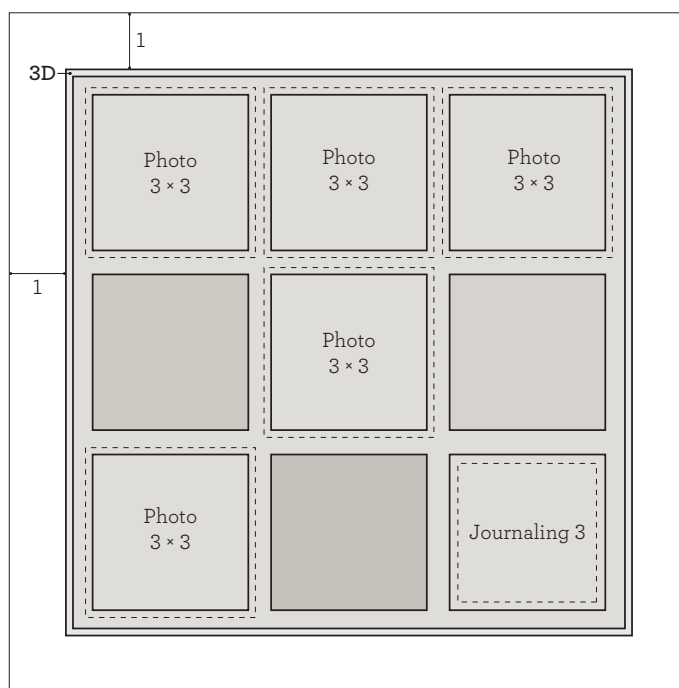
Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use floral paper for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. (Optional) Add watercolor wash to top half of 3B, as shown
4. Attach 3C
5. Attach photo
6. Attach "happy" and leaf die-cuts
7. Attach stickers, as shown
8. Attach "TODAY" die-cut behind "TODAY" acrylic shape with glue dots
Tip: Use glue dots to attach the centers of the acrylic "O," "D," and "A" to the paper die-cut.
9. Attach title
10. Embellish with sparkles

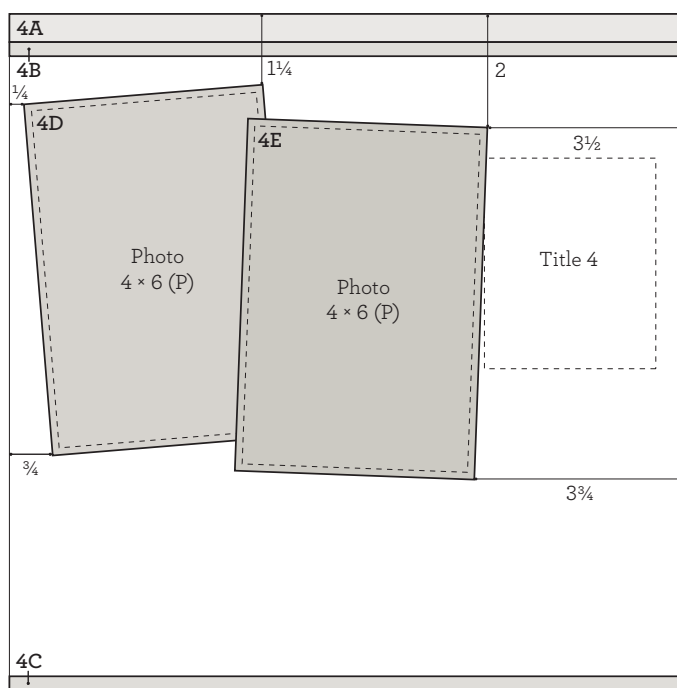
Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use floral paper for base page
2. Attach 3D
3. Attach patterned die-cuts and photos to back of large frame die-cut
Tip: Lay out all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching.
4. Attach large frame die-cut to 3D
5. Attach small triangle die-cuts to a photo, as shown
6. (Optional) Add watercolor wash to journaling square, on "details," as shown
7. Attach stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach butterfly sticker with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Attach acrylic butterflies (2) with glue dots, as shown
9. Embellish with sparkles
10. Add journaling

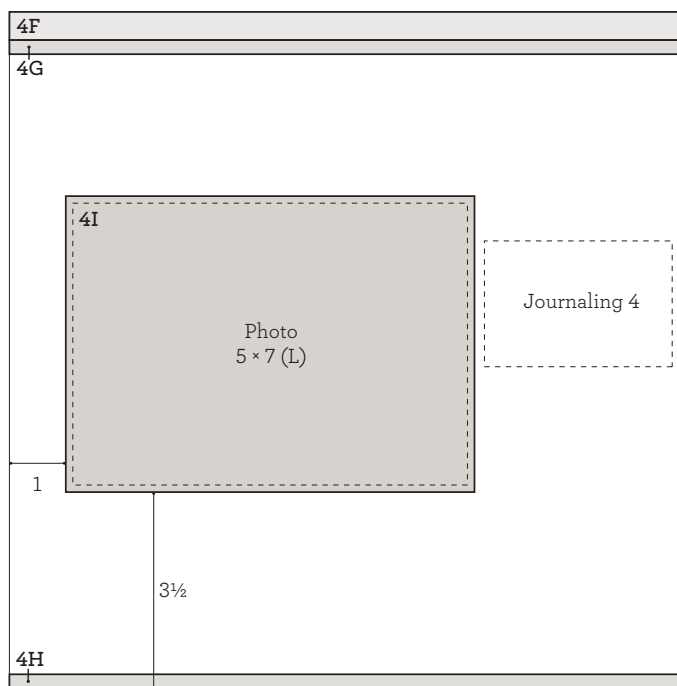
Project 4: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use Mint watercolor wash paper for base page
2. Attach 4A, 4B, and 4C
3. Attach half circle die-cuts to back of scalloped die-cuts
Tips: Lay out all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching.
4. Attach scalloped die-cuts to base page, as shown
5. Attach 4D
6. Attach photo to 4D
7. Attach 4E
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right side of 4D so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
8. Attach photo to 4E
9. Attach title
10. Attach stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach some stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. (Optional) Add watercolor to leaves on large floral sticker
12. Attach acrylic butterflies (2) with glue dots, as shown
13. Embellish with sparkles

Project 4: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Mint watercolor wash paper for base page
2. Attach 4F, 4G, and 4H to base page
3. Attach 4I with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Attach photo
5. Attach half circle die-cuts to back of scalloped die-cuts
Tips: Lay out all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching.
6. Attach scalloped die-cuts to base page, as shown
7. Attach flower and sprigs die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Attach stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach bird sticker with thin 3-D foam tape.
9. Attach journaling strip die-cuts
10. Embellish with sparkles
11. Attach acrylic butterfly (1) with glue dots
12. (Optional) Add watercolor to leaves on sprigs die-cut
13. Add journaling
