Getting Started:

- Gather all additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the $\frac{1}{2}$ " accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

✂ = first cut | * = use back of paper

■ = suggested stamp arrangement | ■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

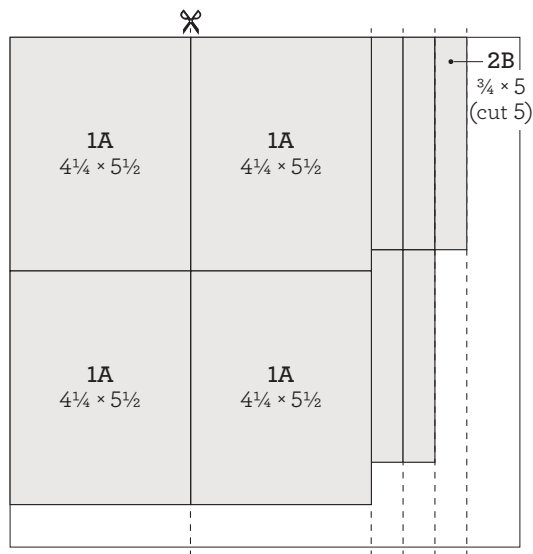

1D: $2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ (cut 5)



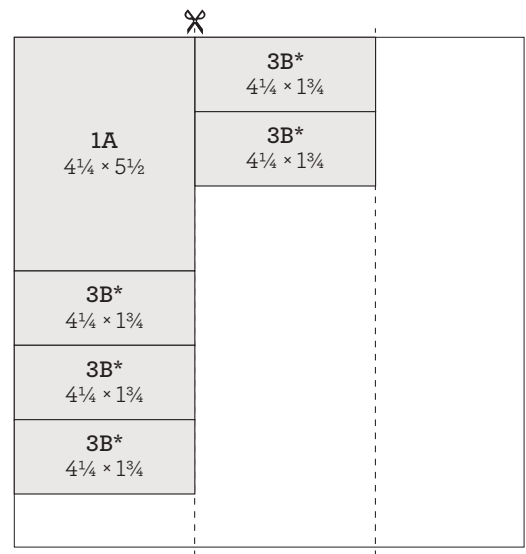

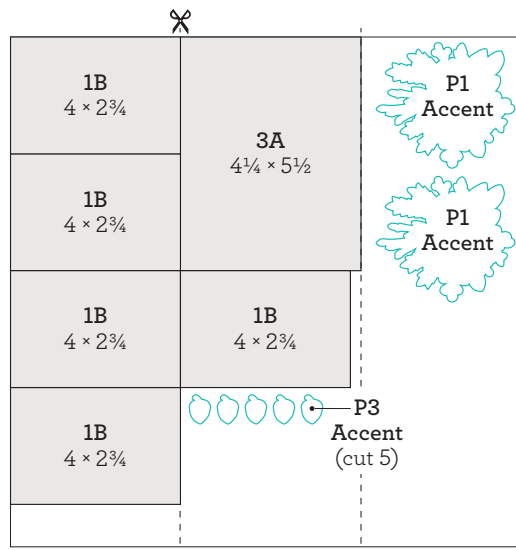


Charcoal cardstock

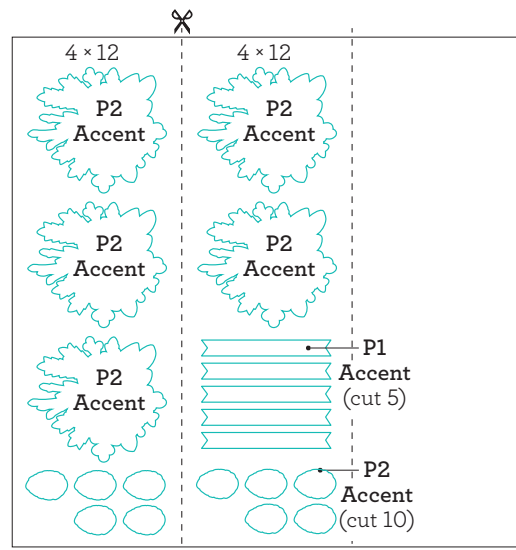

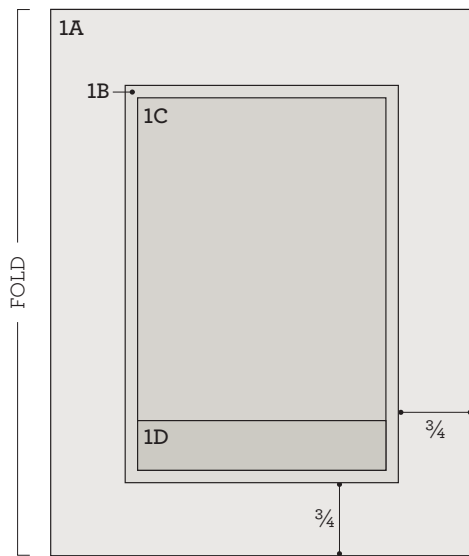

Project 1: Make 5

Prepare (5 each):



THANKS SO MUCH

P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: banner

Ink: Paprika



P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: pine cones and sprigs

Ink: Charcoal

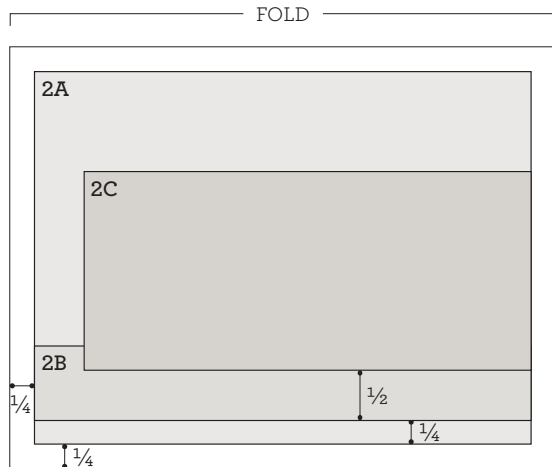
Tip: Add color with watercolor pencils.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A to card base
3. Attach 1C to 1B
4. Attach 1D to 1C
5. Embellish 1B with twine
Tip: Secure ends with glue dots.
6. Attach 1B to 1A with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach pine cones and sprigs accent, as shown
8. Attach "THANKS SO MUCH" accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown

Project 2: Make 5



Prepare (5 each):



P2 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: pine cone
Ink: Charcoal
Tip: Make two per card.



