## Additional Materials Needed:

- Z4224 Black Shimmer Brush (optional)
- Z3516 Black Journaling Pen (.03) (optional)
- Z2045 All-purpose Mat (optional)
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z3440 Dual-tip Permanent Glue Pen
- Ruler (optional)

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

## Project 1: Left Page

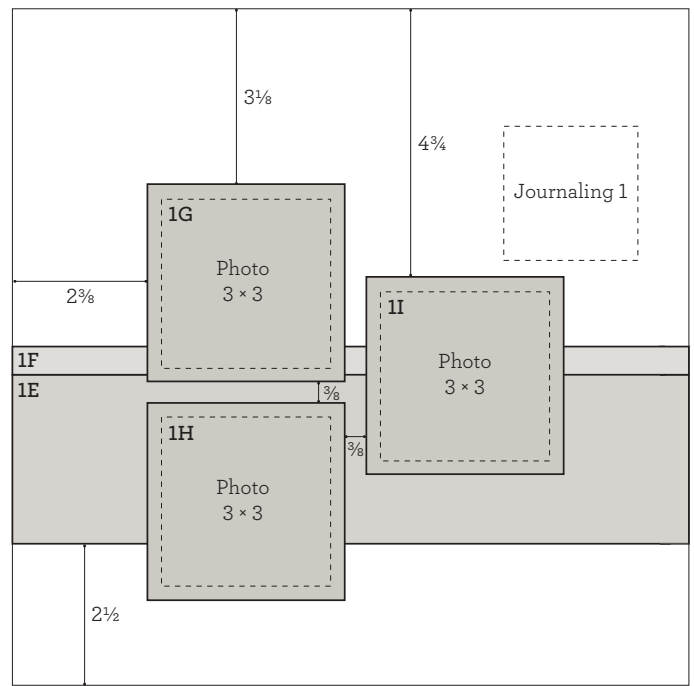


### Assemble:

1. Use Clover dot paper for base page
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach background scalloped half circle die-cut, as shown
4. Attach 1B, 1C, and 1D
5. Attach photo  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
6. Attach title
7. Attach tag and white glitter leaf die-cuts behind photo, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
8. Assemble ornaments and attach, as shown  
*Tips: Each teardrop ornament has 3 pieces. Fold and attach the flaps together before attaching the ornament to the page. Attach a few completed ornaments with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
10. (Optional) Draw ornament strings with journaling pen and ruler, as shown
11. (Optional) Draw journaling lines on white scalloped circle with journaling pen and ruler, as shown
12. (Optional) Add color to flower centers with Black Shimmer Brush
13. Add journaling



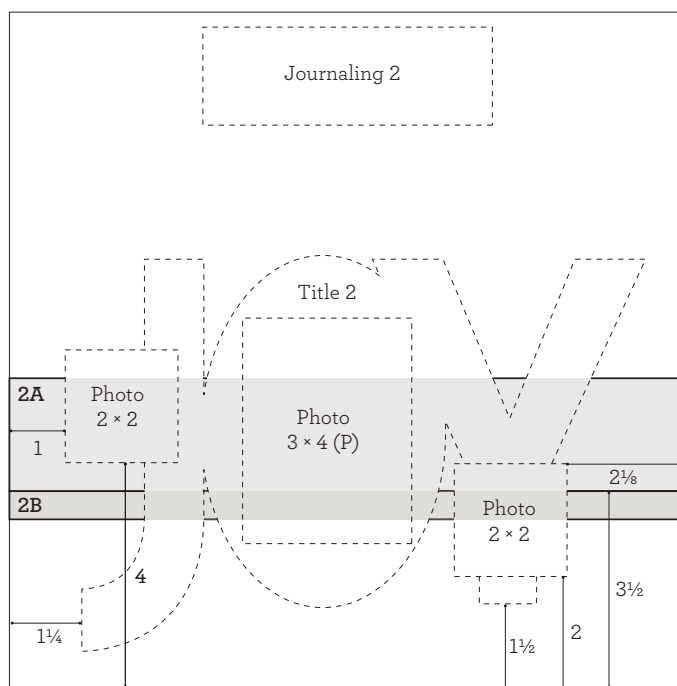
## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use Clover dot paper for base page
2. Attach 1E and 1F
3. Attach background scalloped half circle die-cuts, as shown
4. Attach 1G, 1H, and 1I
5. Attach photos
6. Assemble ornaments and attach, as shown  
*Tips: Each teardrop ornament has 3 pieces. Fold and attach the flaps together before attaching the ornament to the page. Attach a few completed ornaments with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Only use adhesive along the center of the bottom left ornament so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Embellish with white glitter leaf die-cuts, as shown
8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. (Optional) Draw ornament strings with journaling pen and ruler, as shown
10. (Optional) Draw journaling lines on white scalloped circle with journaling pen and ruler
11. (Optional) Add color to flower centers with Black Shimmer Brush
12. Add journaling

