- Z4245 Opaque Matte Texture Paste (optional)
- Z4247 Palette Knives (optional)
- Z3515 Black Journaling Pen (.01)
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z341 Mini Dots® Mini Dots

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

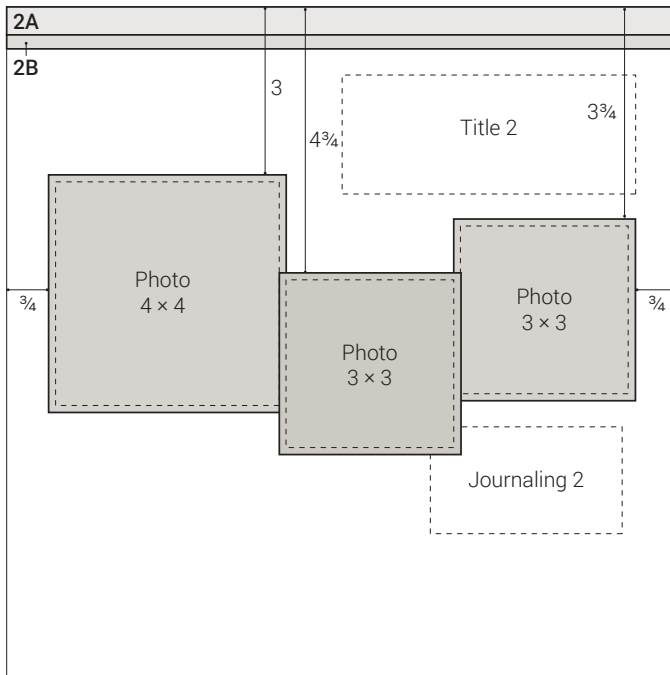
Project 1



Assemble:

1. Use winter birds and sprigs paper for base page
2. Attach die-cut pieces to corresponding openings on back of large bracket frame die-cut, as shown
Tip: Lay out all the pieces first.
3. Attach photo to center opening on back of die-cut frame, as shown
4. Attach large frame die-cut to base page with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach "Winter" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach wooden "STAY COZY" pieces with glue dots
7. Layer and attach snowflake die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Embellish with stickers
9. Trim journaling strips to desired lengths and attach
10. Add journaling

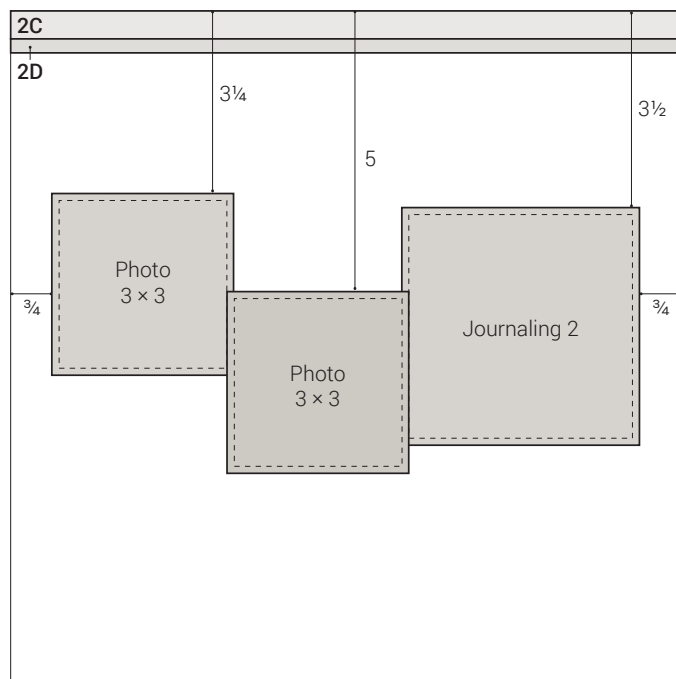
Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use wooden slats paper for base page
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. (Optional) Embellish bottom of base page with texture paste, as shown
4. Attach photos to back of frame die-cut, then hand trim
5. Attach frame to base page with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish page with stickers and die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. (Optional) Embellish some stickers and die-cuts with texture paste, as shown
8. Attach wooden title with glue dots
9. Trim journaling strips to desired lengths and attach
10. Add journaling

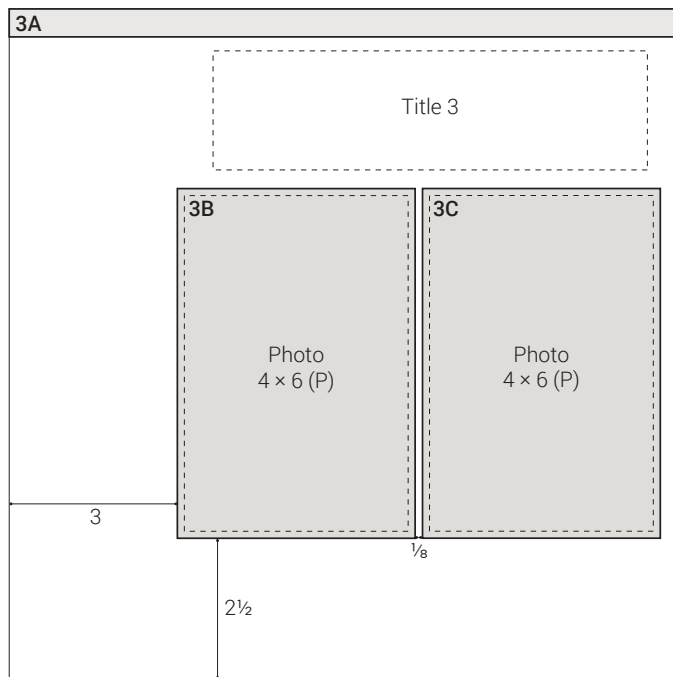
Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use wooden slats paper for base page
2. Attach 2C and 2D
3. (Optional) Embellish bottom of base page with texture paste, as shown
4. Attach photo to back of frame die-cut, then hand trim
5. Add journaling
6. Attach frame to base page with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach wooden "Destination Fun" pieces with glue dots
8. Embellish page with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. (Optional) Embellish some stickers and die-cuts with texture paste, as shown

