Getting Started:

• Gather any additional materials needed.


- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.



Project 1






- 1. Use woodgrain paper for base page
- 2. Attach photos to 1A, 1B, and 1C
- 3. Attach 1A with thin 3-D foam tape *Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top or right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
- 4. Attach 1B and 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
- 5. Layer and attach pennant die-cuts to white banner die-cuts
- 6. Layer and attach colored and patterned tree die-cut pieces to corresponding white die-cut pieces
- 7. Attach prepared die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck sun and short banner die-cuts slightly behind 1A.
- 8. Add journaling
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots *Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*
- 10. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown

Project 2






- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 2A
- 3. Attach photo
- 4. Attach sunray die-cuts and "SUN" letter die-cuts to back of large "SUNshine" die-cut, as shown 5. Attach "SUNshine" die-cut
- 6. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 7. Add journaling
- 8. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.
- 9. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown

Project 3: Left Page






- 1. Use wave paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3A and 3B
- 3. Attach 12" wave die-cuts above 3B, as shown *Tip: Attach the shorter wave die-cut with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 4. Attach ship wheel and handle die-cuts, as shown Tip: Do not use adhesive under the 10 o'clock position of the ship wheel die-cut so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. Attach 3C with 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photo
- 7. Attach $7\frac{1}{2}$ " wave die-cut to photo, as shown
- 8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the peach shell die-cut slightly under the ship wheel at the 10 o'clock position, as shown.
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots *Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*
- 10. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown

Project 3: Right Page






- 1. Use wave paper for base page
- 2. Attach 3D and 3E
- 3. Attach photos *Tip: Attach top two photos with thin 3-D foam tape*
- 4. Attach 3G
- 5. Attach die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape. Lay out wave pieces, first, to help with placement.*
- 6. Attach 3F
- 7. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots *Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*
- 8. Add journaling
- 9. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown

Project 4: Left Page






- 1. Use fishnet paper for base page
- 2. Attach 4A
- 3. Attach colored chevron die-cut pieces to back of large white triangle die-cut, as shown
- 4. Attach prepared white triangle die-cut, as shown
- 5. Attach4B and 4C
- 6. Attach 4D and 4E
- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Attach title
- Tip: Attach "SEAS" and "DAY" with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 9. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 10. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots *Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*
- 11. Add journaling
- 12. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown

Project 4: Right Page





- 1. Use fishnet paper for base page
- 2. Attach 4F
- 3. Attach colored chevron die-cut pieces to back of large white triangle die-cut, as shown
- 4. Attach prepared white triangle die-cut
- 5. Attach 4G, 4H, and 4I
- 6. Attach 4J
- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes and dots *Tip: Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots.*
- 10. Add journaling
- 11. (Optional) Embellish with glitter gel, as shown