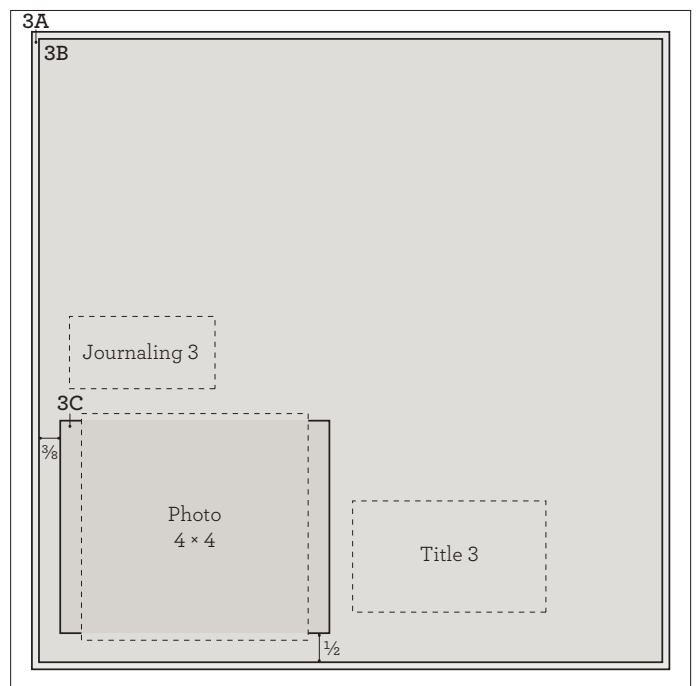
## Project 2



### Assemble:

1. Use Peach plaid paper for base page
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. (Optional) Outline edges of "JOY" title die-cut with journaling pen
4. Attach 3" x 4" photo behind "O" in "JOY" title die-cut, as shown
5. Attach title
6. Attach large scalloped die-cut along top of page, as shown  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along scalloped edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Embellish with white glitter snowflake die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck a couple of snowflakes behind the large scalloped die-cut.*
8. Attach 2" x 2" photos
9. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
10. (Optional) Draw journaling lines on large scalloped die-cut with journaling pen and ruler
11. (Optional) Add splatters with Black Shimmer Brush  
*Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with ink.*  
*Technique: Squeeze the Shimmer Brush over an All-purpose Mat, or piece of plastic, to make a small puddle of ink. Pick up ink from the puddle with the tip of the brush, and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.*