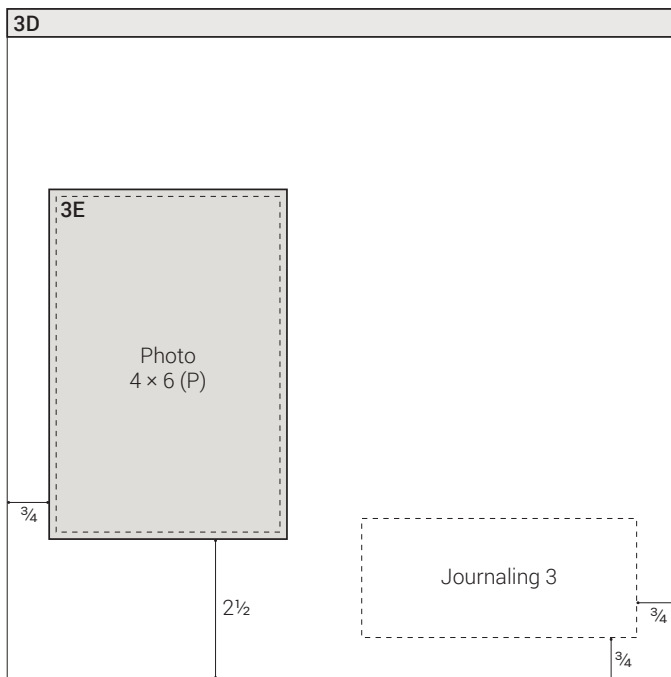
Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use pine leaves paper for base page
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B and 3C
4. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach darker Julep scalloped die-cut, 1¼" from bottom
6. Layer and attach lighter Julep and wood grain scalloped die-cuts, as shown
7. Attach "Together" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach wooden "is the best place" piece with glue dots
9. Embellish with wooden tree, stickers, and remaining die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach wooden tree with glue dots.
10. (Optional) Embellish tree die-cut and wooden tree with texture paste, as shown

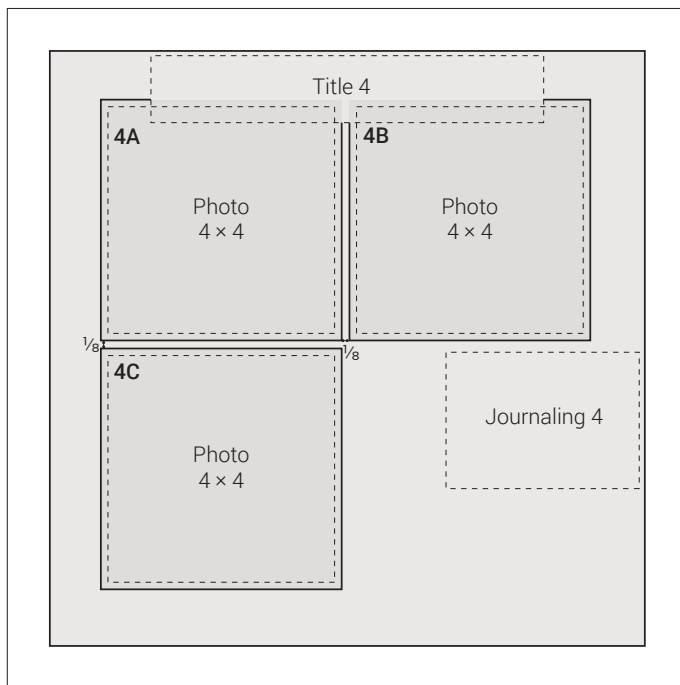
Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use pine leaves paper for base page
2. Attach 3D
3. Attach 3E
4. Attach photo with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach tree trunks die-cut, as shown
6. Attach darker Julep scalloped die-cut, 1 1/4" from bottom
7. Layer and attach lighter Julep and wood grain scalloped die-cuts, as shown
8. Attach deer sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Fold tree line die-cut along tree trunks, alternating ridges and valleys, as shown
10. Attach tree line die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape
11. Attach wooden trees with glue dots
12. (Optional) Embellish tree line die-cut and wooden trees with texture paste, as shown
13. Trim journaling strips to desired length and attach
14. Add journaling

Project 4



Assemble:

1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach die-cut pieces to corresponding openings on back of large square frame
3. Attach large frame die-cut to base page, as shown
4. Attach 4A, 4B, and 4C
5. Attach photos
6. Attach circle journaling die-cut
7. Embellish with die-cut trees, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Attach snow mound die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
9. (Optional) Embellish snow mound die-cuts with texture paste, as shown
10. Attach corresponding die-cut to back of wooden "THIS" piece, as shown
11. Attach wooden "Cherish THIS" piece with glue dots, as shown
12. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown
13. Add journaling