P2 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: pine cones and sprigs
Inks: Paprika, Saffron
Tip: Use rock & roll stamping technique.
Technique: Ink stamp in Saffron, then gently roll the edges in Paprika before stamping.

P2 Accent:

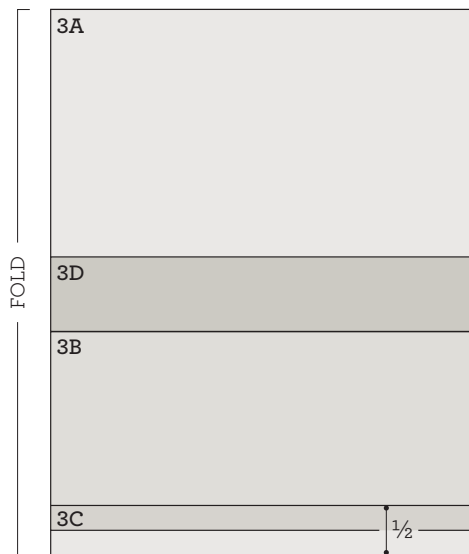
Paper: light Paprika
Die: banner
Ink: Charcoal



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A to card base
3. Attach 2B
4. Tear 1/2" off one end of 2C and attach
5. Attach pine cones and sprigs accent
6. Attach loose pine cone accents with thin 3-D foam tape, on top of matching pine cone images
7. Attach "GRATEFUL FOR YOU" accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Embellish with twine bow
Tip: Attach with a glue dot.

Project 3: Make 5

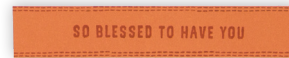


Prepare (5 each):



3A:

Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Charcoal, Paprika, Saffron
Tip: Stamp middle acorn first. Then, stamp the acorn on the left as a second-generation image.
Technique: Ink stamp in Paprika and stamp center acorn on 3A. Then, without re-inking, stamp on 3A again.



3D:

Paper: light Paprika
Ink: Paprika



P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: acorn
Ink: Paprika



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3B, 3C, and 3D to 3A
3. Embellish 3A with twine
Tip: Secure bow with a glue dot.
4. Attach 3A to card base
5. Attach acorn accent with thin 3-D foam tape on top of matching acorn image