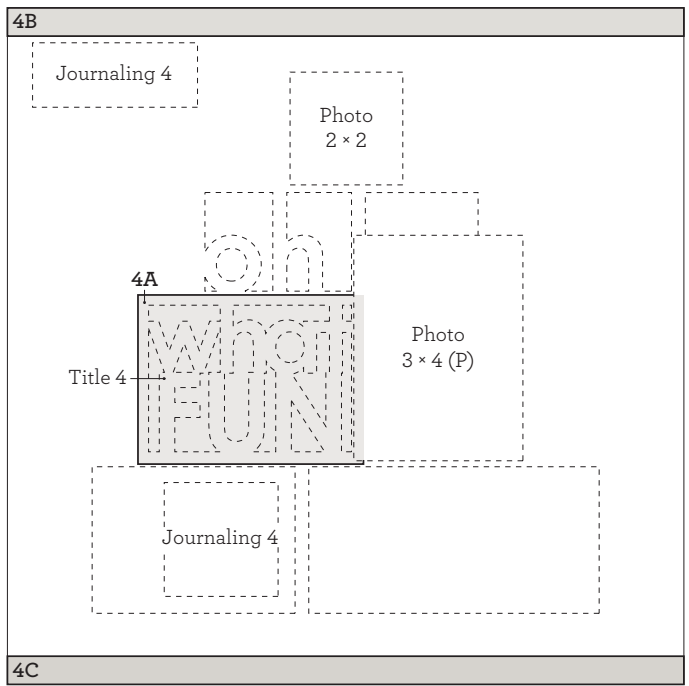
## Project 3



### Assemble:

1. Use Clover cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach individual star-shaped die-cuts to back of large, star-patterned, white frame die-cut, as shown
4. Attach white frame die-cut to 3B
5. Attach 3C
6. Attach photo with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach title
8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
9. Attach journaling strips
10. (Optional) Draw stitched lines on journaling strips with journaling pen
11. (Optional) Add splatters with Black Shimmer Brush  
*Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with ink.*  
*Technique: Squeeze the Shimmer Brush over an All-purpose Mat, or piece of plastic, to make a puddle of ink. Pick up ink from the puddle with the tip of the brush, and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.*
12. Add journaling

## Project 4

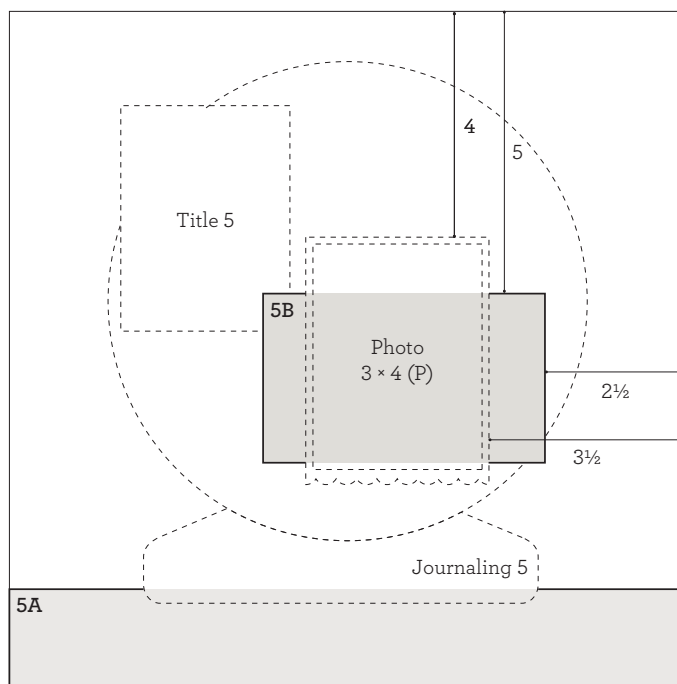


### Assemble:

1. Use light Smoothie cardstock for base page
2. Attach 4A to back of "what FUN" on large, stacked rectangles, frame die-cut, as shown
3. Attach photos and rectangle die-cut pieces to remaining openings of frame die-cut, as shown
4. Attach large frame die-cut to base page
5. Attach 4B and 4C
6. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. (Optional) Draw outlines and journaling lines on journaling square and half circle with journaling pen, as shown
8. (Optional) Add splatters with Black Shimmer Brush  
*Tip: Use scratch paper to cover any areas you do not want splattered with ink.*  
*Technique: Squeeze the Shimmer Brush over an All-purpose Mat, or piece of plastic, to make a puddle of ink. Pick up ink from the puddle with the tip of the brush, and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.*
9. Add journaling



## Project 5



### Assemble:

1. Use snowflake paper for base page
2. Attach 5A
3. Attach snow globe base die-cut
4. Attach snow globe sphere die-cut, as shown  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left side so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach 5B
6. Attach green tree die-cuts and Christmas tree sticker, as shown, and trim as desired  
*Tip: Lay the white glitter tree die-cut to help with placement.*
7. Attach white glitter die-cuts, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck a large snowflake under top left of the snow globe, as shown.*
8. Attach photo mat die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Attach photo
10. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
11. (Optional) Draw details on journaling strips with journaling pen
12. Add journaling
