

Getting Started:


- · Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.




Assemble:

- 1. Use mountain paper for base page
- 2. Attach long Sapphire plaid strip die-cut
- 3. Attach remaining long strip die-cuts and zip strips
- 4. Attach mountain range die-cut along bottom, as shown
- 5. Attach photo mat die-cuts and photos
- 6. Attach title sticker with 3-D foam tape, as shown
- 7. Embellish with remaining stickers and die-cuts, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 8. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
 until the powder and ink melt together.
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*





- 6. Attach compass die-cut to base page, as shown
- 7. Attach photo mat die-cut and photo
- 8. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 9. Add journaling

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- 10. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
 until the powder and ink melt together.

- 3. Attach solid tree die-cuts behind tree outline die-cuts, as shown
- 4. Attach tree die-cuts, as shown
 Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 5. Attach wood cut sticker, as shown
- 6. Attach title die-cut with 3-D foam tape
- 7. Attach photos

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- 8. Embellish with remaining stickers and die-cut, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 9. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
 until the powder and ink melt together.



- 2. Attach Sage plaid paper
- 3. Attach border sticker
- 4. Attach photo mats and journaling die-cut
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Attach solid tree die-cuts behind tree outline die-cuts
- 7. Attach tree die-cuts, as shown
 Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 8. Add journaling
- 9. Embellish with remaining stickers, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 10. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
 until the powder and ink melt together.

- 2. Attach zip strip along top
- 3. Attach large "AIR" die-cut, as shown
- 4. Attach photo mats
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Add journaling
- 7. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 8. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
 until the powder and ink melt together.
- 9. Embellish with acrylic shapes *Tip: Attach with glue dots.*

Project 4:





Assemble:

- 1. Use constellation paper for base page
- 2. Assemble spinner and attach, as shown
 Tips: The spinner is made up of 4 die-cut pieces: two small disks,
 the spinning wheel, and the decorative front with the window.
 Attach the two small disks to the front and back of the spinning
 wheel with a brad. Apply 3-D foam tape to the front disk and
 attach it to the decorative front piece of the spinner. Apply 3-D
 foam tape to the back disk and attach the assembled spinner to
 the base page.
- 3. Attach long strip sticker
- 4. Attach photo mat die-cuts
- 5. Attach photos
- 6. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 7. Add journaling

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- 8. (Optional) Heat emboss acrylic shapes
 Tip: Hold piece(s) with a tweezer while applying heat.
 Technique: Press the shape(s) face down on the surface of
 the VersaMark™ ink pad. Sprinkle the wet ink with embossing
 powder and shake off any excess. With the heat tool, apply heat
