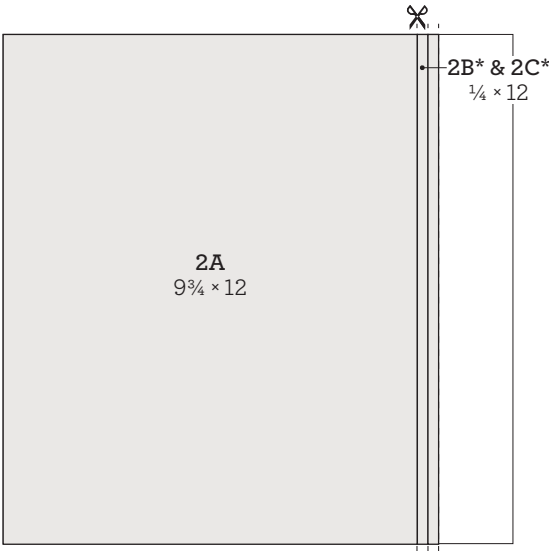

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

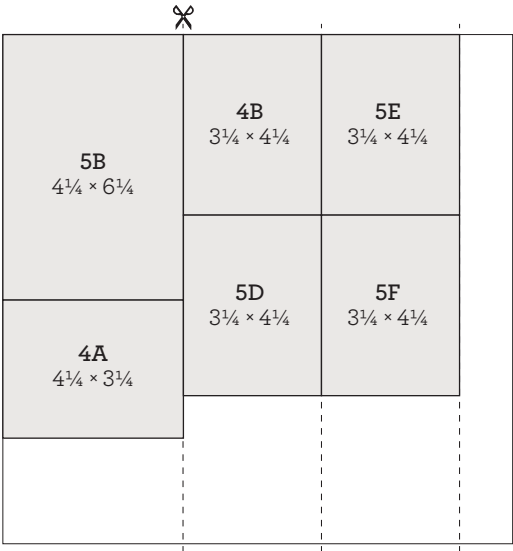

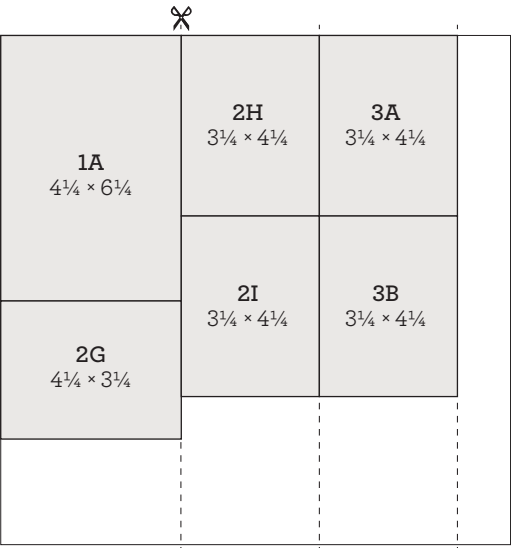
Peach cardstock

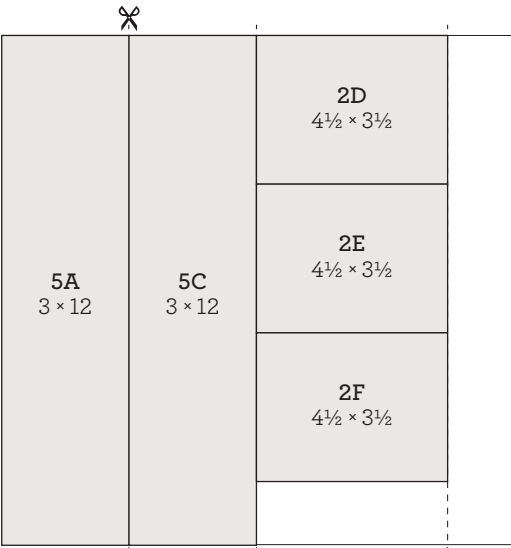

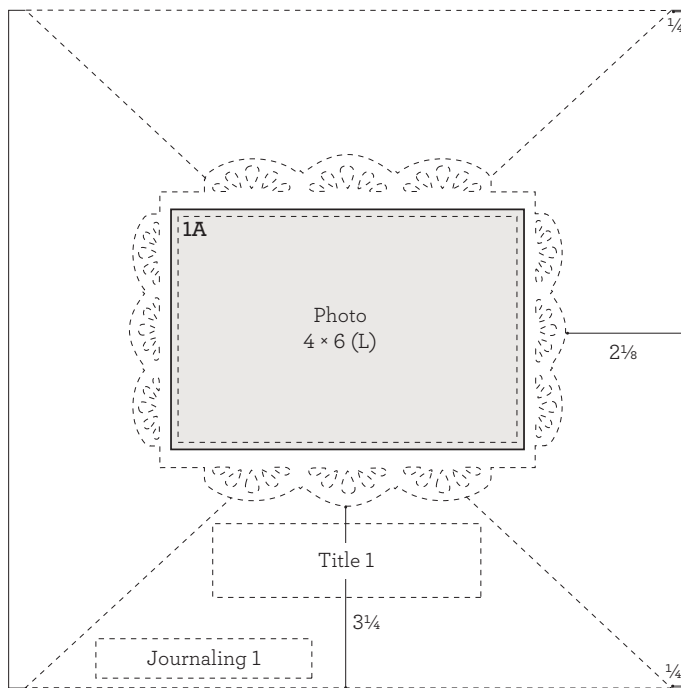

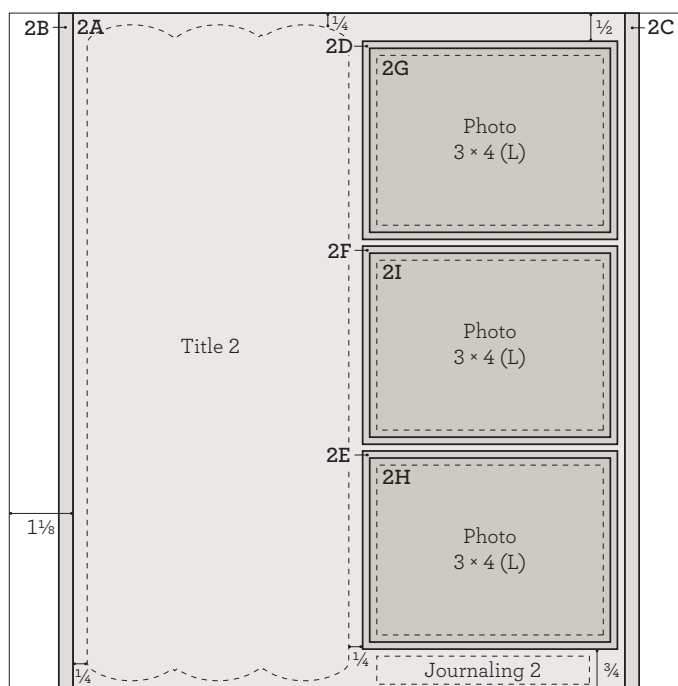
Project 1



Assemble:

1. Use Peach stripes paper for base page
2. Attach large triangle die-cuts to top and bottom of page
Tip: The one with the three flower cutouts goes on top.
3. Attach 1A to scalloped frame die-cut, as shown
4. Attach frame die-cut to base page with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photo
6. Attach title
7. Embellish with glitter, flower, and leaf die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Embellish with ribbon bow
9. Attach journaling strips
10. Add journaling
11. (Optional) Embellish flower centers with glitter gel

