## **Getting Started:**


- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Punch out all die-cuts and sort by project.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

🛠 = first cut | \* = use back of paper

## **Cutting Diagrams:**


### zip strips



pencil mark along the top and bottom, 2" from the right edge. Make another light pencil mark along the right edge, 6" from the top. Cut the paper on a diagonal, from each 2"


mark to the 6" mark. Repeat for 3F.




Tip: To cut 3B, first cut a 7" × 12" rectangle. Make a light pencil mark along the top and bottom, 2" from the right edge. Make another light pencil mark along the right edge, 6" from the top. Cut the paper on a diagonal, from each 2" mark to the 6" mark. Repeat for 3G.







Tip: To cut 1A make a light pencil mark along the right edge of the 12" × 12" paper, ¾" from the top. Make another light pencil mark along the left edge, 4" from the bottom. Cut the paper on a diagonal, connecting the two marks.





#### Project 1



#### Assemble:

- 1. Use Sage chevron paper for base page
- 2. Attach hexagon die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach the first piece along the left edge, 4¼" from the bottom. Cut the French Vanilla with Saffron borderlines sticker in half before attaching and use both halves separately, as shown. For added dimension, layer the smaller hexagon die-cuts on top and attach with thin 3-D foam tape.
- 3. (Optional) Sponge stitched edges of leather flap die-cut with Toffee ink

Technique: Rub the sponge on the stamp pad to load it with ink. Then, lightly rub the edges of the die-cut with the sponge until the desired color is achieved.

- Fold leather flap die-cut on score line and attach to 1A, as shown Tip: Attach the large part of the flap that overlaps the front of
- 1A with thin 3-D foam tape.
- 5. Attach 1A to base page
- 6. Attach 1B with thin 3-D foam tape
- 7. Attach "life is good" chipboard die-cut, as shown
- 8. Attach photo
- 9. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape
- 10. Attach arrow die-cuts next to title, as shown
- 11. Attach colored leaf die-cuts behind French Vanilla cutout leaf die-cuts, as shown
- 12. Attach die-cut, chipboard, and sticker leaves in a cluster, as shown

Tip: Attach some leaves with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

- 13. (Optional) Draw journaling lines with a journaling pen on leather flap die-cut, as shown
- 14. Add journaling

#### Project 2



#### Assemble:


- 1. Use Sage chevron paper for base page
- 2. Attach 2A
- 3. Attach corrugated cardboard sticker next to 2A, as shown
- 4. Attach 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E behind large frame die-cut, as shown
- 5. Attach tab die-cut behind "back to" on large frame die-cut
- 6. Attach large frame die-cut to base page


Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left side of the large square, or along the right side of the middle square, so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.

- 7. Attach photos
- 8. (Optional) Sponge edges of brown journaling square die-cut with Toffee ink

Technique: Rub the sponge on the stamp pad to load it with ink. Then, lightly rub the edges of the die-cut with the sponge until the desired color is achieved.

- 9. Attach journaling square die-cut
- 10. Attach hexagon die-cuts slightly behind large die-cut frame, as shown
- 11. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape
- 12. (Optional) Sponge edges of "12345" chipboard die-cut with Toffee ink
- 13. Embellish with chipboard die-cuts, as shown Tip: Attach numbers and stars with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 14. Embellish with stickers, as shown
- 15. Attach zip strip accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
- Embellish with wood shapes, as shown Tip: Attach with glue dots.
- 17. Add journaling





# Prepare (Optional):


Sponge all wooden leaves (3) with Toffee ink and set aside to dry. Technique: Rub the sponge on the stamp pad to load it with ink. Then, lightly rub the wood shapes with the sponge until the desired color is achieved.

## Assemble:

- 1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3A
- 3. Attach 3B
- 4. Attach stitched chevron die-cut, as shown
- 5. Attach 3C
- 6. Attach Saffron border sticker, as shown
- 7. Attach 3D and 3E Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 3E so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 8. Attach photos
- 9. Attach half circle die-cut slightly behind 3E, as shown
- 10. Attach Charcoal banner die-cut, 1¾" from right edge
- 11. Attach Paprika banner die-cut, as shown
- 12. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape
- 13. Attach colored leaf die-cuts behind French Vanilla cutout leaf die-cuts, as shown
- 14. Attach all leaves, as shown *Tips: Attach the wooden leaves (2) with glue dots. Attach some of the remaining leaves with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 15. Attach "cherish this" chipboard die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
- Embellish with stickers Tip: Attach some stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

## **Project 3: Right Page**





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 3F, 1¼" from bottom
- 3. Attach 3G
- 4. Attach stitched chevron die-cut, as shown
- 5. Attach 3H
- *Tip: Do not use adhesive along the edges of 3H so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- 6. Attach photo
- 7. Attach 3I
- 8. Attach banner die-cuts, as shown
- 9. Attach colored leaf die-cuts behind French Vanilla cutout leaf die-cuts, as shown
- 10. Attach all leaves, as shown
  - Tips: Tuck a couple leaves slightly behind 3H. Attach the wooden leaf (1) with glue dots. Attach some of the remaining leaves with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 11. Embellish with acorn sticker, as shown
- 12. Embellish with chipboard die-cuts, as shown Tip: Attach with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 13. Add journaling

## Project 4: Left Page



#### Assemble:


- 1. Use light Pebble cardstock for base page
- 2. (Optional) Sponge Pebble ink on upper left side of base page, as shown

Technique: Rub the sponge on the stamp pad to load it with ink. Then, lightly rub the cardstock with the sponge until the desired color is achieved.

- 3. Attach background hexagon die-cuts, as shown Tip: Layout all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching. Attach the top right corner first and build your background from there.
- 4. Attach 4A and 4B with thin 3-D foam tape
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Attach small pebble hexagon die-cuts to wood pattern hexagon die-cuts, as shown
- 7. Attach small layered hexagon die-cuts to page with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
- 8. Embellish with stickers and chipboard die-cuts, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## Project 4: Right Page





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use light Pebble cardstock for base page
- 2. (Optional) Sponge Pebble ink on base page, where the title will go
- 3. Attach background hexagon die-cuts, as shown Tip: Layout all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching. Attach the top left corner first and build your background from there.
- 4. Attach 4C with thin 3-D foam tape
- 5. Attach photo
- 6. Attach 4D
- 7. Attach small Pebble hexagon die-cut to wood pattern hexagon die-cut, as shown
- 8. Attach small layered hexagon die-cut to page with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
- 9. Attach another wood pattern hexagon die-cut and arrow diecut, as shown
- 10. Attach chipboard die-cut star
- 11. Attach wooden title and arrows with glue dots, as shown
- 12. Embellish with stickers, as shown
- Tip: Attach some stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 13. Add journaling