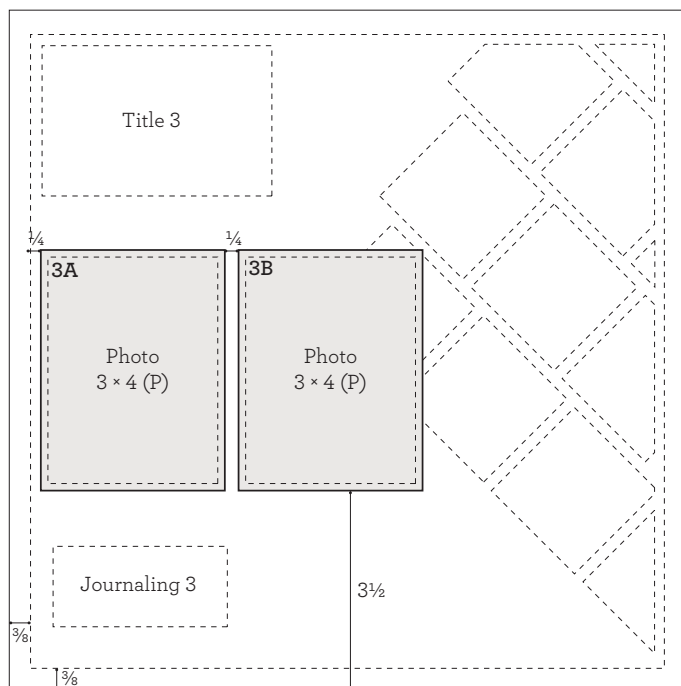
Project 2



Assemble:

1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach 2B and 2C
4. Attach title overlay die-cut to kraft die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach title
6. Attach glitter die-cut title
7. Attach 2D, 2E, and 2F with thin 3-D foam tape
Tip: Center 2F between 2D and 2E, as shown.
8. Attach 2G, 2H, and 2I
9. Attach photos
10. Attach journaling strips
11. Embellish with remaining die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
12. Add journaling
13. (Optional) Embellish flower centers with glitter gel

Project 3



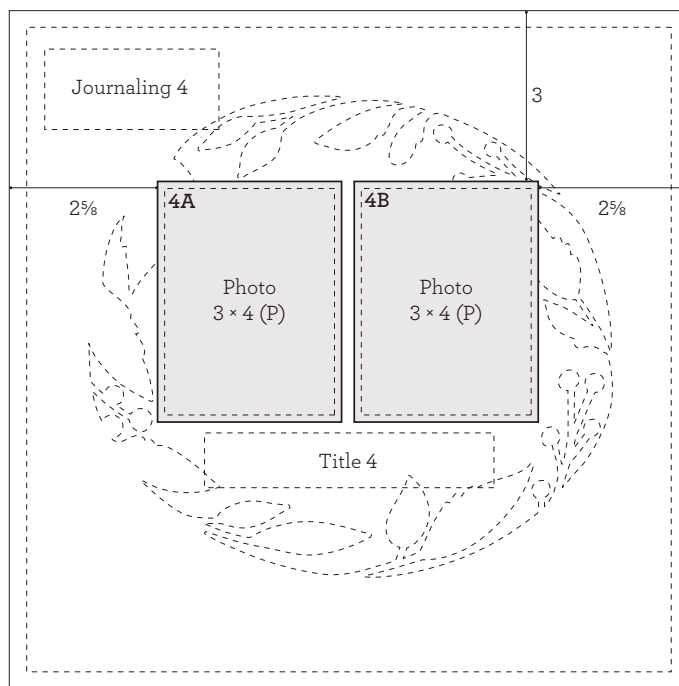
Assemble:

1. Use splattered Candy Apple paper for base page
2. Attach small patterned die-cut pieces behind large overlay die-cut, as shown
3. Attach overlay to base page
4. Attach title

Tip: Attach heart and banner with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
5. Attach 3A and 3B
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown

Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Add journaling
9. (Optional) Embellish flower center and pine sprigs with glitter gel

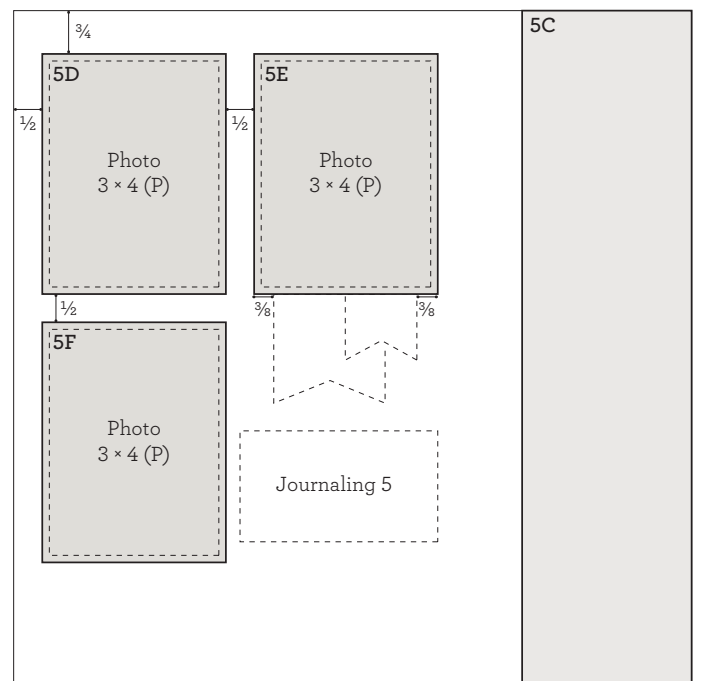
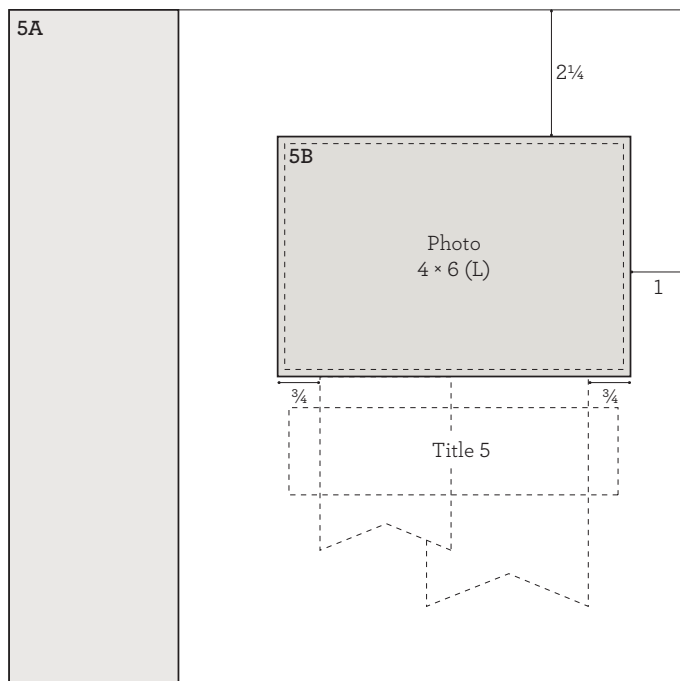
Project 4



Assemble:

1. Use splattered Candy Apple paper for base page
2. Center and attach large overlay die-cut to base page
3. Layer individual leaf die-cuts on matching leaves on overlay, and attach
Tip: For added dimension, use thin 3-D foam tape under the tips.
4. Attach 4A and 4B with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photos
6. Attach title with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with ribbon bow, stickers, and remaining die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Attach journaling strips
9. Add journaling
10. (Optional) Embellish leaves with glitter gel

Project 5



Assemble left page:

1. Use plaid Evergreen paper for base page
2. Attach 5A
3. Attach 5B with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Attach doily and banner die-cuts, as shown
5. Attach glitter, flower, and leaf die-cuts to 5A, as shown
Tips: Layout all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching. For added dimension, attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape. Once attached, trim any excess that hangs over the top, bottom, and left edge.
6. Attach photo
7. Embellish with remaining flower and leaf die-cuts, as shown
8. Attach title
9. Embellish with ribbon bow
10. (Optional) Embellish flower centers with glitter gel

Assemble right page:

1. Use plaid Evergreen paper for base page
2. Attach 5C
3. Attach 5D, 5E, and 5F with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Attach banner die-cuts, as shown
5. Attach photos
6. Attach glitter, flower, and leaf die-cuts to 5C, as shown
Tips: Layout all of the pieces first and arrange them as desired before attaching. For added dimension, attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape. Once attached, trim any excess that hangs over the top, bottom, and left edge.
7. Embellish with remaining flower die-cut
8. Attach journaling strips
9. Add journaling
10. (Optional) Embellish flower centers with glitter gel
